



*The mighty Daqan Horse Lords have thrown back the hordes of angry Uthuk Y'llan that had stormed into their realms. Now, the Daqan have vowed to end the Uthuk menace once and for all. The Horse Lords will take the fight to the very heart of the Uthuk lands. Their final goal: the eradication of every last Uthuk warrior.*

## SETUP

**Uthuk Setup:** Draw 4 Command Cards and 2 Lore cards. The Uthuk army has 45 muster points.

**Daqan Setup:** Draw 4 Command Cards and 3 Lore cards. The Daqan army has 55 muster points.

## SPECIAL RULES

All river tiles are considered impassible, with the exception of the ford and bridge tiles. Units must stop upon entering the ford, no matter how many movement points they have left. While in the ford, units are particularly vulnerable to attack; **enemy units may reroll one die per attack against units in the ford.** The bridge has no special rules and should be treated as open terrain. Neither side places additional ford tokens in this scenario.

The four forest hexes on the Daqan side of the map are part of an ancient woods. This menacing terrain is fraught with perils; Daqan units entering this terrain must roll two dice and suffer one hit for each Lore result. The Uthuk Y'llan are more familiar with the dangers of the forest, and must roll a single die when entering these hexes, suffering one hit for a Lore result. Note that this penalty applies even when moving between two forest hexes.

## OBJECTIVE

The goal of the Daqan Horse Lords is to control Uthuk territory. The Daqan immediately win if, at the **beginning** of any of their turns, they control the four hexes marked one through four. The Uthuk, having been driven back into their own lands, are attempting to repel the invaders and break their will to dominate these lands. The Uthuk immediately win if they eliminate one half of the Daqan units. Round up, i.e. if the Daqan army has 11 units, 6 must be eliminated for the Uthuk to claim victory.

Alternately, either side can win through the standard accumulation of victory points.
