Turn 1 (1500-1000 BC). 6 Mauryans (Afghanistan), 6 Mauryans (Central Asia).

Major Invasion: Mauryans.

Turn 2 (1000-700 BC). 6 Mauryans (Central Asia).

Turn 3 (700-450 BC). 4 Mauryans (Central Asia).

Turn 4 (450-200 BC). 6 Greeks led by **Alexander** (Afghanistan), **Ashoka** Mauryan leader,

3 Sinhalese (Lanka). At the end of the Greek turn, Greeks count victory points and then remove

Alexander and two armies.

Victory Points: All nations.

Turn 5

(200 BC-50 AD). **Ashoka** and 6 Mauryan armies removed at the start of Turn 5; Mauryans may no longer Increase Population. 3 Greeks (Persia), 6 Marathas (Maharashtra), 6 Rajputs (Central Asia), 4 Rajputs (China).

Major Invasion: Rajputs.

Victory Points: Greeks.

Turn 6 (50-300 AD). Mauryans are replaced by Guptas at the start of Turn 6. 4 Rajputs (China).

Boats: Cholas.

Victory Points: Rajputs.

Turn 7 (300-550 AD). 2 Rajputs (Tibet), **Chandra** Gupta leader.

Major Invasion: Guptas.

Boats: Cholas, Guptas.

Victory Points: All nations.

Turn 8

(550-800 AD). **Chandra** and 8 Guptas removed at the start of Turn 8; Guptas may no longer Increase Population. 4 Muslims (Persia).

Boats: Pandyas, Cholas, Marathas.

Turn 9 (800-1050 AD). 8 Guptas removed at the start of Turn 9. 2 Chola reinforcements, **Rajaraja** Chola leader, 8 Muslims (Afghanistan).

Boats: Pandyas, Cholas, Sinhalese, Muslims.

Victory Points: Cholas.

Turn 10 (1050-1300 AD). Cholas may no longer Increase Population. 8 Muslims (Afghanistan), **Aybak** Muslim leader, 4 Mughals (Central Asia).

Major Invasion: Muslims.

Boats: Pandyas, Cholas, Sinhalese, Muslims.

Victory Points: All nations.

Turn 11

(1300-1500 AD). 6 Mughals led by **Timur** (Central Asia), 2 Portuguese (Arabian Sea). At the end of the Mughal turn, Mughals count victory points and then remove **Timur** and two armies.

Boats: Muslims.

Turn 12 (1500-1600 AD). Muslims may no longer Increase Population outside of South India. **Sanga** Rajput leader, 14 Mughals (Afghanistan), **Akbar** Mughal leader, 2 Portuguese (Arabian Sea), **Albuquerque** Portuguese leader, 2 Dutch (Indian Ocean), 2 British (Arabian Sea).

Major Invasion: Mughals.

Boats: Muslims.

Victory Points: Rajputs.

Turn 13

(1600-1700 AD). Shivaji Maratha leader (Lahore), **Alamgir** Mughal leader, 2 British (Arabian Sea), 2 British (Arabian Sea), 2 British (Indian Ocean).

Boats: Marathas.

Victory Points: All nations.

Turn 14 (1700-1750 AD). 2 Maratha reinforcements, **Nizam** Mughal leader, **Dupleix** French leader (Indian Ocean), **Dupleix** French leader (Arabian Sea), 2 British (Indian Ocean), 2 British (Indian Ocean).

Boats: Marathas.

Victory Points: Marathas, Mughals.

Turn 16 (1800-1850 AD). British minimum 6.
Major Invasion: British.
Victory Points: All nations.
