



San Carlos Hospital

Serving about 13,000 people, the Service Unit hospital is in the town of San Carlos, the major population centre. At an elevation of approximately 2,600 feet, San Carlos offers a temperate semi-arid climate. Temperatures range from 90 to 100 degrees during the summer, and 40 to 60 degrees in the winter.

Fourteen physicians and four dentists staff the hospital. The In-patient Unit has an eight-bed capacity, and services include general medical care and surgical aftercare. Outpatient services include general medical, paediatric, prenatal and postpartum care, surgical follow up and a variety of specialty clinics. There is also an Emergency Department. High-risk obstetrical patients and those requiring surgery or complex medical care are referred to Phoenix Indian Medical Centre or other contract care hospitals. Ground and air transportation are available for emergency care.
