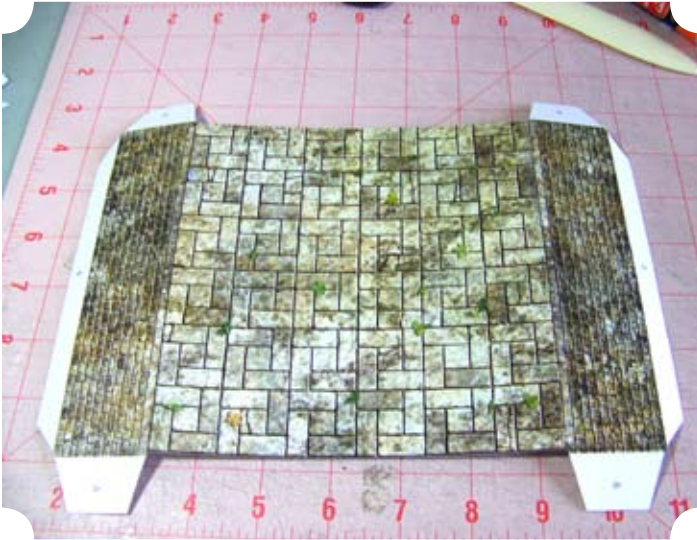

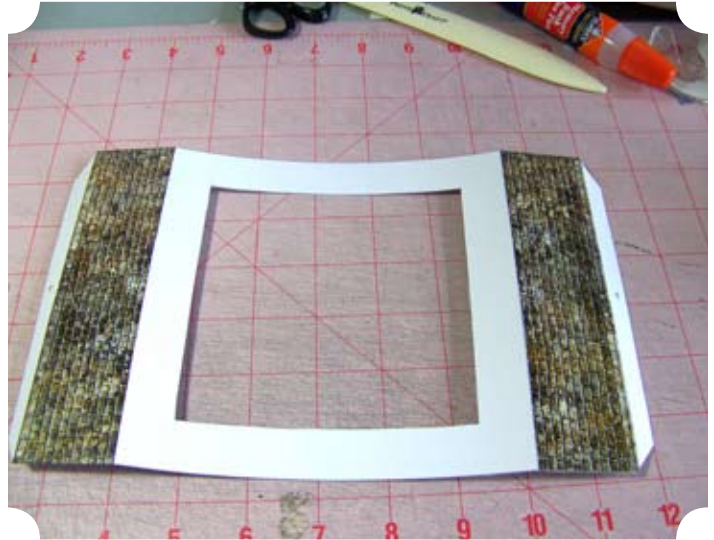
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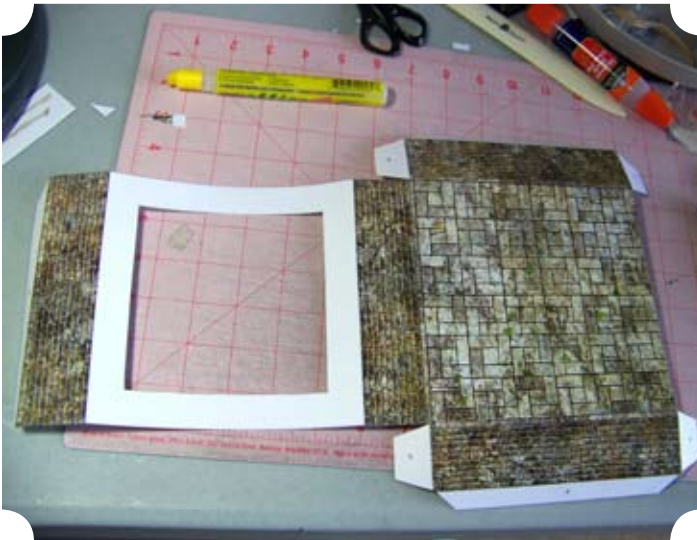
RAISED PLATFORMS



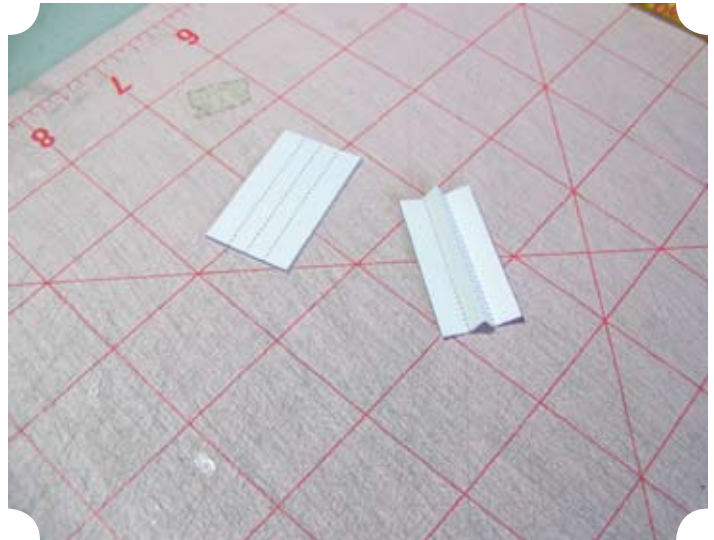
1: Cut, score and prefold the top platform section as depicted above.



2: Cut, score and prefold the bottom platform section as depicted above.



3: Glue the bottom and top sections together as shown.



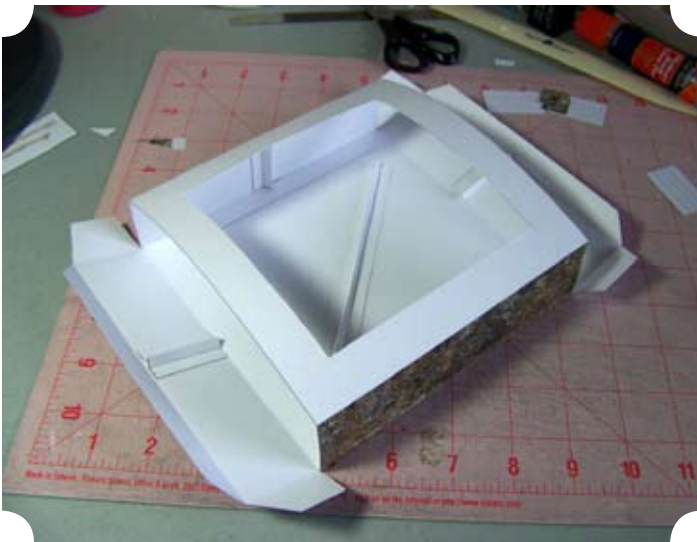
4: Fold the interior brace strips as shown. Note: The PDF page with the support braces will yield enough parts for several platforms.



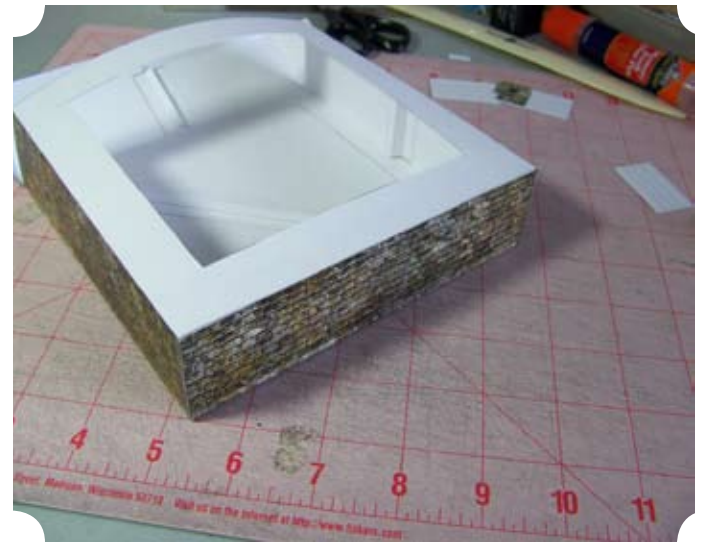
5: Glue the long interior support piece diagonally as shown to the rear of the top section.



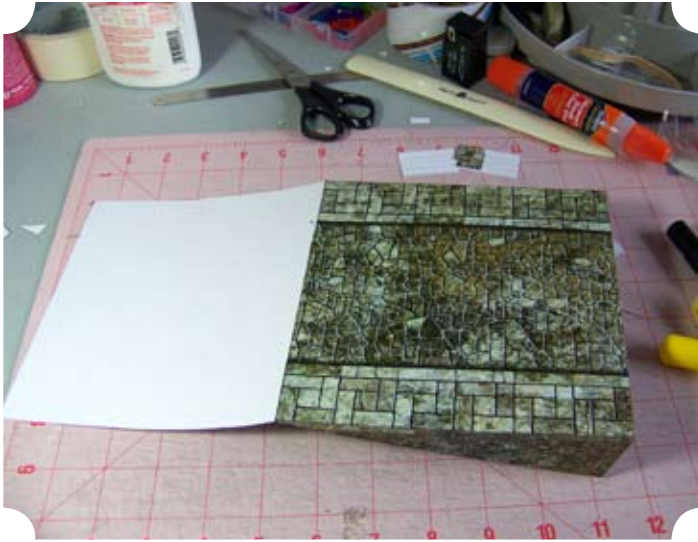
6: Glue the short braces to the center of each vertical wall as shown. Originally we intended there to be two braces per side, but test builds show that you can get by with one per side glued in the middle.



7: Fold over and glue into a box shape.



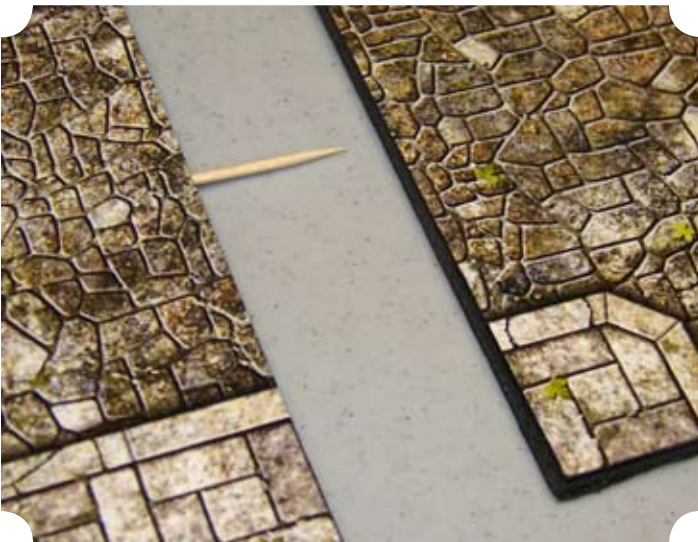
8: Glue the end flaps as shown.



9: The ramp platform assembles similar to the main platforms. Glue the upper and lower sections together, then the side walls, finally gluing the bottom section in place.



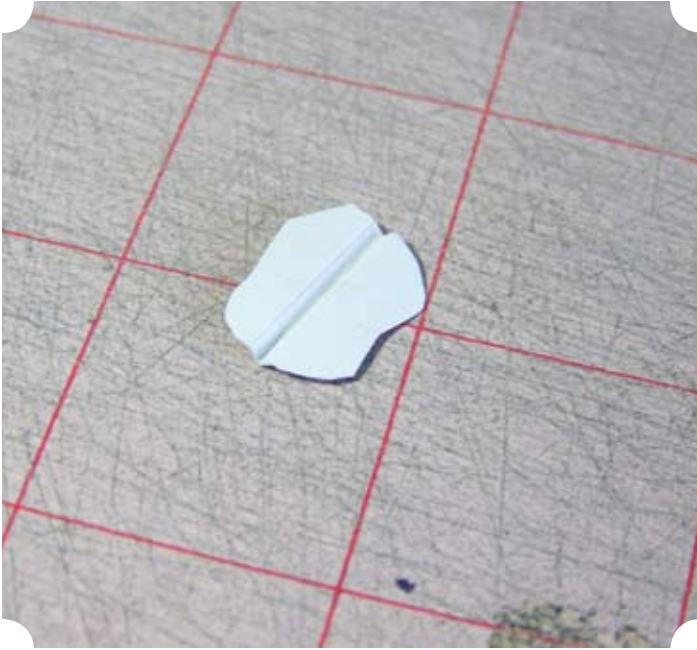
10: We recommend gluing the completed sections (and the flat street tiles as well) to 6x6 sections of foam core. See the E-Z basing instruction document for more information.



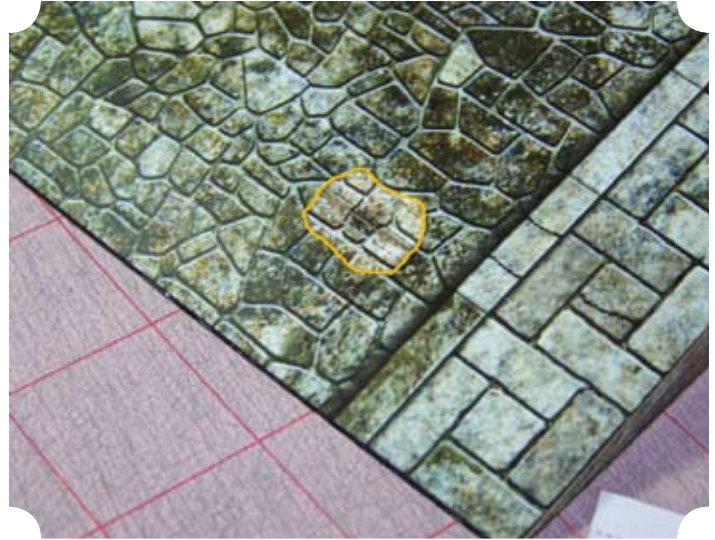
11: As described in the basing instructions PDF, you can use tooth picks to join tile sections that have been mounted on foam core.



12: The small non-slip tabs fold just like the braces you used for the elevated platform interiors.



13: Trim the edges to a random, wavy shape as shown.



14: Glue to the ramp as shown (outlined in yellow). Glue them as shown in the diagram below (1" intervals" on the lower edge of each grid section if using a gridded texture.) These will keep your miniatures from slipping down the slope.



Here is the general pattern for the non-slip tabs, arranged for a 1" grid.
