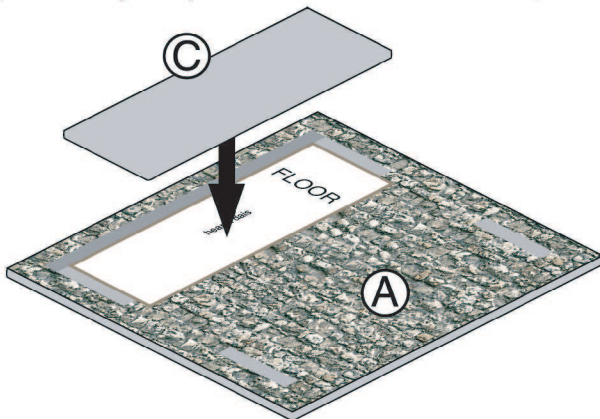


# Little Outbuilding Instructions

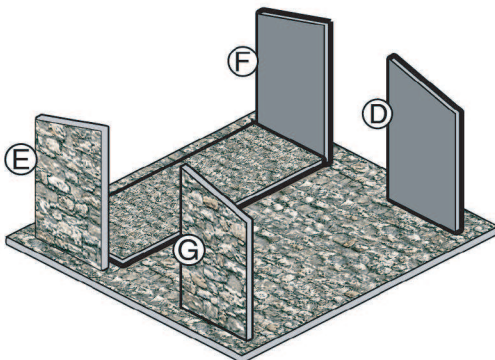

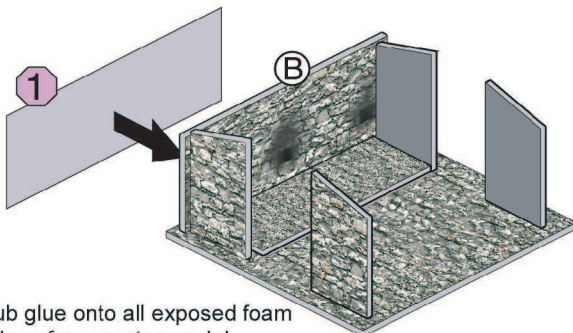
1. Print out pages 14 and 15.
2. Carefully cut out pieces A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, J, and K. **IMPORTANT:** Leave a margin on piece H that includes the hash marks. (They are needed for cutting later.)
3. Glue pieces A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, J, and K to foam core.
4. Cut pieces A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, J, and K out with a craft knife.
5. Glue piece C (Dais) over the white area on piece A (Floor).



6. Glue decals 4, 5, 6, and 7 to D, E, F, and G (Sides).
7. Glue D, E, F, and G (Sides) to A (Floor).

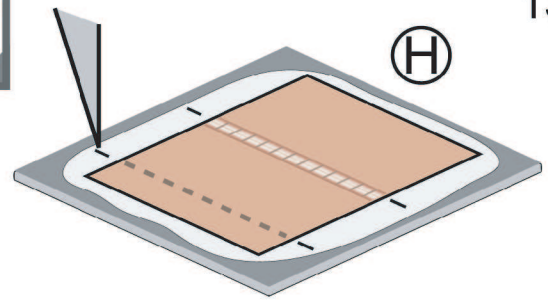


8. Glue decal 1 to B (Back).
9. **IMPORTANT:** Put piece B Glue B (Back) to A (Floor).

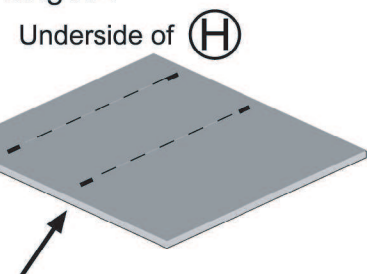


TIP: Rub glue onto all exposed foam core edges for a neater model.

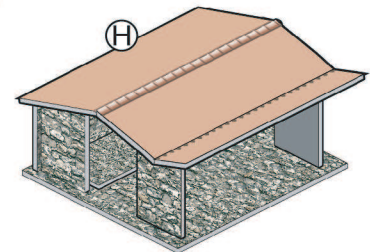
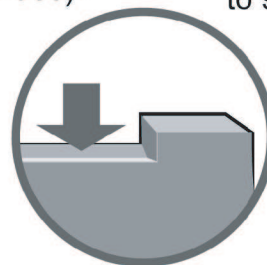

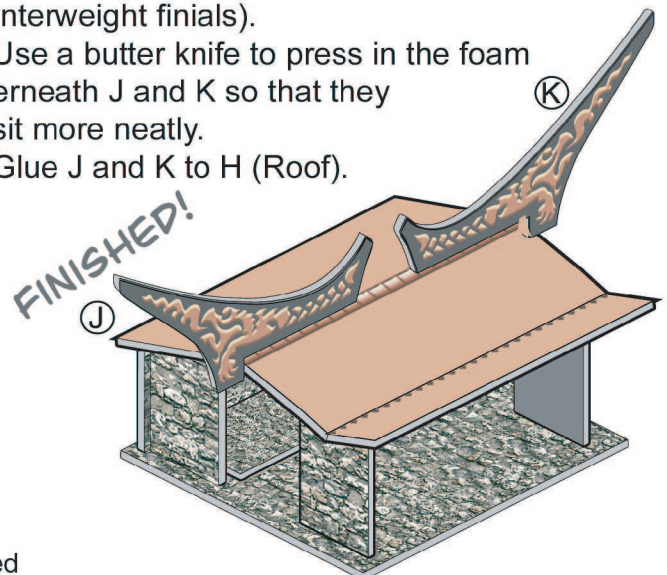
10. Poke cuts at the four hash marks on piece H (Roof).
11. Turn this piece over. Using a straight-edge, cut through just the top layer of cardboard to make two "hinges".



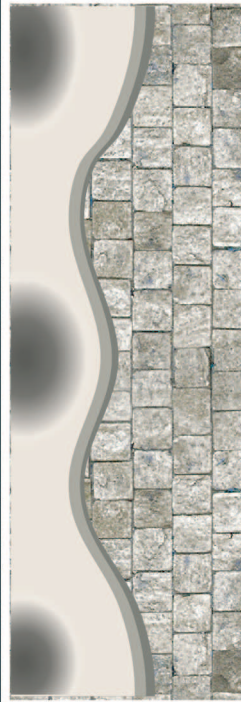
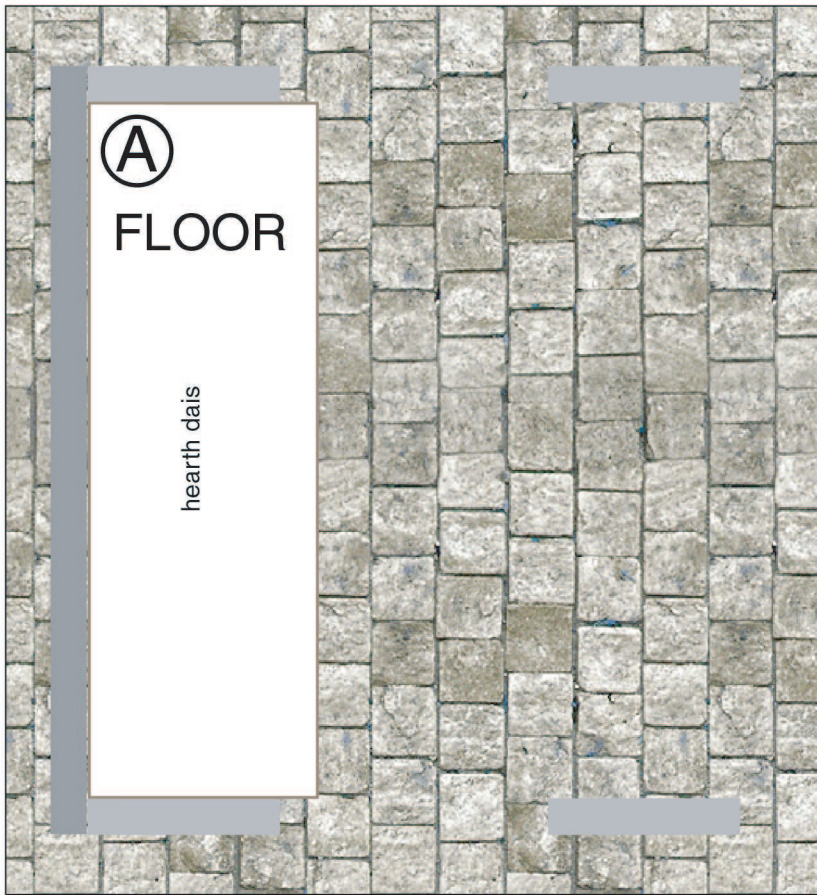
12. Remove a thin wedge out of the middle cut. Bend piece gently to shape roof.



13. Glue H (Roof) to D, E, F and G.
14. Glue decals 2 and 3 to pieces J and K (counterweight finials).
15. Use a butter knife to press in the foam underneath J and K so that they will sit more neatly.
16. Glue J and K to H (Roof).

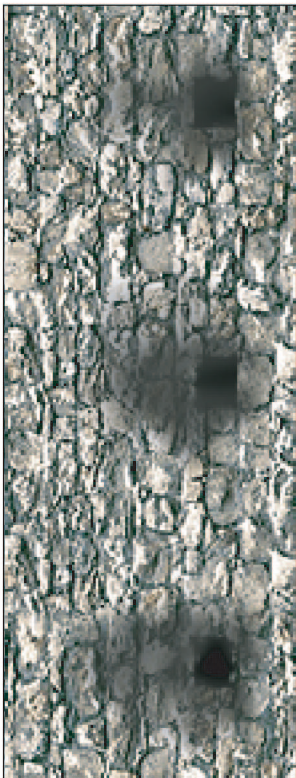
Underside of

## A Few Slightly More Advanced Building Variations

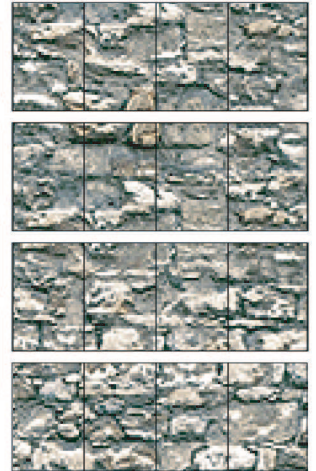
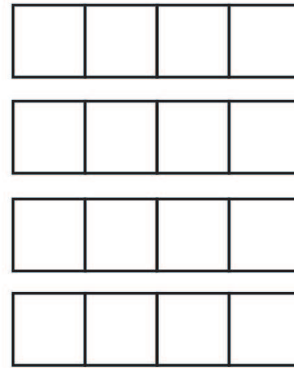
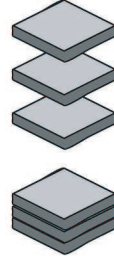
For the Outbuilding:

By default, the back wall is piece B.

Use decal ① for the wall instead.

Cut off foam edges at the hash marks.

Use B as the decal.

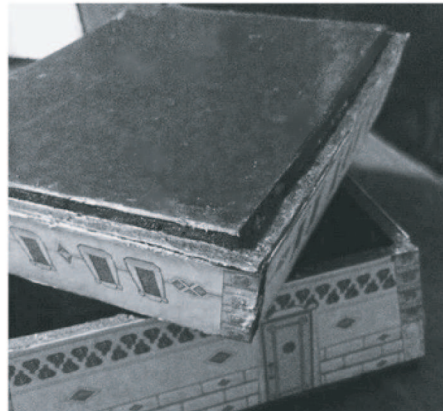
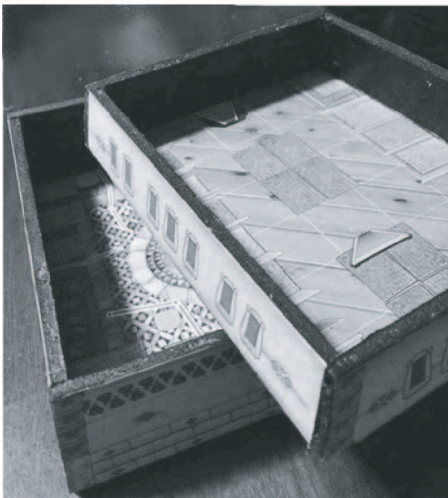


A building like this would not stand up to a powerful flood. It would tend to be found on a hilltop. It might also be placed on little platforms. Glue these pieces to foam core, apply the decals, then attach them to the underside of the Outbuilding.

For the Wayhouse: The edges of the base floor can be trimmed so that the bottom piece's foamcore edge is hidden.

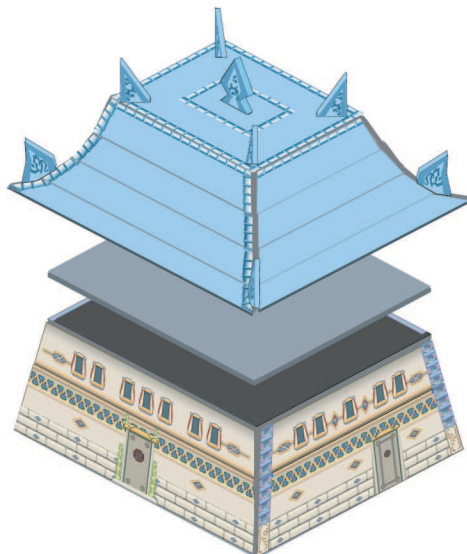
*TIP: For a more durable model all-around, cover all paper surfaces with a layer of plain white glue. Put a generous stripe of glue on all inner edges where two walls, or wall and floor, meet.*

If you would like the second floor to be another box tray, use the floor plan as another piece. Cut the edge off the underside so it will sit nicely on the first floor



The top can also be given a floor, with the Rooftop turned into a lid.

The second floor makes a good pencil tray, while the bottom works as a dice-rolling bowl!



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
