

## Notes and Errata for KEO5-04 Burning Brightly

- In the encounters in the Limbo monastery, **ONLY** the stained glass golems and Memnonthraxus possess the *touched by chaos* special ability. All other creatures, including the demons, suffer from this effect.
- KEO5-04 is a *very* difficult module. You should forewarn PCs of this before they play it. In some cases, PCs will indeed fail. The following are expanded guidelines for handling things should the worst come to the worst.
  - ❑ Any PCs that died in Limbo *\*in the final encounter\** must pay 4 TU. This represents their spirits freeing themselves from Tharizdun's grip by sheer willpower and escaping back into Limbo. If they don't have 4 TU left to spend, they must expend the balance on their first AR for next year. PCs slain before that point in the module had their souls "out of the blast zone" and need not pay this TU penalty.
  - ❑ All PCs who were slain must pay to have their bodies brought back to life. The LGCS rules should be followed in regards to this. A raise dead spell is sufficient for this task, since by expending the above 4TU (or by dying before the ritual went off) their soul is floating around and able to be raised.
  - ❑ Lastly, all PCs who were killed while in Limbo, and who choose a method of being raised from the dead that requires some or all of their physical remains, must expend a single *\*significant\** influence point or favor. This represents someone doing them a big favor and going to Limbo (or sending minions to Limbo) and recovering their remains. Email the Keoland Triad and let them know what significant person(s) are doing it. For Keoish players, this would include someone like Duke Luschan, the Silent Ones, Holphin Neheli (I know it sort of doesn't make sense, given the circumstances, but just pretend it does), Lashton of Greyhill, etc. For Geoff players, any Class A influence point will do. If the above doesn't cover what you want to expend to meet this requirement, email the Keoland Triad and ask. We are politely asking for the players to honor the intent of this third requirement - it's meant to be a penalty, and remember, this is someone who is willing to do a serious favor for you - so please don't let them cheese it.
