Additional Notes

These maps of the Five Empires originally appeared as part of Empire of the Petal Throne, published in 1975. Unlike the map of the City of Jakálla, these are *not* done in a "semi-representational" style, i.e. important structures shown on the map would appear much larger (and therefore take up more room) than they actually do in a physical and geographic sense. The projection has not, however, been adjusted for curvature of the globe of Tékumel.
