For three players...

★ To get revenge: On the one that killed your family For four and five players, add...

★ To get out: No matter who gets hurt

LOCATIONS IN ROMERO

For three, four, or five players...

* Romero Municipal Airport: A secluded helicopter pad

OBJECTS IN ROMERO

For three or four players...

★ Forbidden: One dose of anti-virus

For five players, add...

★ Sentimental: A new-born baby

THE TILT

During the Tilt, roll dice as normal. As per the rulebook, the players with the highest White and Black totals will choose elements from the Tilt Tables for Act 2. In addition, once this is done, the remaining player with the lowest White total chooses an element from the Survivors table. Then, the remaining player with the lowest Black total chooses an element from the Infected table. Break ties as per the standard rules. This will mean in a 3-player game, one player will choose both the Infected and Survivors elements, and in a 5-player game, one player won't have picked any elements.

• SURVIVORS

- A pre-recorded Civil Defense message from the high school
- A hand-made bed-sheet banner on the mall roof
- I A spray-painted sign instructing survivors to gather at the train depot
- A military convoy heading for Fort Boyle
- Several helicopters passing overhead and landing at the airport
- II A radio broadcast from the CDCA rapid response team at the hospital
