So when news leaks out of a secret meeting of F.E.A.R. heads here in Titan City, your mission is clear: to discover the location of the meeting, capture the Titanium Cyborg and his cohorts and bring them to justice.

There are four super powers to choose from, clues to find, Hero Points to gain or lose and new twists to the Fighting Fantasy combat system as Steve Jackson's amazing new gamebook throws you up against the most challenging, most dangerous adventure of them all! All YOU need is two dice, a pencil and an eraser. Many dangers lie ahead and even with your super powers your success is by no means certain.

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# HOW TO BATTLE THE SUPER-VILLAINS OF TITAN CITY

In Appointment with F.E.A.R., YOU will become the Silver Crusader, a superhero with unusual powers, dedicated to saving the citizens of Titan City from crime. You will come across robberies, kidnappings and destruction – crimes committed by a host of super-villains. You must also find out where the fateful meeting between the heads of F.E.A.R. (the Federation of Euro-American Rebels) is due to take place and capture Vladimir Utoshski, otherwise known as the Titanium Cyborg, F.E.A.R.'s leader.

You do not have only your super powers to aid you. Through your Crimewatch your friend and informant Gerry the Grass will alert you to crimes even before they are committed, and you can keep in touch with the police. And as you fight and overcome villains of the underworld, you will discover clues. Some clues will enable you to locate archcriminals and arrest them; others will give you information on the whereabouts of the secret F.E.A.R. meeting.

You begin the adventure with a choice of four super powers. With Super Strength, you are powerful and have the ability to fly. Psi-Powers enable you to read minds and influence objects by brain-power alone. ETS (Enhanced Technological Skill) provides you with a variety of devices and gadgets which you carry round in your Accessory Belt. If you choose Energy Blast, you can summon up a bolt of energy and project it from your fingertips. Depending on which power you choose, the solution to the book (finding the location of the F.E.A.R. meeting) will be different. Once you have solved it with one power, you can try it again with another.

And you may also monitor your success with your Hero Points score. When you overcome supervillains, you will be awarded Hero Points to allow you to compare the success of one adventure with another.

Because of these new features, the rules to Appointment with F.E.A.R. differ a little from other Fighting Fantasy Gamebooks. Combat is basically the same, but you will find several new sections in the following rules.

Before setting off to fight the super-villains of Titan City, you must first determine your own SKILL, STAMINA and LUCK scores by rolling dice as described below. On pages 22-3 there is an Adventure Sheet which you may use to record the details of your adventure. You are advised either to make records on the Adventure Sheet in pencil or to take photocopies of the page to use in future adventures.

# Skill, Stamina and Luck

Roll one die. Add 6 to this number and enter the total in the SKILL box on the Adventure Sheet. The exception to this is if you have Super Strength, in which case you will start with an automatic SKILL score of 13.

Roll two dice. Add 12 to the number rolled and enter the total in the STAMINA box.

There is also a LUCK box. Roll one die and add 6 to the number rolled. Enter this total in the LUCK box.

For reasons that will be explained below, SKILL, STAMINA and LUCK scores change constantly during an adventure. You must keep an accurate record of these scores and for this reason you are advised either to write small in the boxes or to keep an eraser handy. But never rub out your *Initial* scores. Although you may be awarded additional SKILL, STAMINA and LUCK points, these totals may never exceed your *Initial* scores.

Your SKILL score reflects both fighting and problem-solving skills; the higher your SKILL score the better. Your STAMINA score reflects your general constitution, your will to survive, your determination and overall fitness; the higher your STA-MINA score, the longer you will be able to survive. Your LUCK score indicates how naturally hucky a person you are.

# Battles

You will often come across pages in the book which instruct you to fight a villain of some sort. If so, you must resolve the combat as described below.

First record the villain's SKILL and STAMINA scores in the first vacant 'Villain Encounter Box' on your Adventure Sheet. The scores for each villain are given in the book each time you have an encounter.

Unlike other Fighting Fantasy Gamebooks, you may not kill the criminals you are fighting. As a sworn upholder of justice, you may not take the life of a super-villain, no matter how evil he or she may be. But they will be attempting to kill you! If you manage to reduce the STAMINA score of a criminal to zero, you have killed him and must lose 1 Hero Point as a result. When a criminal has been reduced to 1 or 2 STAMINA points, he will surrender himself to you.

The sequence of combat is then:

- Roll two dice once for the criminal. Add his SKILL score. This total is the criminal's Attack Strength.
- Roll two dice once for yourself. Add your own current skill score. This total is your Attack Strength.
- If your Attack Strength is higher than his, you have landed a blow: proceed to step 4. If the criminal's Attack Strength is higher than yours, he has landed a blow on you: proceed to step 5. If

both Attack Strengths are equal, you have avoided each other's blows: start the next Attack Round from step 1 above.

- You have landed a blow on the criminal, so subtract 2 points from his STAMINA score. You may use your LUCK here to do additional damage (see over).
- The criminal has landed a blow on you, so subtract 2 points from your STAMINA score. Again, you may use LUCK at this stage (see over).
- Make the appropriate adjustments to either the criminal's or your own STAMINA scores, and to your LUCK score (if you used LUCK).
- 7. Begin the next Attack Round (repeat steps 1-6). This sequence continues until the STAMINA score of the criminal has been reduced to 2 or less or your own STAMINA has been reduced to zero. A criminal with a STAMINA of 2 or 1 is semiconscious and will give himself up. A STAMINA score of zero (for you or the criminal) is equivalent to death. If you kill a criminal, you must lose 1 Hero Point, so be careful about this and use your LUCK when appropriate.



## Luck

At various times during your adventure, either in battles or when you come across situations in which you could be either lucky or unlucky (details of these are given on the pages themselves), you may call on your LUCK to make the outcome more favourable. But beware! Using LUCK is a risky business and if you are unlucky, the results could be disastrous.

The procedure for using your LUCK is as follows: roll two dice. If the number rolled is equal to or less than your current LUCK score, you have been Lucky and the result will go in your favour. If the number rolled is higher than your current LUCK score, you have been Unlucky and will be penalized.

This procedure is known as *Testing your Luck*. Each time you *Test your Luck*, you must subtract 1 point from your current LUCK score. Thus you will soon realize that the more you rely on your LUCK, the more risky this will become.

# **Using Luck in Battles**

On certain pages of the book you will be told to Test your Luck, and will be told the consequences of being Lucky or Unlucky. However, in battles, you always have the option of using your LUCK either to inflict a more serious blow on the criminal you have just hit, or to minimize the effects of a blow the criminal has just inflicted on you. If you have just landed a blow on the criminal, you may Test your Luck as described above. If you are Lucky, you have landed a severe blow and may subtract an extra 2 points from the criminal's STAMINA score. If you are Unlucky, however, the blow glanced off and you must restore 1 point to the criminal's STAMINA (i.e. instead of inflicting 2 points of damage, you have inflicted only 1).

If the criminal has just hit you, you may Test your Luck to try to minimize the effects. If you are Lucky, you have managed to avoid the full force of the blow. Restore 1 point of STAMINA (i.e. instead of taking 2 points of damage, you take only 1). If you are Unlucky, you have taken a more serious blow and must subtract 1 extra STAMINA point from your score.

Remember that each time you Test your Luck you must subtract 1 point from your own LUCK score.

## Restoring Skill, Stamina and Luck

Instructions for restoring your SKILL, STAMINA and LUCK scores will be given in the pages of the book as appropriate. STAMINA will be restored when you rest at home in the evening. STAMINA bonuses are difficult to come by, so be careful! LUCK points will be gained when you find some clues.

## Hero Points

As you defeat super-villains and solve crimes, you will be awarded Hero Points, to be recorded on your Adventure Sheet. Hero Points have nothing to do with your main objective, which is to locate the secret F.E.A.R. meeting and capture Vladimir Utoshski, the Titanium Cyborg. Hero Points are a measure of how successful you have been in your adventure. Each time you go through the book, record your Hero Points score and compare each adventure with previous ones. As you will find, if you try a different super power, the solution to the book will be different, so you can rate your own performances with each of the four powers.



## Clues

Whichever super power you begin the game with, you will have knowledge of two clues which will help you trace and capture Titan City's criminals. Indeed, you will not be able to find some of the villains without knowledge of the appropriate clues. In fact there are two types of clue. Some relate to the villains and their crimes – the ones you start with are of this type. Others relate to the secret F.E.A.R. meeting. Without finding the necessary clues to the meeting, you will never be able to prevent it, with disastrous results for Titan City! So bear in mind that you must find these F.E.A.R. clues, and remember also that, when you try the adventure using a different super power, the F.E.A.R. clues that you need will be held by different villains!

# SUPER POWERS AND CLUES

You are Jean Lafayette, the product of a dangerousbut successful – genetic experiment. Although seemingly normal as a child, it became apparent in your early teens that you were a far from ordinary human being. You are gifted with a superhuman power, which you have sworn to use only for the benefit of your fellow man. As the Silver Crusader, you are well known to the population of Titan City. Most people admire you, some distrust you, but all members of the underworld fear you. Only your parents, who are both dead, ever knew your real identity and the origin of your powers.

In the adventures ahead, you will begin with one of four powers. During your daily activities and encounters with disasters and super-criminals, you will have two objectives. First, you must learn the whereabouts of the secret meeting of F.E.A.R. (the Federation of Euro-American Rebels) which is due to take place within the next few days. This dangerous alliance of master-criminals and enemy agents is planning to overthrow the governments of the western world and establish their own rule. Secondly, you may assess your own performance as a superhero by trying to gain as many Hero Points as possible. Before you start each adventure, you may choose which super power to start with, from the four powers listed below. You will also start the game with knowledge of two clues. Following the description of each super power, you will find instructions on where to find your clues, which are hidden in the text of the adventure. Before you turn to reference 1 to start your adventure, choose your super power, locate and read the clues and enter the information on your Adventure Sheet.

## Super Strength

You have the strength of many men. The muscles of your immensely powerful legs and arms bulge through the fabric of your costume. They are developed to the point of perfection and, in combat situations, you always fight with a SKILL of 13. You also have the power to fly through the air at any speed you wish. This allows you to hover unsupported above the ground or to chase and catch up with the fastest jet.

To find the first of your clues, turn to reference 127. For your other clue, you may choose one from the following:

# **Psi-Powers**

You have extraordinary mental abilities. You are able to reach into the thoughts of most other humans (and some animals) to read their minds and influence them. You also have limited powers to make objects move mentally and even to change the very nature of some elements. However, using this power is an enormous mental effort for you. Each time you use your *Psi-Power*, you must deduct 2 STAMINA points.

Turn to 222 to discover your first clue. You may also choose one clue from the following:

## Enhanced Technological Skill (ETS)

Your considerable intelligence has allowed you to develop a whole collection of hi-tech gadgetry. Through advanced micro-circuitry designs, you have been able to miniaturize most of these gadgets so that they will fit conveniently into a special Accessory Belt worn around your waist. Whatever the situation, you are usually fortunate enough to have something appropriate to use. However, you have avoided developing weaponry in case any weapon you developed should ever fall into the wrong hands and be used by the criminal element to wreak untold havoc. You start the adventure with two clues, which must be chosen from the following list:

# **Energy Blast**

You are able to summon up electrostatic energy from within your own body and channel it out through your fingertips. You can aim these Energy Bolts at adversaries or objects and your control is such that you know before you aim how much force will be needed to deal with them. You have taken a personal oath that you will only stun any human target, no matter how villainous your opponent may be. When using Energy Blast, you need only determine whether or not your aim is true; if you hit a human opponent, the effect will be an automatic stun. Test your aim by rolling two dice. If the result is equal to or less than your SKILL score, the Bolt has hit. If the result is higher than your SKILL, you have missed and a normal battle must be fought or the situation must be resolved as per the instructions in the text. Sometimes you will not be able to use a second Bolt. Each time you use Energy Blast, you must deduct 2 STAMINA points.

Your first clue will be found at reference 88. For your second clue, you may choose one of the following:

# BACKGROUND

The time of your birth was an anxious moment for your parents and their doctors. Your mother had consented to undergo an experimental form of genetic surgery. The doctors had warned her of the dangers of the radiation experiments; their research programme was nowhere near complete. But this she already knew, for she herself was one of the researchers. The work had reached the stage where progress was impossible without testing it on a human subject. Your father had not fully understood the implications when he gave his consent, and eight pairs of apprehensive eyes watched your arrival into the world.



Their first reaction was one of relief. You certainly seemed a normal, healthy baby. Post-natal tests showed no physical deformities whatsoever. In fact, you appeared to be a fine specimen. In your younger years your development was carefully monitored with a seemingly endless series of physiological and psychological tests, all of which you passed with flying colours. The doctors and researchers congratulated themselves; their experiments were a complete success. However, the experiments had been conducted in a shroud of secrecy. Had the world known of the risks of the experiment, public outcry would have been overwhelming. It would certainly have put an end to further genetic research. And from your mother's point of view, she had no wish to have the world regard you as an experimental freak. Only a few knew what had really happened.

Over the years, the testing stopped as the doctors felt more and more certain that there was no need to monitor your progress. As fate would have it, it was just when this testing *stopped* that it became clear that you were anything but a normal child. Your latent superhuman powers did not show themselves until after the doctors had lost interest.

Your parents, who had become thoroughly fed up with the endless tests, decided that your extraordinary powers must remain a secret from the world. They had no wish to have you studied as some kind of freak for the rest of your life.

You have a regular job working in an office of a medium-sized company. But when duty calls, you become the Silver Crusader, upholder of justice; and you have taken an oath to serve in the fight against crime in Titan City. Apart from your own super abilities, you have one other device to aid you – your Crimewatch. This neat little device, worn around your wrist, receives and broadcasts transmissions to and from your two most important allies. You can be contacted by police headquarters through this Crimewatch and you can also summon the police to aid you. In addition, your friend and underworld contact Gerry the Grass is able to warn you of impending crimes through the Crimewatch.



Gerry the Grass has recently become aware of an important meeting about to take place within the next few days. Vladimir Utoshski, leader of F.E.A.R. (the Federation of Euro-American Rebels), has been summoning his aides-in-crime to meet in Titan City. Utoshski, also known as the Titanium Cyborg, is a super-villain whose field of expertise is the electronic enhancement of human abilities. He is part man, part machine – and very dangerous. Gerry the Grass has not yet found out where or when the meeting is due, but one thing is certain. Its purpose is to finalize plans for a scheme which would mean disaster for the western world. The meeting must be stopped! You must find out where and when this meeting is due to take place and prevent it at all costs . . .

## NOW TURN OVER



As you walk the ten blocks to work that morning, you can't help but feel that something is not quite right. You stop by a telephone booth to consider what it could be.

The sounds of the city are the usual 8 a.m. cacophony. Cars and buses bounce past along Clark Street, their drivers too sleepy even to try to avoid the pits and bumps in the road. A newspapervendor bawls an incomprehensible headline – something about a robbery – at the crowds of men and women milling past him on their ways to work. Overhead in the sky the rhythmic beating of a traffic 'copter's blades fades into the distance. An argument is taking place between an elderly businessman and an over-large woman with an untrained dog, whose sidewalk deposits have offended the businessman. There is nothing unusual . . . or is there?

The difference is only barely perceptible, but there is a distinct air of tension in the streets. There are nervous twitches in the eyes of the passers-by; the cars are accelerating and braking in a jittery manner – little things like that. To your heightened senses, the atmosphere is pregnant. Today will not be just another day.

Your thoughts are broken by the high-pitched wailing of a police siren. A yellow and black Cougar GS screeches round the corner and leaps ahead through the Clark Street traffic before swinging left

into Audubon Park. Behind it, the traffic settles back into its regular flow. Your attention drifts back to the argument. A small crowd has built up around the man and woman. Raised voices are taking one side or the other and the situation is beginning to look nasty. What will you do next:

You manage to seal the lid on the crate, thus trapping the creature that was Mustapha Kareem. Kareem's jacket fell off the Mummy's shoulders as you hurled it into the crate and now lies on the ground. You pick it up and rummage through the pockets. You find two pieces of paper inside. One bears the emblem of F.E.A.R. and you unfold it quickly. The bottom half of the paper is ripped off, but the message reads: 'Meeting in executive jet . . . The second piece of paper is a scribbled note which simply says 'Crate', followed by an Egyptian hieroglyphic character. You check the crates in the room. One bears a symbol identical to that on the note. Inside are a number of pieces of gold jewellerv which match those on the main exhibit! Kareem had been stealing these and replacing them with imitations! Having now exposed the fraud, you may hand the affair over to the police. Award yourself 4 Hero Points and turn to 276.

You hide behind the gate until Bronski is close. When you can hear his footsteps approaching, you spring out to confront him. The startled killer reaches into his coat and pulls out a weapon: a battery-powered electric knife! Resolve your combat with him:

'CHAINSAW' BRONSKI SKILL8 STAMINA8

If you manage to defeat him, turn to 93.

You arrive at the circus as preparations are being made for the evening's performance. Caravans are clustered around the huge big top and round the back are the animal cages. A dwarf dressed in a clown's outfit comes running over to you as you arrive. He cannot talk, but instead honks a bicycle horn excitedly, grabs your hand and pulls. He seems to want you to follow him. Will you follow him as he wishes (turn to 399)? Or will you head for the lion cages (turn to 310) or an important-looking caravan in the centre (turn to 223)?



You try valiantly to smash the door. But your efforts are futile against so solid a door. Your best plan would have been not to waste your strength on this door, because in trying to smash it, you injure yourself. Deduct 1 SKILL and 2 STAMINA points (if your power is Super Strength, deduct only 2 STAMINA points). Turn now to 60. How will you escape from your prison? There seems to be only one plan open to you. You will have to use a bolt of energy to blast through the door. But the door is ten centimetres of solid metal! Its weak spot must be the small glass window set in the door. You prepare yourself and unleash a controlled blast. The glass turns from red to yellow as it melts. The heat inside the chamber is tremendous, but a welcome rush of cool air hits your face as the glass drops away. There is just enough room for you to reach out and grasp the handle to release yourself. With great relief, you step out into the corridor. Voices are coming from behind a door at the far end of the passage and you step up, ready for action. Turn to 298.

You fight your way through the crowd until you reach a spot where you can just about see the cars arrive up the avenue over the heads of the crowd in front of you. Twenty minutes later, the cavalcade arrives and cheers go up from the crowd. As the President's car approaches, you catch sight of a man in front of you struggling with something. His hand comes free – he is holding a gun and is preparing to point it at the President! You are in your street clothes and cannot use your super powers, but you must do something to prevent the man getting a shot at the President. You leap on him from behind:

SKILL7 STAMINA6

After the second round of combat, turn to 359.

You grab the little thief by his shoulder and turn him round, telling him that he must not steal; he must work hard and eurn the money he needs to buy what he wants. A sneer breaks out across the boy's face and he reaches into his pocket as if to get the Munchie Bars. But when his hand comes out it is gripping a loaded pistol! His sneer changes to a sly smile as he pulls the trigger and, from this range, he cannot miss. Your life as a superhero is over . . .

You establish line-of-sight with the man and woman in the centre of the crowd and concentrate. As your powers take effect, their argument dwindles and ceases. They look around in astonishment at the crowd which has built up. The woman shrugs her shoulders and walks off with her dog. The man looks towards you and freezes. Keeping your Psi-Powers focused on him for as long as you are able, you realize this man is not as he appears. He is desperately trying to keep from you some dark secret. His thoughts go to the gold watch on his wrist but then he fights to keep the watch out of his mind. He briefly focuses on a pawnbroker's shop which is next to a diner. Could he be a pawnbroker? You will never know, for in the next instant he breaks line-of-sight and disappears into the crowd. You spring forward to try to relocate him, but it is no use. Meanwhile, the crowd has long since lost interest in its arguments and fifty wide-eyed faces are staring at you. You decide to leave. After changing, you may:

Head into Audubon Park Go to work Buy a paper Turn to 165 Turn to 341 Turn to 228 You leave the airport and head for home. What a day! You slump into a chair in front of the TV and relax with a long, cold drink. You may add 6 STAMINA points for the rest. One thing disturbs you. Your boss, Jonah Whyte, will be livid when you turn up for work tomorrow. You will have to invent some pretty convincing excuses . . . The next morning you set off to work early. You decide to travel by subway to make sure you get to work on time. But since when has a superhero's life ever been easy? 'HELP!' shouts a voice further up the crowded carriage. 'Pickpocket!' Oh, no . . . just what you needed. You force your way through the crowd on the busy train. As you reach the pickpocket's victim, that familiar beep - beep - beep sounds from your Crimewatch. Its electronic voice speaks: 'RADD SQUARE. HURRY.' You sigh. But what will you do? The train is pulling into a station and you will have to change trains immediately if you are to reach Radd Square quickly. If you want to do this, turn to 201. If you want to apprehend the pickpocket, turn to 185.



You fly up in the air to the floating vapour. As you approach it, you spin your body round in the air like a top. Your plan is working! You are sucking the brown cloud back down to the ground. As it swirls about, it begins to solidify and when you reach the ground, it has turned into the dazed personage of the Smoke. Although you have managed to defeat the arch-criminal – and you may award yourself 2 Hero Points for this – you have not managed to prevent him sending radio photographs of the doctor's notes to the headquarters of F.E.A.R. Turn to 162.

Your Energy Bolt smashes into the side of beef speeding towards you, but hardly slows it down at all. Perhaps the freezing cold has affected your Energy Blast. But you have no time to wonder about this now. You must take evasive action. Turn to 436. You race down the escalator after him. But he has quite a head start on you; and he knows that you will not use your powers with so many people about. You start to gain on him as you reach the first floor. He looks over his shoulder and sees how close you are. You can tell he is beginning to panic. Halfway down the last escalator, he strips off his jacket and flings it at your feet. Suddenly you are falling forwards, your feet ensnared in the chains dangling from the jacket. Damn! As you land in a heap at the foot of the escalator, you see him disappear out of the door into the street. You will never catch him now. You pick up the jacket and search through the pockets for possible clues. Stuffed in one pocket you find a crumpled piece of paper and your eyes light up as you see the mark of F.E.A.R. at the top! The message reads: 'Don't forget. We need the merchandise in time for our meeting on the 28th. Do not fail us.' At least your effort has not been entirely in vain. You return to the third floor to make sure the other three thugs are handed over to the police. Turn to 380.

You search his shop. The place is littered with cheap jewellery, cameras, electrical goods and tatty furs. The back room is much the same. There seems to be nothing here. You may either leave and try the diner next door (turn to 351), or try something else (turn to 368).

Wisneyland is swarming with holiday-makers enjoying their day out at the amusement park. The smell of candy-floss and hot dogs hangs in the air and, as you stroll about, youngsters clutching stuffed animals run laughing past you. Screams of delight from roller-coaster riders turning through the corkscrew break through the general hubbub. You are going to enjoy yourself today. Which ride do you want to try:

The Big Dipper? The Fun House? The Dodgems?

Turn to 187 Turn to 174 Turn to 357



You tie the three of them up and release Drew Swain, then summon the police on your Crimewatch. While you wait for them to arrive, you peruse the Mantrapper's fiendish traps. Apart from the bath trap which has made him famous (when the victim pulls the plug, the plug-hole opens up to swallow both him and the water), you are particularly impressed by a handkerchief net. When held by one corner and shaken, the handkerchief turns into a strong nylon net big enough and strong enough to trap a man. You run through the miscellaneous bric-à-brac which litters his work-bench and come up with what may provide useful information: you have found a diary. Reading through it, you learn that he has been in contact with Sidney Knox, a research assistant at the Murdock Nuclear Laboratories. Knox is a peaceful type who spends his spare time watching migratory birds from a tall observation tower at the Laboratory. But he is under the Mantrapper's control and will do his bidding. With this knowledge you may locate him easily should the need arise. If you are offered the opportunity to search for Knox, deduct 40 from the reference you are on at the time and turn to this new reference to locate him. You may add 1 LUCK point for this information. Eventually the police arrive and take charge. You may award yourself 3 Hero Points. Now turn to 428.

What a day! You slump into a chair in front of the TV and relax with a long, cold drink. You may add 6 STAMINA points for the rest. One thing disturbs you. Your boss, Jonah Whyte, will be livid when you turn up for work tomorrow. You will have to invent some pretty convincing excuses . . . The next morning you set off to work early. This time you will travel by subway to make sure you get to work on time. But since when has a superhero's life ever been easy? 'HELP!' shouts a voice further up the crowded carriage. 'Pickpocket.' Oh, no . . . Just what you needed. You force your way through the crowd on the busy train. As you reach the pickpocket's victim, that familiar beep - beep - beep sounds from your Crimewatch. Its electronic voice speaks: 'cow-FIELD DATRY. FAST.' Typical! Another dilemma! The train stops at a station only a block away from Cowfield Dairy. Will you leap out and see what is happening there (turn to 369), or will you instead aid the pickpocket's victim (turn to 185)?

The others are shocked at the defeat of their leader. They surrender to you. You lock them in their conference room and guide the jet back to Parker Airport where you hand them over to the authorities. Turn to 440.



#### 20

You spread the map out. It is a map of Titan City, and well used, by the looks of things. Fingers have rubbed the printing off one area and a small black cross marks the spot. It is approximately at the junction of 12th Street and 2nd Avenue. But there is no clue on the map as to what this could be. You fold the map up and put it back in your pocket. Turn to 86. The citizens of Titan City have turned out in their thousands to greet the President. They line both sides of 7th Avenue six deep, and the presidential car is still not due to arrive for half an hour. Spirits are high. There is much flag-waving and bands are playing in the streets as a prelude to the arrival. Will you spend the next half hour in a coffee bar waiting for the main procession to arrive (turn to 100), or will you find a place in the crowd which offers a decent view (turn to 7)?

At point-blank range, you fire an Energy Bolt into the Creature's chest. It howls in pain and releases its grip on the girders. You stand powerless before him. He orders you to leave and you have no choice but to obey him. Like a sleeping giant, the huge pistons and cogs of the engine room are motionless. Suddenly, the squeak of a door opening startles you! Hiding behind one of the huge flywheels, you watch as a sailor enters, squirts some oil on a couple of wheels, and leaves. Routine maintenance. You climb the stairs back up from the engine room. Turn to 368.





The Alchemist steps back and holds his tube up. Without warning, he dashes it on the floor and a pungent gas fills the bank. You fight to remain conscious, but to no avail. When you awaken, you are being shaken by a police officer. The Alchemists have disappeared, taking their booty with them. The cashiers and customers are likewise regaining consciousness, but two officers are kneeling over an elderly woman who does not stir. One of them looks up and shakes his head. She is dead! All eves turn to you. Had it not been for your intrusion, the Alchemists would no doubt have simply run off with their money and no one would have been hurt. A cloud of despair descends over you. You are indirectly responsible for the woman's death! Your confidence is shaken and you must lose I SKILL point. Lose 2 STAMINA points as well, for the effects of the gas. Turn now to 372.

Suspended in the mist, a small brown cloud is floating away from the house. If you have *Psi-Powers*, turn to 287. If you have *Energy Blast*, turn to 203. If you have *Super Strength*, turn to 11. Otherwise turn to 153.



30

What is the number of the building you are looking for on this avenue? Add the number to the number of the avenue and turn to this reference. If the result makes no sense, turn to 368. 31

Roll one die and consult the table below to find out what damage the dog does:

- 1, 2 or 3 The dog cuts you with its claw. Lose 2 STAMINA points.
- 4 or 5 The dog knocks you backwards into the wall. Lose 2 STAMINA points. It also breaks free and bites one of the bystanders (deduct 1 Hero Point in this episode).

You leave the Fun House puzzling over your find, but your questions are answered when you see a young boy crying by his bicycle outside. He has lost the key to the padlock. You hand it over to him. You may add 1 Hero Point for helping him. Turn to 103.

You visit the Grass as the Silver Crusader. He lives in a run-down part of town, in a dirty onebedroomed apartment. He is horrified to see you, as your appearance will surely blow his cover. But, as always, he has some interesting information. Apparently, the Mantrapper has control of the mind of Sidney Knox, a research assistant at the Murdock Nuclear Laboratories. Normally a passive type - he spends all his spare time in an observation tower at the Lab watching migratory birds - Knox has been implanted with a post-hypnotic suggestion. No one knows exactly what this is, but Gerry's information will help you. If you find yourself looking for Sidney Knox, deduct 40 from the reference you are on at the time and turn to this new reference. You may add 1 LUCK point for this information. You leave discreetly and go home. The rest of the evening is uneventful and you may add 6 STAMINA points for the rest. Turn to 215.

You head downtown towards the waterfront. But this is a large area to cover. Are you heading for the Occanaria Marina to check out the luxury yachts (turn to 370), or for Clancey Bay, a navy dockyard (turn to 317)?

What time of day are you expecting the meeting to take place? Add this time to today's date and add the result to this reference. If the resulting reference makes no sense, turn to 220.

The Bolt hits the creature square in the chest! It staggers a little, then turns towards you and roars. You try another, but the result is the same. Your Bolt has done no damage at all! The Devastator is composed of meteoric rock and cannot be harmed by your *Energy Blast*. It lunges at you with a great clubbed fist and knocks you flying across the room. Before you can recover, it has picked you up and flung you through the window. Luckily, you are still unconscious when you hit the ground, three storeys down . . .

Most are in the main vault, which is now locked, but a number are scattered around the floor outside the vault door. One of these contains some recently completed title deeds to Titan abattoir. They show that the abattoir has just been bought by a 'Sylvia Frost'. This name rings a bell. Sylvia Frost? Of course! The Ice Queen! If you find evidence of the Ice Queen's activities, you can use this information to locate her by deducting 20 from the reference you are on at the time and turning to this new reference. Now turn to **60**. You rush out of the control tower and zoom up into the sky towards the low-flying aircraft circling the airport. You reach it easily and enter through the emergency door release. The rush of air alerts the passengers and they gasp as they see the Silver Crusader enter. You close the door and motion for everyone to remain calm. Luckily, the cockpit door is closed and the Tormentor has not noticed your entry. The way is clear for you to surprise the villain. You swing open the cockpit door. Inside, the two frightened pilots are tied against one wall. At the controls is a shaggy-haired madman whose wide grin turns to a look of astonishment as you appear. You must spring on him quickly:

# THE TORMENTOR SKILLS STAMINA 9

If you defeat him within ten combat rounds, turn to 346. If you do not, turn to 376.





The sky clouds over as you enter the cemetery and, by the time you are halfway across, the atmosphere is decidedly spooky. A scraping noise to your left attracts your attention. The noise is coming from a recently dug grave and you step over to get a closer look. Your eyes widen as you see a movement in the soil on the top of the grave. Something is trying to get out! A hand reaches out of the soil and you are frozen to the spot as a huge shape lifts itself out of the pit. You recognize the creature: you have come across him once before. The webbed claws of the grey-skinned beast flex as it steps towards you. The Reincarnation! The beast that cannot be killed! Why on earth has he been buried in an ordinary grave? Will you spend the day at Wisneyland, the amusement park (turn to 15), or will you go downtown, perhaps to do some shopping (turn to 202)?

You streak out after the plane. As it is taking off, you catch up with it and force your way inside through one of the emergency entrance doors. Inside, the meeting has already begun in a special conference room which has been built into the plane. But your entrance has not gone unnoticed. As you step inside, the six delegates rise to their feet. All are overawed by your entry - all except one. 'Stand back,' growls a deep, electro-assisted voice. 'Our puny visitor is no match for the Titanium Cyborg." The others watch as the huge, bald-headed shape steps forward. You run down the hallway, looking for a fireextinguisher. There is not one to be seen. Finally you find one in an empty room and bring it back into the lab. You break the seal and point it at the boiling bottle. Nothing happens! You check the instructions and realize that the extinguisher has not been serviced for two years! Do you want to go into the drug store (turn to 313), the supermarket (turn to 160) or the computer shop (turn to 264)? It snaps its jaws around the youngster, whose cries turn to gurglings then to silence as a red cloud spreads through the water. You, and the onlookers on the beach, are horrified! Apparently the Ocean Behemoth has been seen in Titan harbour and the man knows the purpose of the huge fishcreature's visit. It seeks revenge on the one who defeated it a year ago. You make a mental note to explore the harbour as soon as you can. Now turn to 157.

To your horror, you can see the driver of the car and his passenger in the back seat, struggling with the doors. The fire is spreading and they cannot get out! Will you step round the corner and change into the Silver Crusader (turn to 23), or will you wait to see whether the police have the situation under control (turn to 229)?

Where are you heading as you leave Wisneyland? Will you make your way downtown to do some shopping (turn to 202), or go home. If you decide to go home, you may either want to rest for the evening, in which case you may gain 6 STAMINA points (turn to 327), or you may wish to sacrifice STAMINA gain and spend the evening at the theatre if you can get a ticket for tonight's performance of 'Rats' (turn to 43). You step, as the Silver Crusader, towards the scene. A police officer spots you and helps you through the crowd, which parts as you are recognized. On the ground in the centre of the crowd is the body of a man – a man of some means, by the looks of his expensive clothing. Lying next to him is a goldtrimmed briefcase. Will you go to the army base (turn to 342), or will you follow up the earlier summons by your Crimewatch to Stanley Pool (turn to 97)?

### 108

There is a new menace in town, as Daddy Rich's lawyers have just got him off a murder charge. He is an eccentric millionaire who has everything money could buy. He now gets his kicks by murdering innocent victims and revels in their fear. He has very expensive tastes and lives in a penthouse apartment at 113, 58th Street.

#### 109

For all your strength, you will not be able to defeat the Mummy. Instead, when you have reduced it to 4 STAMINA points, you may use your strength to hurl it into an open crate and seal the lid. You may capture it, but not kill it. Resolve your battle:

If you manage to trap the creature, turn to 2.

You lean towards her meaningfully and whisper your password. 'Eh?' she asks, puzzled. 'What did you say? Speak up!' You try again. This time she looks at you as if you were some sort of crank. Her eyes pass up and down you and she frowns. 'Are you a crazy? Be off with you, or I'll call the police!' You decide that she probably will call the police and decide to take a quick look round the place first. Turn to 199-

You change back into street clothes and get a move on. You are late for work again! You turn the corner on to Clark Street and stop as you pass Harrold's Department Store. A thought has crossed your mind: you could stop and buy your boss a present of some kind to apologize for being late. But then this would make you even later. Is it worth it? If you wish to go in and look for a suitable gift, turn to 429. If you want to get to work as quickly as possible, turn to 301. The police and bank officials fall silent as you step through the door of the bank. You are hoping that the Tigers will have the edge: they recently spent over a million on fullback 'Streak' Gordon and you are anxious to see how he turns out. But neither side is able to maintain the advantage and by half-time a last-minute push by the Mohawks has levelled the score. The second half starts with a fabulous scoring run by 'Streak' Gordon. But, amid the excitement, screams of terror are coming from the crowd. Part of the stand is collapsing! You rush off to change and then nip underneath the stand to find out what is happening. You are amazed by what you see.

The collapse is not a structural fault, as you thought. Standing between two iron girders is a huge, hulking creature with brown, scaly skin, which is shaking the girders and groaning with the effort. You order it to stop. It sees your shimmering uniform and roars loudly: 'PUNY HUMAN!' it speaks. 'WHAT CAN YOUR PITIFUL EFFORTS HOPE TO ACHIEVE AGAINST THE CREA-TURE OF CARNAGE? MANY MUST DIE BE-FORE I WILL BE STILL.' You fly into the air over the Android, grab it and hoist it up out of harm's way into the roof of the building. Finding a clear spot, you release it. It crashes down to the ground and fizzles, its broken limbs twitching harmlessly. You search for Vladimir Utoshski from your vantage point, but can see no sign of him and return to the stand. No one is now manning the stand, and you start rummaging through Utoshski's papers to see if you can find any clues. Only one piece of paper looks interesting; it is from the Parker Airport Authority, advising him that his booking requirements have been made. You also find a small pen-like gadget in a box labelled 'Circuit Jammer'. You decide it could be quite useful and take it with you. Add 4 Hero Points for defeating the Android. The dressing-room shows obvious signs of a struggle having taken place recently. Theatrical clothes, ripped and soiled, lie strewn about the place among smashed bottles of theatrical make-up. Evidently the kidnapper and his victim had something of a fight here. But where are they now? The open window gives the game away. It leads out into the parking-lot behind the theatre and, as you poke your head out to look for the Serpent, you hear the sound of squealing tyres. The Serpent has escaped with his victim! You will never catch him now. You change back into your street clothes and make for home. Turn to 79.

### 118

Your information was correct. As you arrive at the junction, sounds of a commotion are coming from the bank. There are no signs of police. You look through the glass door. Two men in white lab coats are rummaging through the cashiers' drawers and stuffing notes in sacks. Another is grasping a testtube rack containing five tubes of liquid and is holding another in the air ready to throw it at the cashiers and customers, who are huddled in a corner. A direct hit! Your blast strikes the ripper shark in the middle of its back, causing a gruesome explosion. Bits of shark meat and entrails fly high up in the air and rain down on the beach. The onlookers are revolted. Many of them are spattered with the creature's remains. Disgusted faces turn towards you. 'Trust that Crusader idiot to create such a mess. Ugh! It's nauseating! What was wrong with diving in and fighting the poor shark? Dumb animal – it didn't know any better . . .' Your jaw drops. What's wrong with these people? You've just saved a boy from almost certain death! With your head bowed, you leave the beach to change into your street clothes and head for home. Turn to 18.

You hand the Tiger Cat in at police headquarters. You may add 2 Hero Points for this arrest. The police sergeant at the desk is puzzling over a piece of paper which has been handed in by a little old lady. She thinks it might be important. He lets you have a look at it, thinking it might be a clue. It reads: 'Watch for the sign of the Mantrapper – a metal slug with a letter M engraved on it.' This is a useful clue and you may add 1 LUCK point for seeing it. If you find evidence of the Mantrapper's activities, add 60 to the reference you are on at the time and turn to this new reference. Turn now to 67. You leave the Murdock Laboratories and head back into town. Walking along Danvers Street, you see a crowd huddled round a shop window and you step up to see what is going on. You cannot hear what is being said, but you recognize the face on the photograph which appears briefly on the screen. It is Giorgio Schultz, better known as the Poisoner. When you are in the vicinity of his new residence and are given the opportunity to look for him, subtract 50 from the reference you are on at the time and turn to this new reference to find him.

The gang has not noticed and you manage to shoo the boy and his mother away. If you have Super Strength, turn to 172. If you have ETS, turn to 210. If you have Energy Blast, you may not use it as there are too many passers-by. If you do not have Super Strength or ETS, turn to 243.



You follow your clue's instructions to a seedy industrial area of town and arrive at the Titan abattoir. What sort of a place is that for a super-villain like the Ice Queen? The answer dawns on you as you pass a door leading to the refrigeration plant. Cautiously you open the door and step into the freezer room. Your breath freezes and you feel the cold at the back of your throat as you search through the sides of beef hanging in the room. A sound from behind you startles you. 'So!' speaks a woman's voice. If fewer than four escaped, return to 120 (note this reference), if you defeat them, to face the dogs left inside the Lab.

You jump over the counter and change quickly into the Silver Crusader. You will have to be careful not to stay too close to the Fire Warriors, as their flames will burn you. Grasping the door by its frame, you heave it off its hinges. You grab both passengers and lift them away to safety. The man in the back, a middle-aged man in a fur-collared overcoat wearing an expensive-looking silver watch, is suffering from shock. He is delirious. As you lift him out of the car, he is mumbling incoherent bits of sentences: 'Fear summit . . . Must make meeting . . . Opposite number 35. . . Mustn't forget . . .' You hand him over to the ambulance-men to take care of him. And just in time, as the fire hits the tank and the car explodes. Your duty done, you may now nip off to change clothes and return to work. An old man is attending to the girl in the water and another has gone to phone an ambulance. 'What is happening to the world?' he asks. 'Where does a creature like that come from? I have never seen anything like it before, except in my worst *dreams*. It's this new-fangled technology, I think. Creates super weapons in space and monsters on the earth. Bah! Sometimes I'm glad my time will soon be up. But Crusader, thank you for saving us. We all owe you our lives.' You can add 2 Hero Points for defeating the beast. You still don't know where it has come from, unless the old man has given you a clue. If you wish to try an address, add the street number to this reference to get there. Otherwise turn to 71. 139

Daddy Rich pulls out a long-bladed silver knife and his two thugs do likewise. Fight his two bodyguards one at a time:

First BODYGUARD	SKILL 8	STAMINA9
Second BODYGUARD	5KILL7	STAMINA 8

If you defeat them, you may take on Daddy Rich himself:

DADDY RICH

SKILL9 STAMINA8

If you capture all three, you may turn them over to the authorities and award yourself 3 Hero Points. Then turn to 73.



Knox lies unconscious on the ground and your attention turns to the reactor. You are looking for Vladimir Utoshski and he is a powerful adversary. With this you will stand a better chance.' You thank the Director for his gift. It may well come in handy. Turn to 125.

Where do you want to begin your investigations? The Fun House's main attractions are buzzing with people, although most are now staring at you with open eyes. Will you check the 'Rotating Room' (turn to 439), the trampolines (turn to 90) or the 'Hall of Mirrors' (turn to 212)?



You change into the Silver Crusader and head for the Biochemistry Department. There are no signs of panic; everything seems just like any other day. You make inquiries and find that a Professor Murdock is working on aldehyde experiments on the top floor. When you reach his Laboratory, the Professor is sweating profusely. 'Crusader!' he says, relieved to see you. 'My experiment has got out of hand! The temperature is building up! I fear I may have caused a disaster!' In the corner of the Lab, a complicated array of chemical equipment is shuddering. At one end a bottle is boiling madly. If you have *ETS*, turn to 295. Otherwise turn to 339.



How will you escape? You search in your Accessory Belt for something to use. You pull out your Lasertorch and begin to cut away at the door. In certain instances, these dreams seem to have come true. These are only rumours, but the identity of the child is known. He is Timothy Grant and lives on rooth Street.

#### 153

There is nothing you can do but watch the brown cloud float into the distance. The damage has been done. The Smoke, who has the ability to change into an ethereal form, has been through the doctor's notes and sent radio photographs to the headquarters of F.E.A.R. Turn now to 162.



#### 154

You speed off back to Titan City and arrive at the Council Buildings. Everyone seems surprised at your visit. The day has been a peaceful one. Being a holiday, there are few people about. There certainly seems to be no danger. Your Crimewatch beeps again: 'SORRY. FALSE ALARM.' Just what you needed! Turn to 311. 155

The noise from outside has made the Alchemists nervous. They tie up their sacks and race into the street to escape. Turn to 243.



#### 156

You jump over the counter and, while no one is looking, change into the Silver Crusader. You are well prepared for outbreaks of fire and you take the Micro Extinguisher from your Accessory Belt. Stepping up to the villains, you douse them with a blast of carbon dioxide and extinguish their flames. Coughing and spluttering, they give themselves up to you. Turn to 380.



While you are trying to pry more information out of the man, you forget about the time. Suddenly the noise from the crowd outside swells up. The President is arriving! You leave the table and push your way out into the street. But before you can catch a glimpse of the procession, a loud crack sounds, followed by shouts and screams. You freeze, Surely noff That crack sounded like a gunshot! And from the reaction of the crowd, your fears could well have been realized. You nip inside a doorway and change into the Silver Crusader. When you fight your way through the crowds to the President's car, it is all over. He has been shot neatly through the chest and killed immediately. The bullet has been dug out of the car seat and you turn it over in your hand. Four letters are engraved in it: F-E-A-R. The outlawed organization has succeeded in assassinating the President! He is surprised to see you but assures you that, as far as he knows, everything is in order. He offers to double-check all his treasures to make sure nothing has disappeared. Do you wish him to do this (turn to 416), or will you ask him to get someone to show you round (turn to 135)?

The curator is mildly amused at your suggestion that his stuffed animals could have anything to do with the killings. 'I see,' he chuckles, with more than a little mockery in his tone. 'The elephant stepped off his pedestal and told his cleaners, "Excuse me, won't you. I'm just off out for a stroll round the grounds.'' And you think the tiger somehow passed right through its glass case, came downstairs - through the crowds, who didn't notice anything odd - left for a morning in Audubon Park and then returned at lunch-time? I thought you superherotypes were supposed to be bright . . .' You feel a bit foolish for even suggesting it. You decide to leave. You decide to return to town. You have already missed part of the day and Jonah Whyte will be furious when you return to work. You arrive just in time. As you are about to enter the building, three men turn the corner towards you. In his gold and furs, Daddy Rich is returning home, flanked by his two burly bodyguards! They hesitate when they see you. Speckles of blood on his cuffs and shoes confirm your suspicions. If you have *Energy Blast*, turn to 371. Otherwise, turn to 139 to confront Daddy Rich.

With your Super Strength, you pick up a heavy sidewalk sign outside the next-door store. As the Alchemists emerge, you fling it at them. A strike! The sign smashes into them, knocks two of them out and leaves the third so groggy that it is an easy matter for you to capture him. Turn to 336. 'So!' laughs Dr Macabre. 'We are honoured to have the famous Silver Crusader witness our little shopping trip. Beware, my beauties. Guard your minds well.' You concentrate on Macabre himself and can gradually feel his will slipping as you take control of his mind. Eventually you feel you have captured his will and you order him to bring his creations out of the drug store. The three figures follow their master's orders and they walk towards you. You concentrate hard, trying to force droplets of water out of the air to extinguish the flames. But it is no use. One of them puts his hand on a counter of socks and flames begin to rise. You had better act quickly. Turn to 133.



#### 179

You find yourself at the foot of a three-storey building. A scruffy-looking Chinese laundry is open on the ground floor. By the front door are stairs which go up to the other floors. A nameplate by the stairs reads: 'Chomsky and Sons: Exporters in Biomechanical Engineering'. Will you go in the Chinese laundry (turn to 266), or will you investigate Chomsky and Sons (turn to 44)? You rush to the edge of the water and scan the surface. Thirty metres out from the beach you find what you are looking for. The tell-tale black fin of a huge ripper shark is cutting its way towards the beach. Directly in its path is a young boy, and in seconds the shark will have reached him! You have one chance to use *Energy Blast* on the creature before it reaches the struggling boy. Roll two dice. If the number rolled is *less than or equal to* your SKILL score, turn to 123. The familiar bleeping on your wrist alerts you. Your Crimewatch is receiving a message. The electronic voice speaks two words: 'PARKER AIRPORT.' This time the voice is warning you of another incident, at 'PETER LABORATORIES.' You have no indication of which is more urgent. Where will you go? The two powers struggle against each other, backwards and forwards, as if both energy sources were armwrestling. You worry about the Laser's power source, but then you see signs that she is weakening. Her icy shield falls back and eventually disappears, and she squeals in pain as the laser heat which would be no more than mildly uncomfortable to an ordinary person - burns her. She pleads with you to stop and offers you some information which will be useful. You release the button. 'Keep it off' she screams. 'I will tell you what I know about the F.E.A.R. meeting you are trying to locate. I don't know exactly where, but the meeting is certainly somewhere on 3rd Avenue!' With your device trained on her, you bind her hands and feet. Turn to 241.

Warning the police and staff to hide behind cover, you release a ferocious blast at the vault. The metal smoulders and melts a little, but the door does not open. You breathe heavily and beads of sweat break out across your forehead. The blast was highly charged and you must lose 2 STAMINA points. You are not sure whether or not you have the power to break through the solid steel door. If you wish to try again, turn to 275. If you don't want to risk losing any more STAMINA, turn to 60.



# 184

You land a fair blow on the creature. But rather than being knocked back, the Mummy's chest collapses under the blow and then re-forms. Your punch has done nothing! Staring in disbelief, you are off guard as the creature fastens its hands around your neck. Your struggles are futile, as its hands tighten their grip. This is the end of your career as the Silver Crusader . . .



185

You rush up to a puny-looking bespectacled man who is shaking with fright. 'There!' he cries, pointing to a man running up through the next carriage. 'He . . . he's stolen my wallet!' You race after him. No one else moves; they don't want to get involved. If only you could change into the Silver Crusader. Roll two dice and compare the total with your SKILL score. If the total is *less than or equal to* your SKILL, turn to 166. If the total is *greater than* your SKILL, turn to 106. You quickly pull a Power Drainer from your Accessory Belt and attach it to the Android's back. You wait for its actions to slow down as your device begins to drain its internal batteries. But nothing happens! A light on the Power Drainer comes on. Its power supply has run down! You curse and think desperately about what else you could use. The answer comes from a man in the crowd who has been watching the demonstration. 'Try this,' he shouts, throwing you a small pen-like device. Roll two dice and compare the total with your SKILL. If the roll *exceeds* your SKILL, turn to 224. Otherwise turn to 415.

Just before the pawnbroker passed out, you managed to catch a strong mental image. He was obviously concerned about something, and a vision of a secret trapdoor flashed through his mind. You search the shop and indeed you find a trapdoor, hidden underneath the counter. You open it and step down into a small chamber. A door leads off from the chamber. Voices are coming from behind the door and a line of light comes from underneath it. Turn to 298.

You find there is a new Michael Blackson album called 'Willer', all about spooks and ghouls, and decide to buy it. You go straight home to listen to it. Turn to 327.

You arrive at Central Hospital and ask at the desk about the strange admission. You are regarded suspiciously and one nurse, turning her nose up, says: 'Why do you want to know? Are you one of those gutter-press reporters?' You show her the emblem on the chest of your costume, but she is unimpressed. Finally, a police officer fills you in. The Serpent has a powerful secret weapon – his poisonous bite. Each time he hits you, roll one die. A roll of 1 or 2 indicates a bite and the poison will take effect. Deduct 1 SKIII. point each time you are bitten. However, the effects of the bite are only temporary. You will recover your SKILL after one full day. If you defeat the villain, turn to 432. Having defeated the shark, you turn to the young boy, who is splashing about in the water, terrified. You calm him down, lift him out of the sea and carry him back to the beach, where his sobbing mother is waiting. She thanks you again and again and wants to know if she can do anything in return. Her uncle runs a circus and she could get you the best seats. You humour her and thank her for her generous offer, but insist that there is really no need. But your protests are of no avail. She writes down a telephone number, 444-5666, and tells you to ring a 'Captain Menagerie' any time you would like to see his show. She goes on and on about this uncle of hers. She tells you that he is the ringmaster of a circus and has strange habits. He has a secret office reached underneath the lion's cage where he keeps his money and papers. This information may be useful to you. If you ever need to find him, you may search for him by adding 50 to the reference you are on when you reach a lion's cage. By now this woman is becoming a pest. You excuse yourself. You really must be on your way. After secretly changing back into your street clothes, you head for home. Turn to 18.





You fly up towards the central dome of the Fun House. Sure enough, your information was correct. High up the wall of the Fun House is a door. You alight outside the door, burst inside and startle a hunched figure dressed in a colourful jester's costume. He grabs for a piece of paper on the table in front of him and tries to stuff it into his mouth! But you are too quick for him. You manage to stop him eating the paper and must now fight him:

# SCARLET PRANKSTER SKILL9 STAMINA8

If you defeat him, turn to 333.



199

You search round the premises for signs of criminal activity. But all are deserted except one, in which a middle-aged man is asleep at his desk. He is naturally startled at your arrival and asks if he can help. Apparently business has not been good recently. There doesn't seem to be anything strange going on here. Turn to 368.

### 200

Your Bolt misses and the Fire Warrior piles into you, fists swinging. You manage to fight him off, but not before he has given you some nasty burns. Lose 4 STAMINA points. While you are recovering, the four Fire Warriors make off down the escalator and out of the shop. The shop staff are putting out the fires that have been caused, and they look at you scornfully. 'I thought this Crusader character was supposed to be a hero,' sneers one. 'Pretty pathetic if you ask me.' You limp off downstairs and leave the shop. After finding a suitable place to change back into your street clothes, you head for work. Turn to 301.



Radd Square is one of Titan's City's most pleasant areas. On a sunny day, the cool sprinkling of the fountain is refreshing and the blossoming cherry trees make it a picturesque place for the locals to eat their lunch and chat. The crowd you have noticed has gathered round the fountain. You change into the Silver Crusader and step over to see what is happening. As you arrive, you hear a piercing scream and panic suddenly hits the crowd. They turn and flee from the fountain. You rush forward to see what is happening. Rising out of the water is a huge figure, some four metres high. Its vast, bulky shape is green and scaly. It opens its huge jaws and leans forwards, snatching a fleeing woman and holding her high. You leap up to fight the creature. If you have Super Strength, turn to 272. If you have Psi-Powers, turn to 326. If you have Energy Blast, turn to 367. If you have ETS, turn to 404.

### 201

Strolling downtown, you stop first at the bank to get some cash. Next stop is a pizza parlour for a bite to eat. You take a stool facing out across Banner Street and watch the shoppers passing as you eat your pizza. On the far side of the road is a man you recognize. It is Drew Swain, a retired millionaire who made his fortune manufacturing the collection tins used by charities. He steps into a baker's shop: when he comes out, something strange happens. He takes a step forward and suddenly freezes, held like a statue in an off-balance pose. A blue van draws up and obscures your view. When the van drives off, Swain is gone! You saw it with your own eyes! But it happened so quickly that you are now a long way behind the kidnappers. Will you nip to the toilets in the back of the shop and change costume? If so, will you follow the van (turn to 151), or ask questions at the bakery (turn to 41)? If you are determined to have an afternoon off and to do nothing, turn to 428.



#### 203

You aim an Energy Bolt into the brown vapour. If you miss, turn to 153. If you hit, the brown cloud swirls and begins to solidify as it drifts down to the ground. When it reaches the ground, it has reformed into the body of a dark-skinned man. You have captured the Smoke! However, you have not managed to prevent him sending radio photographs of the doctor's notes to the headquarters of F.E.A.R. Nevertheless, you may add 2 Hero Points for the arrest and turn to 162.



204

As you summon up your power, the mutant's attention switches to you. You release the blast and Sidney Knox blinks. To your horror, it turns around in the air and heads back towards you, hitting you in the chest. You must lose 1 SKILL and 3 STAMINA points for this. You may now either rush in to attack him (turn to 33), or back away to nurse your injury and leave the Lab (turn to 125). Extracting a Microlaser from your Accessory Belt, you step up to the car door to start to cut it open. 'Get out of it,' snaps an angry fireman. 'What're you trying to do, fancy pants? Put us all out of work? This is a job for professionals, not some peacockcostumed amateur!' You try to reason with the man, explaining that your Microlaser will do the job in half the time it would take him. 'Okay, hot shot,' he says. 'Let's see this fancy gizmo.' You flick the button. Nothing happens! Red-faced, you step back and let the firemen cut away the door. What a time for a malfunction! You sneak off into a side-alley, change clothes and walk back upstairs to work. Turn to 398.

You withdraw a Sonic Confuser and prepare to use it on the gang. But an instant before they emerge, you realize this may not be such a good idea. There are too many innocent bystanders to be certain that your gadget will not harm them too. If you wish to use it anyway, turn to 406. If you instead put it away and fight the Alchemists, turn to 243.

### 211

Papers in his briefcase identify the man as Wayne Bruce, President of Euro-American Security Inc. There are also documents from his lawyer which relate to divorce proceedings. Other than these, there appears to be nothing else out of the ordinary in his case. Do you wish to visit his home to talk to his wife (turn to 195), will you head for his office (turn to 233), or will you leave this apparently simple, but brutal, mugging in the hands of the police (turn to 73)?



#### 212

Apart from making you large, small, fat, thin, long and short, the mirrors do not seem to hold any secrets. You are making little progress here. You overhear someone making comments about how dangerous he thinks the Big Dipper is. Will you go and check it out (turn to 187), or is it time you were making for home (turn to 103)? 213

Two dogs are not fully under your control. As you step into the room, they push past you and rush into the screaming crowd outside. Your first duty must be to deal with these beasts:

You may want to communicate telepathically with one of the passengers – someone who may be strong enough to grapple with the villain (turn to 308). If you have another plan, turn to 176. 217

Before she fell unconscious, your *Psi-Powers* picked up a strong feeling of fear. The Tiger Cat was thinking about a meeting that she couldn't afford to miss. Of course! F.E.A.R.! You concentrate your thoughts, but can only glimpse one piece of information before she blacks out. The meeting will be on 5th Avenue. But this is a long road. However, you can get no more information. Turn to 124.



### 218

You make a promise to yourself. Tomorrow you are going to arrive at work on time. With that in mind, you can decide either to stay in and rest for the evening (turn to 337), or go out to see a show. You have heard that 'Rats', the all-star musical by Lloyd Webber-Andrews, is playing to packed houses. If you fancy a night on the town, turn to 43.

The cool air is refreshing and allows you to gather your thoughts. You must anticipate the F.E.A.R. meeting if you are to prevent their master-plan from succeeding. If only you knew where it was to be held, and . . . Thump! You feel a heavy blow across the back of your head and you drop to your knees. A rough accent says: 'Just get the money and let's get going. Quick!' A hand searches through your pockets for your cash. Though groggy, you know what is happening. You are being mugged! You could, if you wished, fight back, but that would mean you having to reveal your secret identity. Or you could let them think they have knocked you out - you have very little money on you, anyway. Will you fight back (turn to 230), or let them rob you (turn to 279)?

### 220

You wait for some time, but nothing happens. Eventually you give up. Puzzled about the whole affair, you decide to leave the airport and catch a taxi home. The driver has his radio on. You approach a grand caravan painted in gay colours. There is no reply when you knock on the door, so you push it open. Inside, the caravan is tastefully decorated and photographs of circus acts line the walls. But no one is about. You can leave the circus and go to either the zoo (turn to 408) or the Natural History Museum (turn to 365).

### 224

You reach forward to grab the girl. Your clutching fingers manage to catch hold of one of the straps on her dungarees. But the material is not strong. The strap breaks and the helpless girl plunges over the side of the carriage to her death! Panic breaks out and the riders' screams continue until the ride is over. Desolate, you decide you have had enough of Wisneyland. Turn to 103.



As the bus comes into Radd Square, you notice an excited crowd of people gathered in the centre of the square. Will you investigate the disturbance (turn to 201), or ignore it and continue back to work (turn to 435)?



#### 226

Where will you head for now? If you wish to make that visit to your aunt, turn to 134. If you prefer to go downtown to see if you can get tickets for a special concert that Georgie Boy and the Vulture Club are giving, turn to 122.

## 227

For capturing the Poisoner, you may award yourself 4 Hero Points. Before leaving the reservoir, you go through his pockets and come across an interesting clue. The Beast-King has escaped from jail and is planning a raid on Titan zoo. You note this information. Turn to 107.



You study the newspaper. Under the headline 'ALCHEMISTS IN CLEVELAND', the story describes how the notorious gang of chemical experts entered a branch of the Cleveland Bank on 113th Street at 4 a.m., bypassed the alarm, locked the security guard in the vault on a time-switch and made off with a number of safe-deposit boxes. Although it was impossible to tell how much was taken in the raid, claims from the owners of the deposit boxes are now coming in. Apart from the cash, many valuable papers had been stolen. Do you want to investigate the robbery as the Silver Crusader (turn to 112), or will you see what else is in the paper (turn to 386)?



Sirens sound as first a fire-engine, then an ambulance, come racing round the corner. From the other direction, *another* ambulance arrives. The firemen get to work on cutting the doors away to release the occupants, both of whom are injured and suffering from shock. But the ambulance drivers are in the middle of a heated argument about who should pick up the patients! Meanwhile the fire has spread to the tank. They give themselves up without a struggle and you hand them in at the local police station. But your career is over. Word of your true identity will soon get about from these two. And when it does, the lives of all your family and friends will be in danger from criminals seeking revenge. The time has come for you to hang up your cape . . .

You take out a vial of Concentrated Antifreeze and rush out into the centre of the ice. Removing the stopper, you pour it on to the ice around the two girls. A puddle of water spreads around them and their struggles allow them to move more freely. Moments later they are free and you help them to the side of the pool, where friends are waiting with warm blankets. You may add 2 Hero Points for the rescue, then you must leave the pool (turn to **362**). But you may, if you wish, check the heating-plant first before you go (turn to **347**).

Turn to 316.

At the offices of Euro-American Security, the staff are shocked to hear of their President's murder. Wayne Bruce's secretary, an attractive blonde with dark eyes, introduces you to the company's senior executives. But none can shed any light on why anyone should want to murder their boss. You decide that the incident must have been the mugging it seemed and that you will leave it to the police. Turn to 73.

### 234

You react immediately and swing the wheel full circle, taking your foot off the pedal at the same time. Your car lurches and stops dead. Although you have avoided hitting the boy, the woman in Purple 10 does not have the same speed of reaction. Her car hits the boy, who drops unconscious to the ground. The power stops immediately and a crowd of people, led by the boy's shricking mother, flood on to the track. The boy is still breathing. An ambulance arrives to take him to hospital. You are feeling somewhat shocked by the near-disaster and decide you have had enough of Wisneyland for the day. Turn to 103.



235

Your hands drop, as if in submission to his orders. Your right hand moves towards a pouch on your Accessory Belt. 'Not so fast, Crusader!' the Poisoner warns. 'Touch that belt and this vial disappears into the water supply.' He has spotted your plan. Turn to 25.





Quick as a flash, you fly out over the roof, come up in front of the man and hit him with a blow that knocks the gun out of his hand. He falls back on to the roof and you must resolve your battle with him:

ASSASSIN

SKILL9 STAMINA 8

If you defeat him, turn to 258.

### 237

You step up to the door and wait for the frantic barking to die down. It does not. In fact the dogs are dawing and jumping at the door, which is beginning to weaken. You grasp the handle and prepare to rush in. Roll one die. If you roll 1–4, turn to 132. If you roll 5 or 6, turn to 375. When you arrive at the house, a young boy opens the door, 'Wow!' he gasps. 'The Silver Crusader come to see us! Er . . . if you want to see my dad, he's not in. But you can come in, anyway.' You explain that it's him you want to see and you ask whether he's had any interesting dreams recently. He tells you about this 'really neat' one he's just had about a huge green monster rising out of a fountain and attacking people. Your suspicions were correct. This is the 'Brain Child' you were warned about. His dreams are so vivid that they actually come to life. His mother appears and you explain the situation. With this information you can search for such a secret room, if you arrive at a lion's cage, by adding 50 to the reference you are on at the time and turning to this new reference. You may add 1 LUCK point for this information. Leave when you are ready and return to Radd Square (turn to 71).

There is no one about to help you. What can you do? Simply leave the creature where it lies? You decide the best thing to do is to place it back in its grave and cover it until you can bring the police to dispose of the Reincarnation more effectively. You cannot gain any Hero Points for this encounter, as no one has seen you defeat it! Such are the rewards of a devotion to public service . . . Now you continue by setting off once more for your aunt's. Turn to 76.

The Princess's sarcophagus, in all its splendour, is watched by three security guards. Priceless golden treasures adorn the exhibit. There is no doubt that any of these would make rich pickings for a thief. You talk to the guards and compare the exhibit with its description in the catalogue. All seems to be in order. It seems that you are wasting your time here, and you decide to leave. Turn to 276.

### 241

The police arrive to take care of the Ice Queen. You may add 4 Hero Points for capturing her and then you must leave the abattoir. Turn to 362.



A huge crowd has gathered round Titan City Library. The police are struggling to keep them away from the building to allow both the army and the fire-brigade to get closer. What is happening? Your question is answered when a third-floor window smashes. The smash is followed by screams as two bodies come hurtling out of the broken window, followed by a huge bookshelf. Books and glass rain down on the terrified crowds. Inside you can hear a roar which chills you to the bone. The police chief is glad to see you. 'We need help, Crusader,' he pleads. 'Some sort of creature is inside there. They've called it the Devastator. Looks like something not of this earth! A huge brute - I'd say it's made from rock!' You rush into the building and find the creature on the third floor. Your jaw drops. Indeed, it does seem to be made from rock rather than living flesh, and it stands some four metres high. Something has enraged it and it is destroying everything in sight, pushing over huge shelves of books and smashing tables and chairs. If you have Super Strength, turn to 378. If you have ETS, turn to 421. If you have Psi-Powers, turn to 192. If you have Energy Blast, turn to 363. If you don't think you can handle this creature, you can leave by turning to 319.

The Serpent has a powerful secret weapon – his poisonous bite. Each time he hits you, roll one die. A roll of 1 or 2 indicates a bite and the poison will take effect. Deduct 1 SK11.1 point each time you are bitten. However, the effects of the bite are only temporary. You will recover your SK11.1 after one full day. If you defeat the villain, turn to 432. 251

You hand the medallion to the officer who places it in a small plastic bag. 'Seems to me like just another mugging,' he says. 'But it's very strange. It happened in broad daylight and the guy's wallet hasn't even been touched. Anyway, thanks for your help.' You leave the area, once you have changed into your street clothes. Turn to 181.

## 252

As you climb down inside the submarine, a noise from within alerts you. It is the dull clanking of metal on metal. But it sounds also like another familiar sound. *Footsteps!* You quickly climb down inside and search for a convenient hiding-spot. The door to a small chamber is open and you nip inside. Moments later, you can hear the sound of more footsteps and a human figure stops outside your chamber. 'Which numbskull left the door to the ejection chamber open?' he says, spinning the handle to lock you inside. Your heart sinks. The *ejection chamber?* You are trapped. How will you escape? You must try to use your power:

Super Strength	Turn to 390

ETS	Turn to 145
Energy Blast	Turn to 6

The curator takes you round the stuffed exhibits. Gorillas, rhinos, great cats, even a whale – they are all there and you examine them with interest. Two in particular catch your attention. One of the tigers has dried blood on its claws, but there is no way of knowing whether the blood is human or animal, or even how long it has been there. Also, the curator tells you that the elephant was moved into the ground-floor private exhibit rooms yesterday for cleaning. If you want to pursue your investigations with these exhibits, turn to 161. If you wish to have a look at the dinosaurs, turn to 345.





254

At the gates, the security guard says he remembers the car leave, but he didn't see who was driving. The car did indeed head towards Titan City centre. But how will you track it down? You inform the police to look out for its licence-plate number and leave the Murdock Laboratories. Turn to 125.

### 255

The Bolt misses. You do not have time to try another shot, as the shark is dangerously near the young boy. If you miss again, the boy is doomed. Wisely, you decide to spring into the water and grapple with the shark. Turn to 294.



Quick as a flash, you spring into the shop ready for action. It is a small sweets, candies and tobacco shop. The proprietor, a Mr Kalvin Farquarson, is standing behind the counter in a state of shock, his head buried in his hands. You shake his shoulders and tell him to pull himself together. He composes himself and stammers: 'Terror! The little terror . . . ! Pulled a gun . . . grabbed everything on the counter . . . and ran out through there!' He points through the shop to what is apparently the back door. Will you race for the back door to stop the thief before he can get away (turn to 24), or will you grab something to use as cover first (turn to 101)?

Your wait is brief. The doctor comes downstairs in his dressing-gown and wants to know what you want. You explain your clue and how you feel that someone may be trying to steal his secrets. He is not impressed and takes you into his study to show you that nothing is amiss. Turn to 303.



# 258

You pick the assassin up by the collar and demand to know who he is working for. He realizes that the game is up and admits that he works for F.E.A.R.I You threaten him with more punishment unless he tells you the whereabouts of the meeting you know is about to take place, but he swears he knows nothing more than that it is due to take place tomorrow. Perhaps he is telling the truth. You hand him over to the police and head for home. You have saved the President's life and may award yourself 6 Hero Points. Turn to 311.

## 259

You try talking to the security guard, but it is no use. The vault is over a metre thick and he cannot hear you. While you are trying, however, you do find out what has happened. The Alchemists, masters of advanced chemistry, had neutralized the alarm with some sort of acidic gas which delayed its being activated as they forced their way in. Another unknown compound had dissolved the security lock. on the main door. Why the security guard had not noticed the intruders was still a mystery which would only be solved when the time-lock released him from the vault. You may, if you wish, try to smash the vault door to release the guard. If you have Energy Blast, turn to 183; otherwise turn to 5. If, on the other hand, you see this as a futile exercise, turn to 60.

### 260

You seem to be getting through to the demented maniac. You try a different tack, telling him to think of his wife or his girl-friend, and how she will feel if he crashes the plane. His anger rises! He switches off the radio and you watch despairingly as the plane lurches in the air and plummets down towards the edge of the landing-field. Helplessly, you watch the plane crash into the ground. There will be no survivors. Turn to 10. 261-263



261

You knock the Fire Warrior backwards. He lands unconscious in a pile on the floor and his flames die out. Now you must go for the other three. As it takes only a low-level Energy Bolt to knock them out, you may fire at each one. When you have hit two of them, turn to 53.

## 262

The creature spies you and swings a great fist. Resolve this battle:

THE DEVASTATOR SKILL 14 STAMINA 12

If you win, turn to 119.

# 263

Do you wish to step into the crowd in street clothes (turn to 99), or nip round a corner to change into the Silver Crusader (turn to 191)? The sales assistants are all demonstrating various machines to other customers and you wander round looking at the racks of software. You take a copy of a 'Whack Man' variant and study the description on the box. 'I don't rate that one myself,' says a voice behind you. You turn round. It is Gerry the Grass! You must be careful not to give yourself away, for he doesn't know you as Jean Lafavette. You chat away to him and he tells you of his hobbies: computers, CB radio and amateur detecfive work. As he boasts of his interests, he gives you some information. Apparently he has heard of a plot to assassinate the President, who is due to arrive in Titan City tomorrow on a visit. There will be a decov gunman in the crowd, but the real killer will be on the roof of the Regent Hotel. He tried to tell the police, but they dismissed him as a crank. With this information, you may apprehend the gunman by adding 100 to the reference you are on when you arrive on 7th Avenue and turning to that reference. You thank him for his advice on the game and leave. Turn to 226.

# 265

Your blast hits the creature square in the chest. It mars...and then vanishes! Your jaw drops. What is happening here? Likewise, the watching crowds are completely baffled. Turn to 138.

A Chinaman jabbers at you as you walk in. 'Yes, yes, yes?' he asks. He is obviously in a hurry. Will you push past him and look around the shop (turn to 334), or do you have a password you would like to try on him (turn to 206)?



# 267

The firemen cut through the car door. When the door is freed, you help bend it open and grab the two passengers, pulling them to safety away from the flaming car. An instant later, the tank catches fire and explodes, but all the onlookers are a safe distance away. Not a particularly dramatic rescue, but nevertheless you have helped save their lives. Leaving them with the ambulance-men, you walk away from the crowd to find a suitable hiding-place and change into your street clothes. You may award yourself 1 Hero Point for the rescue, before climbing the stairs back to your office. Turn to 398.

268

You explain to the manager of the drug store that you are looking for clues which will help you locate the Poisoner. He is happy to let you look round his shop and investigate the storerooms downstairs. But you can find no evidence of the Poisoner's presence. You thank the manager for his help and leave. You have no leads to follow up. Turn to 107.

# 269

You grab the flask and hurl it out of the window. This was not a good choice. First of all the flask was hot and has severely burned your hand – lose 1 SKILL point. Secondly, the contents of the bottle have splashed over passers-by on the ground below. For this you must lose 2 Hero Points. Nevertheless, you have prevented the explosion. The Professor thanks you for averting what could have been a disaster. You leave the building and head for home. Turn to 18.





At the mention of his name, your eyes fall on Mustapha Kareem. He holds your gaze, then breaks away, nervously. You grab his shoulder and ask him to answer a few questions. To the great surprise of the curator, Kareem breaks free and rushes off downstairs into the vaults of the museum, with you hot in pursuit. You catch up with him in a dimly lit nom in which several wooden crates stand. Kareem is cornered. But as you advance, a wicked smile spreads across his lips. His skin begins to wither. His eyes become sunken pits in their sockets. He stands before you as a *Mummy* and raises his arms as he comes towards you to attack. If you have *Energy Blast*, turn to 170. If you have *Super Strength*, turn to 109. Otherwise, turn to 61.

### 271-272

271

With a miniature Sensor Scanner, you examine the man's pocket for clues. The scanner indicates some flakes of skin from a hand that was not his own. Something strange is going on here! Turn to 143.



### 272

You fly into the air and smack your fist into the creature's jaw. It drops its victim into the water and a red stain spreads around the body. You now have a fight on your hands:

5KILL 10 STAMINA 11

When you inflict your fourth wound on the beast, turn to 65.

# Turn to 34.

# 273

### 274

You confront the villain in the Colonel's office. He is startled to see you appear, and turns to face you. 'So!' he smiles. 'The Silver Crusader, as always, fights on the side of what is good and just. Sickening. But perhaps that can be changed . . .' What follows is a contest of will - yours against that of the Macro Brain, who has similar powers. But the Macto Brain has been waiting for this. He has not had such a busy day, and his powerful mind begins to prevail. You break out in a sweat from the exertion and finally drop to your knees in submission. But your foe has not finished yet. 'Crusader,' he announces, 'for many years you have fought for justice. From now on you will become servant to the Macro Brain!' You feel your will slipping. He has overpowered you and is now implanting mental suggestions. Your struggles are to no avail. No longer will you be Titan City's avenger against evil. Instead you are destined to become a useful pawn to the immense intelligence that is the Macro Brain

You summon up your energy and try another Bolt. Again the effort is tiring and you must lose another 2 STAMINA points. But this time you manage to burn through to the door-mechanism, and a metallic clang sounds from within. The door swings slightly ajar and you enter the vault. Deposit boxes are strewn about the floor and in the centre, lying spread-eagled, is the security guard. Blood trickles from a nasty gash on his forehead. This injury, together with the lack of fresh air in the vault, has been too much for him. As you kneel down beside him, he is gasping his last breaths. Seeing you, he whispers a few dying words, interrupted by coughs, into your car: 'Alchemists . . . Overheard meeting plans . . . Big deal . . . Nervous . . . Fear .... Submarine .... Ahhhhhh .... ' His head falls to one side: the man is dead. Turn to 60.

## 276

Where to now? You may want to visit the Titan Central Library to do some research in their criminology section (turn to 242), or you could go to visit Cerry the Grass (turn to 38).

### 277

Silently you climb the stairs. Four steps from the top, your foot creaks on the old wooden board. The voices upstairs fall silent. They have heard the noise. Drat! You look up to see two sights, neither of which is comforting. Above the stairs is a mirror. The Mantrapper and his men have without doubt noticed you. The second thing you see is a pipe suspended over the stairs, its open end pointing straight at you. As you watch it, a whiff of green smoke puffs out of the pipe into your face. You cough heavily. Another of the Mantrapper's little traps, no doubt – and one from which you will not recover, as you take the poison gas into your lungs. Your valiant attempt to save the millionaire has been in vain.

278

the Cats' Home is not far from the Dairy. As if it senses where it is going, the little animal squirms to get free. It fights and scratches in your grip. It seems to be getting heavier! Suddenly a remarkable transformation takes place. You drop the cat to the ground and before your eyes it grows in size and takes on a female human form, until it stands before you as the Tiger Cat! Of course! This wicked shevillain has a record of robbing dairies and fish factories. Her tight, tiger-striped costume has sharp claws at the hands and feet and she springs at you:

# TIGER CAT

SKILL9 STAMINA8

If you have *Psi-Powers*, turn to 413. If you have *ETS*, turn to 168. You have no time to use an Energy Bolt. If you defeat the Tiger Cat, turn to 124.

You fake unconsciousness and, seething inwardly, let them take the money that they are after. A car pulls up and they leap inside, cursing about how little they have taken. You memorize the number the police can handle this one. Lose 2 STAMINA points for the blow on the head, and turn to 76.



### 280

Recently you have learned the true identities of several of the crime world's most notorious supervillains. The Tormentor has been identified as Richard Storm, an uptown heating engineer. The Ice Queen is none other than Sylvia Frost, society débutante. And Marcus Buletta is known to be the gruesome Dr Macabre, whose terrible experiments in surgery have shocked the world. Buletta has been planning a jail-break for months. When he does so, he is likely to rob a chemist immediately for surgical equipment and chemicals. You sit down next to a kid listening to a Walkman and borrow it to listen to the tape. It seems to be a recording of a telephone conversation between a man and a woman. The conversation ends: 'Don't worry. The treasures are being collected and replaced by our agent, Mustapha Kareem. We will have them all soon. Remember, we meet the day after tomorrow on board the yacht. Okay. Bye.' Interesting stuff. This Mustapha Kareem sounds like a dubious character. If you come across him, you may question him about his activities by doubling the reference number you are on at the time and turning to this new reference. Add 1 LUCK point for discovering this message, and turn to 86.

## 282

There is no other course of action you can take but to grapple with the berserk Android:

ANDROID

SKILL9 STAMINA 11

After the second round of combat, turn to 335.

### 283

You jump over the counter and quickly change costume. When you step forwards as the Silver Crusader, the Fire Warriors stop in their tracks. You warn them and order them to give themselves up. But your words are wasted. One of them lunges for you and you will have to release an Energy Bolt. If you hit, turn to **261**. If you miss, turn to **200**.



You quickly change into the Silver Crusader and rush to the Peter Laboratories. It is near the centre of town, annexed to the nuclear physics department of the university. When you arrive, you are sent straight upstairs to the third floor, but told to be careful. A group of students and professors are huddled by the stairs. You are told what has happened. Four Alsatian dogs which were being used in dangerous radiation experiments have escaped from their cages. They are locked in a room down the corridor and are barking wildly. Although they should not be radioactive to the touch, their bite could be lethal, should their saliva enter an open cut.

If you survive this episode, you may award yourself 1 Hero Point for each of the dogs you capture, but you must deduct 1 Hero Point for each person who is bitten by a dog. If you have:

You watch from the control tower as the Tormentor steps out of the plane and gives himself up to the police, who are waiting on the runway. The Air-Traffic Controller thanks you for your help, and you leave. You may add 2 Hero Points. Turn to 10.

## 286

You grab the unconscious thief and pull him out from behind the boxes. As he slides out into the daylight, you gulp. This little villain can be no more than nine years old! You may well have hurt him badly! In his right hand he clutches his booty – a half-eaten Goo Bar. Desperately, you shake him, and eventually his eyes flick open. He is terrified to see you and you scowl at him sternly. But secretly you are relieved that he is not seriously hurt. You pick him up and march inside the shop. Turn to 316.

## 287

You first of all try to latch on to the mind of the arch-criminal you know to be inside the brown cloud. This is difficult, but you do find out one thing. He has been taking pictures of the doctor's notes with a radio camera and the photographs have already been sent to the headquarters of F.E.A.R.! Then you concentrate hard, trying to alter the air molecules around the gas to imprison the villain. But it is no use. You have failed to prevent important secrets from reaching the eyes of F.E.A.R. Turn to 162. You push the door open and step into an untidy dressing-room. Clothes are strewn about the floor and jars of make-up lie open on the dressing-table in front of the mirror. But otherwise the room is empty. You search through the mess for a clue to the Serpent's whereabouts, but find nothing. Do you want to try room number one (turn to 322) or room number three (turn to 117) instead?

## 289

As you enter the park, you pick up sounds of a commotion and follow it to a crowd grouped around a body. Police are trying to move the crowd on. Will you push through to see what is happening (turn to 434), or change into the Silver Crusader (turn to 104)?

290

Are you anticipating this meeting? If so, you will know what time you ought to arrive to catch the meeting in progress. Add this time to today's date (do you know what this is?) and turn to the reference corresponding to this number. If the resulting reference makes no sense, turn to 368.



'Escaped animals?' she asks. 'I don't think any of our animals have escaped. But I'll just check for you, if you like.' She picks up a land-line telephone and cranks a handle. 'Hello, Mario? This is Nancy. Someone here wants to know whether any animals have escaped . . . No, I didn't think so. Thanks. Byc.' She shakes her head and you leave. Where will you try now? You can try the zoo (turn to 408) or the Natural History Museum (turn to 365).

### 292

You sneak away from the waiting crowd, change costume and make for home. You have had an exhausting day and you slump in front of the TV with a long, cold drink. You may add 6 STAMINA points for the rest. The next morning you leave for work early. You catch a bus, but to refresh yourself before work, you get off and walk the last half of the journey. Typical: as soon as you get off the bus, it starts to rain! You begin to run but slow down when you arrive at Cowfield Dairy. Something is not quite right. Do you wish to investigate (turn to 369), or are you already on your way to somewhere more important? If so, you will know how to get there.



294 With a tremendous splashing, the fight commences

RIPPER SHARK SKILL 10 STAMINAS

When the shark has inflicted its fourth wound on you, turn to 95. If you defeat the shark before it has inflicted four wounds, turn to 197.



## 295

From your Accessory Belt you draw an Absolute Zero Flask. Quickly, you step over to the experiment and bring the flask up to surround the bottle. Moments later, the danger is over. The liquid in the bottle has frozen, and will do no further harm. The Professor thanks you for saving the lives of everyone in the building. You may add 1 Hero Point. You leave and make for home. Turn to 18. 296

You go through the man's pockets to retrieve the wallet. He is carrying some peculiar things, no doubt the pickings of his trade. Along with the wallet, you find a cigarette packet which contains a crumpled piece of paper, a tape cassette and a map. Before handing the pickpocket over to a security guard on the train, you manage to take *one* of these from him. Which did you take? The cigarette packet (turn to 423), the cassette tape (turn to 281) or the map (turn to 20)?

# 297

You will have to do battle with the lions. If you can defeat them, the Ringmaster will give himself up:

First LION	SKILL 8	STAMINA 9
Second LION	SKI1.1.7	STAMINA 8

Fight them one at a time. If you defeat them both, turn to 433.





You burst through the door into a smoke-filled room. Six startled faces wheel round to stare at you from their seats around a conference table. You recognize them all as agents of F.E.A.R. At the head of the table sits a man whose face you could never forget. The bald head, pointed nose and eyegoggles belong to Vladimir Utoshski, leader of F.E.A.R. He rises to his feet and speaks: 'Sol The Silver Crusader honours us with a visit. Could it be that you wish to join us? I think not. My friends, I will show you how F.E.A.R. must deal with its enemies. This puny specimen is no match for the Cyborg!' The half-human, Titanium halfmechanical man steps towards you, his two electroassisted arms ready to attack. A glowing light pulses in the goggles he uses for eyes. Do you have a Circuit Jammer with you? If so, turn to 159. If not, you will have to fight the leader of F.E.A.R .:

You rush to the edge of the water and search the surface for the tell-tale fin of a shark. Thirty metres out from the shore, you spot it. A monster! Swimming in towards the beach is a huge ripper shark! It is heading straight for a young boy who is still on his way back to the beach. What a nuisance! You could easily have seen the shark off with your Omnidirectional Electrifier. But with the boy in the way, you cannot risk using it. You will have to plunge into the water and tackle the shark with your bare hands. Turn to 294.

## 300

As you step up to Epiphany's window, you notice a familiar figure taking an unhealthy interest in the diamond rings - Porcelain Percy, so called because his punishment for once betraying a former boss was to have all his teeth filed down to the gums and they all had to be built up with porcelain caps. He stands aside nervously as you step up to the window. You play with him a little. Did he not have something to do with the smash-and-grab at De Lager's jeweller's last week? Wasn't he seen talking to Timmy the Tongue? Maybe it would be better for all if you were to just hand him over to Big Ben and the Slicer; it would save the police a lot of effort Porcelain Percy starts to sweat profusely and agrees to give you some information if you will just forget you have even seen him. Apparently he knows that the Poisoner has plans which threaten the lives of all the inhabitants of Titan City. He also tells you more about what the Poisoner's plans are. If you find yourself searching for the Poisoner, deduct 30 from the reference you are on when you are given the opportunity, and turn to this new reference. You may add 1 LUCK point for this information. Then you allow the skinny little man to go home. The rest of the evening is uneventful and you get a good night's rest. You may add 6 STAMINA points. Turn to 327.

#### 301

"Lafavette! Get in here at once!" No sooner had you stepped through the office door than Jonah Whyte's booming voice summoned you. You creep into his office, mumbling scanty excuses for being late yet again. 'Enough!' he yells. 'What do you think we are running here? A charity? Do you suppose I should be grateful that you even grace us with your presence? Very noble of you indeed to even bother coming in at all! Well, I tell you what. I'm feeling kind today. You can have the rest of the day off. Without pay! And if you're not in first thing tomorrow morning, you can start looking for another job!' You slink out of his office with your tail between your legs. How can you tell him what you've been doing? And now you've been suspended for a day. Where will you go? Will you spend the day at Wisneyland, the amusement park (turn to 15), or will you avoid all contact with the outside world and go home to make sure you get an early start in the morning (turn to 218)?

After a brief snack, they get up and leave the diner. You overheard part of their conversation, but their heated discussions were no more than arguments about the likely results of tomorrow's horse-races. You are wasting your time. You leave the diner and catch a cab. Turn to 368.



#### 303

'There, you see!' says the doctor as you enter the study. 'Allisin order. Just as Heft it.' But you are not listening. Your attention has been caught by a dark whisp of brown smoke that is passing out of the window through the air-conditioner. You race quickly outside. Turn to 29.

### 304

You prepare to use Energy Blast on the Android, but decide that you cannot risk it with so many innocent people about. What can you do against the creature? The answer comes from a man in the crowd who has been watching the demonstration. 'Try this,' he shouts, throwing you a small pen-like device. 'The demonstrator was asked what happens if the Android becomes uncontrollable and showed us this. He called it a "Circuit Jammer" or something. Maybe it will help.' You catch the device and hold it to the Android. Sure enough, the little gadget lives up to its name and the movements of the Android cease. You may add 4 Hero Points for defeating the Android and you may also take the strange little device with you. Having seen enough of the exhibition, you decide to leave Whirl's Court. Turn to 75.

#### 305

The police officers help you over to a bench. You overhear their conversation: 'Ugly incident in Audubon, seems like. Throat slashed. Made a mess of the path . . .' The other replies, 'Yeah. And Cleveland Bank. They reckon that was the Alchemists. Glad I wasn't the night-watchman when *they* came in!' The two nod in agreement. 'Looks like things are hotting up,' says the first, as they walk back to their yellow and black car. What will you do now? You could walk into Audubon Park to see what they were talking about (turn to 165), buy a paper to see if you can pick up any news on the robbery (turn to 228), or go to work (turn to 341).

306

You may use Energy Blast against the dogs only in the confines of the Lab. If a dog escapes into the crowd, you dare not risk using it. Turn to 237.



#### 307

What can you do to help the swimmers? An Energy Bolt would melt the ice around them, but you cannot risk hitting the girls. However, you could aim a Bolt in a ring around them. This will cost you 4 STAMINA points, as it will have to be a prolonged effort. If you decide to help them, you can add 2 Hero Points. If you don't want to deplete your STAMINA, you must *lose* 2 Hero Points and face the boos of the onlookers as you walk away. Turn to 362 to leave.

Using your mental powers, you search quickly through the passengers. A burly man with wide shoulders catches your attention. You make contact with him and will him towards the cockpit to take on the Tormentor. He shakes his head and stares into the distance as he listens to your message. Suddenly he springs up from his seat. 'Hallelujah!' he cries. 'I have received the word of the Lord! I must rid us of this unbeliever. My mission has been sent from above!' Your heart sinks. Just what you needed - a religious fanatic who thinks your message is some sort of divine omen. In your mind's eye you watch as he stomps forwards up the aisle towards the cockpit, giving the Tormentor full warning of his approach. The villain throws the joystick forwards and sends the plane into a deep dive. Unconcerned about his own life, he has made sure that his plan will succeed. Moments later, the plane crashes to the ground, killing all on board. Your plan has failed. You leave the airport. Turn to 10.



You wait anxiously for the Alchemists to emerge from the bank. Passers-by are not aware of what is happening, but you manage to prevent any from entering while the robbery in in progress. However, you cannot avoid the curiosity of the public. One small boy strains on his mother's arm and yells out 'Mommy, look! It's the Silver Crusader! Can Lask for an autograph, mommy? Please, mommy, can I?' You try to hush him up, but only manage to annoy his mother. Unaware of the situation, she thinks you are extremely rude. Have the boy's cries alerted the Alchemists? *Test your Luck.* If you are Lucky, turn to 128. If you are Unlucky, turn to 155.

#### 310

There are two lions inside the cage. They are lying contentedly on the floor, licking their paws as if they had just finished a meal. But there are no signs of meat in the cage. Several metres from the cage is an elephant tied to a stake. These beasts could well be the killers, but what evidence do you have? Do you want to arrest the lion-tamer and take him to police headquarters (turn to 383), or will you try to gather more evidence (turn to 45). If you have *Psi-Powers*, turn to 321.

## 311

You set off home to take some well-deserved rest. The prospect of the F.E.A.R. meeting is weighing heavily on your mind, but for the moment you are well advised to relax for the evening. You may gain 6 STAMINA points for taking it easy. Next morning, you are woken, not by the alarm clock, but by your Crimewatch: *beep – beep – beep*. This time the message is longer than normal and it repeats itself: 'RELIABLE INFORMATION. FEAR MEETING TO-DAY. WHEREABOUTS UNKNOWN!' You spring out of bed. Today! Do you have any clues as to where the meeting is? Where will you go:

Parker Airport?	Turn to 349
Stay in town?	Turn to 70
Head towards the waterfront?	Turn to 290



312

The President is due to pay a visit to Titan City. Rumours are going round that an attempt will be made on his life when he arrives. It would be wise to find out how this attempt will be made. Both Marcus Buletta and Rat-face Flanagan know how the attempt will be made.



As you are about to enter the drug store, you hear screams from inside. You nip into a storeroom and change into the Silver Crusader to investigate the disturbance. When you rush into the shop, you see two figures rummaging through the pharmaceutical shelves, while a crowd of terrified onlookers are held at bay by another. You recognize him as Dr Macabre, the mad surgeon whose brilliant experiments in transplant surgery were outlawed by a world not yet ready for the advances he had made. His two henchmen are the results of his work. One has four arms and is snatching bottles from the shelves with them. The other has the head of a tiger and is terrorizing the shop staff with his sharp teeth. You leap into action. If you have ETS, turn to 325. If you have Psi-Powers, turn to 173. If you have Super Strength, turn to 78. If you have Energy Blast, turn to 142.

## 316-317

314

You race out of the vaults and back upstairs where you tell the curator what has happened and leave the affair in his hands. You must deduct 2 Hero Points for leaving prematurely. Turn to 276.



#### 315

You fly up in the air and come down with a mighty thump in the creature's chest. The blow winds it and it temporarily releases the girders and turns its attention to you. Resolve this battle:

## CREATURE OF CARNAGE

SKILL 12 STAMINA 14

If you defeat the Creature of Carnage, turn to 131.

## 316

After giving the young boy an earful, you send him on his way. Then you turn to the shopkeeper. You are furious! You had thought that this was a serious robbery, not merely a youngster's prank to steal a bar of candy. The cowardly shopkeeper has wasted your time. You may gain no Hero Points for this capture, but you must *lose* 1 Hero Point if you knocked out the young thief. In fact, if you did knock him out, you had better get moving quickly before any of the passers-by find out what has happened. This is just the sort of thing that your critics would pick up on. Will you leave quickly (turn to 438), or would you like to give the shopkeeper a piece of your mind first (turn to 64)?



## 317

The naval dockyard is a dismal place. In dock at the moment are three boats you can investigate: a small PT boat (turn to 417), an ageing submarine (turn to 252) and a battleship which is being painted (turn to 96).

This has been a particularly savage murder. The man's throat has been slashed with a none-toosharp blade. His wallet contains his business cards, which identify him as Wayne Bruce, President of Euro-American Security Inc. Also in his wallet is a photograph of an attractive blonde woman with dark eyes. One thing puzzles you. His wallet has not been touched! Certainly robbery was not the motive of this apparently normal mugging. Do you wish to head for the offices of Euro-American Security Inc. (turn to 233), will you visit his home to talk to his wife (turn to 195), or will you leave this crime in the hands of the police (turn to 73)?

#### 319

You had better avoid any more super exploits for a while. Do you want to pay a visit to your elderly aunt's house (turn to 134), or will you go downtown to police headquarters to check that you are not required for any other duties (turn to 245)?



#### 320

Using Energy Blast will be dangerous, as a miss could cause the vial of poison to fall into the inlet. Will you risk it? If so, turn to 150. If not, turn to 25.

#### 321

You approach the lion-tamer and exchange a few pleasantries. But while you keep up the conversation, you are also probing his mind for signs of any link between the attacks and the animals. But you cannot find any. If you wish to arrest the lion-tamer anyway, turn to 383. If you leave the circus, turn to 148.



322

Evidently this is the theatre's most luxurious dressing-room, normally used by the stars. Elegant drapes line the walls, and a border of lights surrounds the mirror. But it is untouched. It looks as though it has not been used for weeks. There is nothing for you to find here. Will you try room number two (turn to 288) or room number three (turn to 117)?

#### 323

The Chief Detective is contemptuous about superheroes. In his eyes, fighting crime is a job for the police, not for what he calls 'amateur detectives'. Nevertheless, you do find some information about the event. The Alchemists, masters of advanced chemistry, had neutralized the alarm with some sort of acidic gas which delayed its being activated as they forced their way in. Another unknown compound had dissolved the security lock on the main door. Why the security guard had not noticed the intruders was still a mystery which would only be solved when the time-lock released him from the vault. But now he assures you that the situation is well under control in his hands. There is no need for any 'amateur in fancy pants' to get involved. Turn to 60



324

You emerge from the alley into a crowded street and look left and right. *Damn!* You cannot see him. You run a few paces along the street to search for any signs of him, but it is hopeless. He has escaped. Turn to 75.



325

You have nothing you can use that will be especially effective against them. Turn to 78.

## 326

You concentrate first on the creature's mind. Nothing happens. You are not sure that it even has one. Then you try a different approach. You will the water to heat. It starts to steam and the great creature feels the heat. It roars loudly and drops its victim into the fountain. The woman is unconscious and bleeding badly. You must return the water to normal temperature straight away. After doing this, you face the creature:

FOUNTAIN

SKILLIO STAMINA 11

When you inflict your fourth hit on the creature, turn to 65.



Next morning you leave for work early. You are sorely tempted to leave your Crimewatch behind; you dare not miss another day's work! But your fears are unwarranted. To your utter amazement, your Crimewatch is silent. You arrive at work early. Jonah Whyte cannot believe his eyes when he enters the office to find you hard at work at your desk. At lunch-time you catch up on the day's news on the teletext TV. Two stories catch your attention. One is of a strange attack in Audubon Park. A woman has been seriously mauled by what she calls 'a monster', but a specialist at the hospital thinks the claw-marks of an animal of some kind. The second story is of a man who had his chest crushed in the grounds of the Natural History Museum. There are no clues as to who or what was responsible. It is as if whatever caused the man's death simply walked away. Both incidents are being investigated by the police. You decide to do a little investigation of your own. You change into the Silver Crusader and set off to make your inquiries. Where will you head first:

The Natural History Museum?	Turn to 365
Titan Zoo?	Turn to 408
Warnum and Wailey's Travelling	
Circus?	Turn to 4

327

From your belt, you take a small rod the size of a pencil. It extends telescopically like a car aerial. This is a Radiation Neutralization Wand. In the battle that will follow, each time you score a hit, you have touched the dog with the wand and the effects of its radioactivity are neutralized. However, the dog can – and will – still fight, so you still have to defeat it. And if any dog bites a bystander, you will still lose a Hero Point, even if it has been touched with your wand. But a neutralized dog will not be able to kill you with a single attack unless this attack has reduced your STAMINA to zero. Turn to 237.



#### 329

You change trains and head for home. Are you wasting your time? After all, it's only a scrap of paper. How can you tell your boss that you were late for work because you wanted to check out a little piece of paper that you found in a cigarette packet? Nevertheless, you take it into your study, enter the words as they are written, and let your computer try to make some sense of them. Ten minutes later, it has printed three possible messages: 'Call the egg. You're wet behind the ears'; 'My newspaper is covered in plastic nodules'; and 'Idiot. Fear meeting address 176, not 178. Don't forget.' Interesting stuff. By now it is much too late to go to work. You spend the next hour working on a batch of phenolic acid. When it is ready you pour some in a vial and place it in your Accessory Belt to take with you. Will you now spend the rest of the day at the Wisneyland Amusement Park (turn to 15), or will you go downtown, perhaps to do some shopping (turn to 202)?

330

You aim an Energy Bolt at the tail of the plane as it rounds the corner on to the runway. But your aim is not accurate. The plane takes off into the sky. Turn to 249.



Outside you find a single clue to the kidnapping – a metal slug with the letter M engraved in it. If this means anything to you, you will know how you can investigate it. Otherwise you have come to a dead end. You may give your information to the police and let them take over. Turn to **428**.



#### 332

You draw a Micronet from your Accessory Belt and cast it over the creature. The tough fibres tangle its limbs, but it is not strong enough to hold for long. Turn to 373 to fight the Reincarnation, but deduct 3 points from its SKILL for the first six rounds of combat. 333

You pick up the piece of paper that he was trying to destroy. It bears the emblem of F.E.A.R.! The message is short: 'Do not forget. The meeting starts at 9 a.m.' Unfortunately, it bears no more information, but this time could be useful to you. You carry the Scarlet Prankster down to the ground and hand him over to the police. You may add 3 Hero Points for capturing him. Now turn to 103.

## 334

You push past him and step into the back of the shop. He swats at you ineffectually from behind. You sweep aside a pair of curtains separating the front of the shop from the back. Four yellow faces look up at you from steamy wash-bowls. There seems to be nothing unusual here. Would you like to try Chomsky's upstairs (turn to 44), or will you step back out to the street (turn to 368)?



Although seemingly a harmless domestic servant, Vladimir Utoshski has made this particular Android specially to serve F.E.A.R. Apart from a 'Destruction' switch in its back which turns it into a creator of mayhem, it is armed with a deadly weapon – a poisonous dagger which it can make protrude from its right foot. A kick from this foot is certain death, a fact which you have just discovered. As the fastacting poison takes effect, you can almost hear the leader of F.E.A.R. laughing. There is now nothing to prevent his meeting from taking place . . .



#### 336

For capturing the Alchemists you may score 4 Hero Points. Such a waste, you think, that such brilliant minds should be used for criminal gain. If only they could be persuaded to devote themselves to academic research for the good of society. Turn now to 372.

### 337

You spend a quiet evening reading a good book and have a hearty home-cooked meal. Add 6 STAMINA points and turn to 79.

You rush out across the ice and begin hammering the surface around the girls with your fists. But it is no use; the ice is a metre thick. Head bowed, you must admit defeat. There is nothing you can do. The onlookers sneer at you as you leave the pool to try to phone someone who can help. You know what they must be thinking. What use have you been? You must lose 2 Hero Points for your failure. Then you can leave the pool by turning to 362.

#### 339

What will you do to prevent the bottle exploding? Will you throw it out of the window (turn to 269), smother it with your hands (turn to 426), or rush off to look for a fire-extinguisher (turn to 89)?

#### 340

You take your vial of phenolic acid and hurl it at the creature. Roll two dice and compare the total with your SKILL, score. If you roll a number *higher than* your SKILL, you have missed and you will have to take on the Devastator with your bare hands (turn to 262). If the roll is *equal to or less than* your SKILL, turn to 69.



Late again . . . You creep past the office of your boss, Jonah Whyte, hoping he will not notice. But no such luck. His voice booms out at you: 'Lafayette! In my office. Immediately!' Sheepishly, you leave your desk and creep in to see him. A stream of abuse follows. In his eyes you are lazy, shiftless, incompetent . . . . Suddenly a squeal of types in the street below, followed by a loud crash, interrupts him and the two of you rush to the window. A crowd is gathering around a large black limousine which has spun round in the road, mounted the sidewalk and crashed into a street-lamp. A fire has started in the rear of the car and is spreading. Do you wish to run downstairs in your street clothes (turn to 102), or nip into the toilet to change into the Silver Crusader (turn to 23)? Alternatively you may ignore the incident and go back to work (turn to 167).

341

341

You arrive at the army base and are escorted to see Colonel Saunders, who greets you with a warm handshake, 'Crusader!' he smiles, 'Well, this is an honour. What can we do for you?' You explain you have come to compare notes on the activities of F.E.A.R. 'So far,' Saunders starts, 'we have come up with nothing. Like you, we have heard that a toplevel meeting is imminent and if we are to prevent their villainous escapades, we must capture their leader, Vladimir Utoshski, before the meeting can take place. They are powerful, Crusader, and ruthless. You can count on all the help we can give you." Suddenly an aide bursts into the room. 'Sir!' he pants. 'Helicopters! Identity unknown! Coming towards the base at four o'clock!' The Colonel leaps into action, 'Contact them on the radio. If they will not identify themselves, we will open fire.' If you have Super Strength, you fly out to investigate (turn to 379). Otherwise, turn to 58.



All is quiet at the reactor, apart from endless tramping of the numerous armed security guards who have been positioned to guard it. There is no sign of Knox. You wait for half an hour, but still nothing happens. Suddenly a klaxon sounds and men and women rush to their positions. The cooling-system, which was checked thoroughly an hour ago, is malfunctioning. The reactor is overloading! You rush round to the other side of the reactor and, in front of you, you see the cause. Sidney Knox, his head bloated like a pumpkin, is staring at the structure. Guards are aiming their weapons at him, but no one has given the order to fire. They breathe a sigh of relief when they see you, and look to you for guidance. If you have Super Strength, turn to 33. If you have Energy Blast, turn to 204. If you have Psi-Powers, turn to 419. If you have ETS, turn to 80.

#### 344

You send a carefully charged Energy Bolt in the direction of the boxes. It strikes the bottom box (there is no need to test for aim) and the whole pile topples over backwards on top of the thief. A shrill scream comes from the villain. The foot twitches and then rests motionless. You step over cautiously to investigate. Turn to 286. The dinosaur exhibits are very realistic, but the curator merely laughs when you suggest the possibility of one of them being responsible for the man's death. 'Apart from the fact that these creatures have been dead for several million years,' he chuckles, 'how on earth would you suggest they got out of the building? Through the doors? One of these brutes would take the side of the museum with it if it decided to go and look for another home! No, if you're looking for clues to the murder, I suggest you try Titan zoo. You'll have better luck there.' You feel a little foolish for even making the suggestion. If you want to try the zoo, turn to 408. Otherwise turn to 148.



## 346

While the struggle is fought, the aircraft falls into a steep dive. Your last blow fells your foe. As he slumps to the floor, you grab the controls of the plummeting aircraft and shout for the stewardess. She arrives and is able to untie the pilots. In the nick of time they take over from you and are able to guide the plane down to a safe landing. Turn to 35. The heating engineer shows you round the plant. He is mystified as to what happened; there is nothing wrong with the heating-equipment. You double-check the controls and scratch your head. Nothing wrong there. Perhaps no one will ever know what caused the incident, but at least the danger is now over. Turn to 362.

## 348

Your powers reveal that she is telling the truth. The murderer will remain a mystery. Turn to 73.

## 349

Everything is normal at the airport as you arrive. You do not want to cause any panic, so you change into your street clothes and proceed with your plan. You may head for one of the three hangars to look for clues. Xavier Hangar is where private and executive jets are kept. Summers Hangar houses emergency helicopters. McCoy Hangar is for cargo aircraft. Which will you investigate:

Xavier Hangar?	Turn to 394
Summers Hangar?	Turn to 46
McCoy Hangar?	Turn to 115

You are congratulated by the crowd for having averted what could have been a disaster. Note the Hero Points that you have scored, deducting 1 point from the original 4 for each bystander that was bitten by a dog. As you leave the University, a crowd of autograph hunters has gathered outside. Will you slip out the back way to avoid them and make for home (turn to 293), or oblige by stepping out to face the crowd (turn to 397)?

#### 351

You change into your street clothes and sit down in the diner, hoping to notice something suspicious. An hour, and several cups of coffee, later, a group of shifty-looking characters enter and sit down at a table. Turn to 302.

## 352

You will need two Energy Bolts to stop the creature. If you do not wish to risk using two Bolts, turn to 373 to finish off the fight hand to hand. If your first Bolt was a hit, you may reduce its STAMINA by 6 points. Turn to 239 if you win. You rush off to find police officers or stadium officials who might be able to help you. Your first priority must be to organize an evacuation of the west stand. But your plans are futile, as you realize when you hear a great crashing coming from behind you. The stand is down! The Creature of Carnage stands in the centre of the wreckage, roaring loudly. People, dead and dying, surround him. He turns to go and there is nothing you can do to stop him. Your first duty is to aid the injured people around him. When you have done what you can, turn to 40.



## 354

Luckily, the other two are not armed with chemical weapons. Fight them one at a time:

Second ALCHEMIST	SKILL7	STAMINA7
Third ALCHEMIST	SKILL7	STAMINA6

If you defeat them, turn to 336.



355 There must be something he'd like. No doubt he's already got Monopoly. What about this: Trivial Pursuit? Looks interesting. Or how about Dungeons & Dragons? Hmm. He probably hasn't got the imagination. As you are perusing the games, four bikers walk in in ripped jeans and dirty leather jackets. Trouble. You watch them from the corner of your eye. They are in the women's underwear department and are holding bras up to their chests and laughing. A middle-aged woman comes over to stop them and an assistant manager steps in to help. Tempers rise. Just when you are wondering whether or not to join in, one of the bikers throws his jacket to the floor. He clasps his hands together and to the horror of the unsuspecting floor staff, he bursts into flames! The others do likewise and four flaming bodies stomp about the shop, setting fire to everything they touch. The Fire Warriors! Of course! Why did you not recognize those no-good delinquents earlier? You had better act quickly. If you have Super Strength, turn to 133. If you have Psi-Powers, turn to 178. If you have ETS, turn to 156. If you have Energy Blast, turn to 283.

You emerge from the alley into a crowded street and look left and right. *Damn!* You cannot see him. You run a few paces along the street to search for any signs of him, but it is hopeless. He has escaped. Turn to 75.



357

To the beat of loud disco music, cars are circling round the track bashing into one another and causing hoots of laughter for their drivers. Your own car, Blue 7, seems to be a little slower than the rest, but you nevertheless get a couple of satisfying head-ons before your eyes catch sight of the danger . . . A young boy driving Red 14 is smashed in the side by Yellow 3. The collision knocks him sideways and out of his car on to the metal mat of the track in front of you. The driver of Purple 10, who was just lining up a head-on collision with you, screams and throws her hands up in the air as she sees the danger. The boy is lying right between your two cars! How quick are your reactions? Can you avert the collision about to crush the boy? Roll two dice and compare the total with your SKILL score. If the total exceeds your SKILL, turn to 388. Otherwise turn to 234.

## 358

The exhausted mutant falls to his knees. Though you too have been tired by the strain, you have not finished yet. By sheer force of mind, you will him to repair the leaks to the system. One by one the leaks begin to close. Eventually the klaxon stops sounding. The danger is over! You may gain 2 Hero Points for your success. In appreciation of your saving the Laboratory, the scientists bring you a small pen-like device. 'Crusader, take this as a gift from us,' pleads the Institute Director. 'One of our men made it in his spare time. He calls it a "Circuit Jammer". It is still to be fully tested, but seems to work okay. I know you often face mechanical villains and their contraptions. With this, you will be able to disable their circuits. You are looking for Vladimir Utoshski and he is a powerful adversary. With this you will stand a better chance.' You thank the Director for his gift. It may well come in handy. Now turn to 125.

#### 359

You temporarily release your grip on him and he manages to shove you aside, just as the President's car draws past. He aims the gun and shoots! The President falls! You leap on him again to finish off the battle (he was SKILL 7, STAMINA 6). If you defeat him, turn to 374.

You crouch down underneath the lion cage. Sure enough, at the far end is a trapdoor leading up to one end of the cage, into an area which appears to be the lions' shelter. You listen at the trapdoor and can hear shuffling sounds coming from within. Every so often a man's voice chuckles. You shove the trapdoor up and leap inside. Standing in a small room is a sharp-featured man with a long waxed moustache. He is dressed in a bright red suit with a large top hat - the Ringmaster! Surrounding him, pinned to the walls, are photographs of twelve people and several have black lines drawn across them. You recognize photographs of the woman savaged by 'a monster' and the man crushed in the grounds of the Natural History Museum. Twelve people? Of course! The jury which condemned the Ringmaster to fifteen years in prison! He leaps to his feet as you burst in and you will have to fight him:

After the first round of combat, turn to 207.



You arrive at Cowfield Dairy and make a thorough inspection of their sterilization equipment. The staff are most co-operative and are as anxious to find out what happened as you are. All seems to be in order and there is no clue as to how the Poisoner managed to drop traces of his poison into the two milkbottles. You have no way of pursuing this case further. Turn to 107.



362

Where will you go next? Perhaps you deserve a little entertainment. The Titan Tigers, a local football team, are playing the Metro Mohawks. If you want to go and watch the game, turn to 114. If you are more concerned about finding information about the activities of F.E.A.R., you may wish to visit Colonel Saunders at his army base to see whether he knows anything (turn to 342).

Fire an Energy Bolt at the creature. When you first hit it, turn to 48.

### 364

You grab Karpov and threaten to finish him off unless he tells you what he knows about F.E.A.R. The man cringes and agrees, but pleads with you that he doesn't know much. A meeting is taking place tomorrow at 11 a.m., but he does not know where the meeting will be, as he has not been invited. You hand the villain over to the police. You may add 5 Hero Points for defeating him. Turn to 40.



## 365

The curator of the Natural History Museum is very helpful and agrees to show you round the exhibits. Will you ask him to show you the model reconstructions of dinosaurs (turn to 345) or the 'large mammals' section (turn to 253)?

## 366

If you have ETS, turn to 205. If you have Super Strength, turn to 137. Otherwise turn to 267.

#### 367

Take aim and fire your *Energy Blast*. The first hit will cause the poor girl gripped in its jaws to be released. Another will be necessary to kill the creature. When you have inflicted a second hit, turn to 265.

#### 368

It is hopeless. You do not know where F.E.A.R. is holding its meeting and you have no chance of finding it in such a short time. You find a convenient spot, change into your street clothes and hail a cab. The driver has his radio on. As he chats away, the radio splutters and fizzles. The music dies and an unscheduled announcement interrupts the programme. Turn to 292.



369 You change in a convenient alley and head for the Dairy. When you arrive at the gates, everything seems to be in order. Milk-floats are returning from their daily rounds and thousands of bottles are chinking their way along conveyors. There is no sign of danger. A short-tailed tabby cat - no doubt a stray - is trying to get in through the gates. You pick the hungry creature up and stroke it. As you wait, your eye catches a familiar-looking figure turning the corner and walking towards you. It is 'Chainsaw' Bronski, a well-known murderer who you thought was well behind bars! Will you apprehend the villain (turn to 3), or does your first duty lie with the needy and will you instead take the cat to a Cats' Home (turn to 278)?



It is a fine day and the Marina is bustling with activity. Tomorrow is the annual Titan City Regatta and many of the wealthy yacht owners are entering their boats. This does not help you in your search for clues leading to the whereabouts of the F.E.A.R. meeting. You comb the Marina until you finally find a salty old fisherman who is mending his net. If you wish to talk to him, turn to 221. Otherwise turn to 368.

#### 371

There are three of them against one of you. But the two knuckle-faced bodyguards begin to panic. 'B-bboss! That there's the Silver Crusaderl We don' want no tangles with no superheroes! That mother's mean. We ain't got nothin' to save us from an Energy Bolt!' The three of them give up without a fight. You have earned 3 Hero Points. Now turn to 73.

#### 372

Where will your next mission take you? Remembering the police officer's plea and the Crimewatch's message, you may either head for the beach (turn to 72) or Parker Airport (turn to **410**). 373

The Reincarnation is a powerful creature which may not be killed. But you may be able to knock it unconscious; if you reduce its STAMINA to zero, it will remain so for two days. Resolve the battle:

## THE

REINCARNATION SKILL 10 STAMINA 12

If you defeat the creature, turn to 239.

#### 374

You haul the unconscious assassin out of the crowd towards the President's car. Swarms of police are surrounding the car and, in the distance, you can hear an ambulance's siren approaching. One of the President's bodyguards is listening for a pulse. He looks up and shakes his head. In your street clothes, you cannot get near the body, but the police listen to your story and take the assassin from you. One of them talks to another, who talks to another standing in the car. They seem to be considering your story. Word gets back to you: 'Something strange is going on. You say this guy fired at the President as he fell? Then how come the bullet that killed him came from a high-powered rifle, not the Magnum your man was carrying?' You are as mystified as they are and agree to go downtown to answer their questions. But one thing is clear. Your assassin's bullet did not kill the President. Was he merely a decoy? You puzzle over this as you leave the station and head for home. Turn to 311.

## 377-378

As luck would have it, you manage to keep all the dogs from escaping out into the corridor. They now stand facing you, snarling menacingly. Turn to 120.



#### 376

While you struggle, the plane has entered a steep dive. With the madman shrieking with insane glee, you try desperately to subdue him in time to prevent a disaster. But to no avail. The Tormentor is too powerful. Before you can get to the controls, the plane hurtles down to the runway and explodes, killing all on board ...



377

There is no sign of Knox anywhere around the test laboratories, but one scientist believes he saw a man fitting his description jump into a car and drive away from the Lab towards town. Do you want to follow this lead back into Titan City (turn to 254), or will you instead try the nuclear reactor (turn to 343)?



378

You fly up in front of the Devastator and land a heavy blow in its chest. The creature groans and turns to face you:

THE DEVASTATOR SKILL 14 STAMINA 12 If you defeat it, turn to 119. You fly out over the camp fence towards the advancing helicopters. Some twenty helicopters are flying low in towards the camp. You stop in mid-air as you see the insignia on the side of the leader. It is the death's head of F.E.A.R.! As it flies closer, you can see who is leading this attack. The Macro Brain! A product of genetic experimentation, like yourself, the Macro Brain has developed a tremendous intelligence. But unlike yourself, he has decided to use it to further the cause of evil. A formidable combination, you think. On your own there is little you could do against twenty choppers. But perhaps you could take out the leading one carrying your old foe ... As you consider this, a warning comes from your Crimewatch. 'COUNCIL BUILDINGS. FAST.' You consider your options. Will you decide to attack the leading helicopter to try to defeat the mastermind behind this attack (turn to 32), or will you leave this matter to the army and head into town to find out what is happening at Titan Council Buildings (turn to 154)?

380

You bind the Fire Warriors with rope and help the staff clear the damage until the police arrive. You may claim as many Hero Points as the number of Fire Warriors you captured. Then you had better change back to Jean Lafayette and make your way to work. If you want to run to work, turn to 301. If you feel it would be quicker to take the subway train, turn to 409.



381

The little man disappears into the back room. Five minutes later, he reappears with a tray. On the tray is your Peking Duck! He is most put out when you refuse to pay for the food. This is getting you nowhere. You leave the laundry. Turn to 368.



You remember your clue and follow its advice. When you arrive at the reservoir, you are surprised to find the office door unlocked. Inside, you find the reason why. The on-duty clerk is lying in a corner of the office, bound and gagged. You untie his hands and take the gag from his mouth. 'Crusader!' he whispers. 'Thank goodness you're here! But forget about me. You've got to get into the pump-house fast. It's the Poisoner. He's going to poison the water-supply! Quickly!' You rush to the pumphouse and fling back the door. A wild-haired man is leaning over a network of pipes, studying the valves. In his hand he holds a vial of liquid. As you enter, he wheels round. An evil grin greets you. 'The Silver Crusader, eh?' he laughs. 'So you think you can foil my plan. Well, hold your ground. See this vial? One step closer and I'll pour it into this intake and within an hour my poison will be flowing out of the taps of every household in Titan City!" You must stop the Poisoner before he can carry out his plan. If you have Energy Blast, turn to 320. If you have Psi-Powers, turn to 81. If you have Super Strength, turn to 25. If you have ETS, turn to 235.

You arrest the lion-tamer and take him down to police headquarters. The man is incredulous and protests his innocence all the way. When you arrive at headquarters, the desk sergeant wants to know what charges you are bringing against the liontamer. When you can offer no evidence at all as proof of his guilt, the sergeant shakes his head. The lion-tamer must be released. Calling you all the names under the sun, he leaves the station. You must lose 2 Hero Points for this wrongful arrest. Turn now to 148.

## 384

You concentrate hard on the creature's mind. It stops for a moment, shakes its head and looks at you. Are you getting through to it? You believe you are, and you step forward to increase your influence. This is a fatal mistake. For as you step forward, the Creature of Carnage snaps out of its trance and swats at you. You are knocked off your feet and your head cracks against a girder. You lose consciousness and you never see the results of the Creature's devastation. For it succeeds in bringing the whole stand down, killing hundreds of people – and you are among the dead . . .



You rush to the idol and check for the ear-rings. There are none there! The professor thumbs through the catalogue to double-check the idol. 'Er, ahem!' he snorts. 'Ah, my mistake, Crusader. This idol does not have ear-rings at all. My, my. I am getting very forgetful in my old age . . .' A false alarm. Looks like all is well, after all. You decide not to waste any further time here, and you leave. Turn to 276.



386

In the personal column of the newspaper you find an interesting snippet, which reads: 'Richard Storm. All is forgiven. How was I to know she was a private nurse? Phone me on 555-9999. Love, Susan.' A private nurse? What is this all about? If you now want to proceed to the bank as the Silver Crusader, turn to 112. If you want to go to work, turn to 341. You race after Utoshski through the milling crowds and catch a glimpse of him leaving the exhibition through a fire-door. You follow him into an alley. He is nowhere to be seen! He must have run to one end of the alley into the street. Will you try turning left (turn to 356) or right (turn to 324)?

## 388

It is hopeless. Your car is too slow to react. The two cars collide, not with each other, but into the young boy on the ground. The ride stops immediately as the boy's mother rushes on to the track shricking. Five minutes later an ambulance arrives to rush the boy to hospital. But it is too late; he has died. Feeling ashamed that you could do nothing to help the boy, you leave. You have had enough of Wisneyland for the day. Turn to 103.

## 389

You concentrate hard on the ice around the two swimmers. A puddle of water appears around them and their spirits rise. You are melting the ice! But the mental effort you are using is considerable. You must lose 4 STAMINA points to free the two girls, but when you have done so, you may add 2 Hero Points for undoubtedly saving their lives. You will not be able to melt the whole pool; you will have to leave this to time. You may leave by turning to 362. If you wish, you may check the pool heating-plant before you leave, by turning to 347. You try to smash the door. It shakes, but there is nothing you can do. It is made of ten-centimetre solid metal. Even your great strength cannot break it. You try again, but without success. However, your attempts to smash the door do attract the attentions of the crew. 'An intruder!' cries someone. 'Locked in the ejection chamber!' You can guess what they will do next. A rumbling sound from the walls around you is followed by a loud hissing. Next thing you know you are forcibly fired out of the submarine into the sea. The shock is too much for you. You pass out, never to regain consciousness. It doesn't take long for your lungs to fill with waler...



391

You arrive at a disused warehouse in the industrial district. The door is open and you can hear voices coming from upstairs. Will you creep slowly up the stairs, ready for action (turn to 277), or will you get up on the roof and swing through the window to surprise them (turn to 396)? You follow the Macro Brain into the Colonel's study and wait for the right moment to use Energy Blast. As you are about to send a Bolt, your opponent wheels round to face you. 'Crusader!' he laughs. 'So you have joined the army, eh? Well let's see if we can persuade you to join my army.' You try to fire your Bolt. Nothing happens! The tremendous mental powers of the Macro Brain have interfered with your own special abilities. Seconds later, you feel a sharp stabbing pain in your chest. Your old foe has developed much more far-reaching mental powers then he ever had before. You are powerless to prevent him sapping the energy from you! You fall to your knees in submission, but still he will not relent. For the Macro Brain will not stop until you have been reduced to a virtual mindless zombie. Your career as a superhero is over . . .

#### 393

The crowd love you. You sign autographs for ten minutes and kiss a couple of babies, then make your excuses and leave. Jonah Whyte will be *furious* when you arrive at work. But your public-spirited attitude has been good for PR. Add 1 Hero Point and head for work. Turn to 435. 394

When you arrive in Xavier Hangar, mechanics are servicing two executive jets. You find a pair of overalls hanging on the wall, slip into them and wander around. There is nothing suspicious. In fact you are not expecting anything to happen for a couple of hours. What time of day are you expecting the meeting to take place? Add this time to today's date and add the result to this reference. If the resulting reference makes no sense, turn to 220.



395

An obliging attendant is happy to show you the body of the mysterious man. He looks up a file and reaches for the handle on a cadaver drawer. His eyes open wide as he pulls the drawer out. It is empty! He double-checks the number and shakes his head. 'I can't understand it!' he says. 'I put him in here myself! And I've been here all the time except for... my coffee break.' The trail ends here. There are no clues as to the whereabouts of the missing body. You can leave the hospital by turning to **226**.



You time your swing perfectly. The Mantrapper and two henchmen are sitting just inside, with Drew Swain tied up on a chair nearby. Smashing through the glass, you land in the centre of the group, your feet catching both henchmen. One topples over backwards and rolls into a self-locking cage, which slams shut, trapping him inside. The other rolls over to the stairwell and crashes through the bannister to land with a thud at the bottom of the stairs. Now it's just you against the Mantrapper:

MANTRAPPER

SKILLS STAMINA7

If you defeat him, turn to 16.



#### 397

The crowd cheers as you walk down the steps of the building. You are surrounded by energetic hands thrusting pieces of paper at you. You have signed a dozen or so autographs when your ears prick up. A cry is coming from a shop a few doors down: 'Stop! *Thief!*' Sounds like a job for the Silver Crusader! You break through the crowd to investigate. Turn to 256.



#### 398

Under the watchful eye of your boss, you complete the morning's work. At lunch-time, you take a corner booth at El Greco's, a cheap diner on the next block. While you are eating, a chattering group of boffin-types scramble into the booth next to yours. They are trying to keep their voices down, but their obvious excitement allows you to catch the gist of their conversation. They are from the local university's science laboratory. 'Well, I think the man's a fool" says one. 'If he mixes the aldehyde in at *that* temperature there could be an almighty explosion.' 'Maybe you're right,' says another. 'He's a stubborn old jackass. He'd never admit it was dangerous. I know one thing; we're much safer out here!' Hmmm, you think. Sounds ominous. Perhaps you'd better check it out. The group's securitypasses identify them as being from the Biochemistry Department – only a block away. You pay your bill and leave quickly. Halfway there, you stop. From within the shop you are passing, a cry reaches you. 'Stop! *Thief!*' Will you investigate this call for help (turn to **256**), or do you think stopping a potential explosion is a much more important task (turn to **144**)?

## 399

Honking furiously, he pulls you round to the far side of the circus towards a large, brightly coloured caravan. You walk up the steps and open the door. 'Good afternoon, good afternoon!' says a plump lady behind a desk inside. 'We have only a few seats left for tonight's performance, but I'm sure we can find you something suitable. How many tickets do you want?' You explain that you have not come for tickets. Will you ask her where you can find the owner of the circus and follow her directions (turn to 223), or will you ask her whether she knows anything about any escaped animals (turn to 291)?

The Bolt catches the assassin in the back. He howls and throws up his hands, losing his grip on the rifle, which drops from the roof. The shock has made him lose his balance and he slumps forward, over the edge of the roof! You rush to the edge just in time to see him land in the crowd below, no doubt causing some considerable injuries to the onlookers. You have saved the President's life, but have also caused a serious accident. Add 1 Hero Point and turn to 311.

#### 401

One of the dogs has not been fully subdued! It breaks past you through the door and rushes into the crowd, growling menacingly. You must pursue it immediately before it can harm anyone:

## RADIATION DOG SKILL 7 STAMINAS

If it rolls a higher Attack Strength than your own, turn to 31, but first note this reference, as you will have to return here afterwards. If you defeat the dog, turn to 247.

#### 402

You pull a small metal gadget from your Accessory Belt and aim it at the boxes. Your Forcefield Generator hums; the boxes sway, topple over and fall on the thief. There is a shrill scream. The protruding foot shakes and then rests still. Cautiously, you walk over to investigate. Turn to 286. The study is not empty. As you enter, a figure stands over the desk, leafing through a notebook and taking pictures with a radio camera! The maid screams at the sight of the Smoke, an ethereal villain who is able to turn himself at will into a vapour. As you enter he drops the camera and smiles. Turning himself into a whisk of brown smoke, he streaks across the room and disappears through the airconditioner. You race outside the house. Turn to 29.



404

You have no special gadgets you can use against such a creature, the likes of which you have never seen before. You will have to light it:

# FOUNTAIN

SKILLIO STAMINA 11

Your first hit will cause it to drop the injured girl into the fountain. When you have inflicted your fourth hit, turn to 65.

### 405

You reach into a thorny bush and your fingers touch a metallic object. Grasping it as best you can, you pull out a gold medallion hanging on a delicate chain. As you turn it over in your hand, you realize it is undoubtedly quite valuable. The medallion has the initials D.R. engraved on it. Will you hand this over to the police (turn to 251), or take it to a jeweller (turn to 17)? Alternatively you may wish to visit another address. If so, add together the number and street number of this address and turn to this reference.

## 406

The Alchemists emerge, and you turn on your Sonic Confuser. In front of you, the gang raise their hands to their ears and scream with pain. But around them, pedestrians, including two young girls, are doing the same. You cannot risk harming the public. You fiddle with the gadget to turn it off, but already the gang have turned the corner and escaped. You have lost them! Turn to 372.

#### 407

Test your Luck. If you are Lucky, turn to 196. If you are Unlucky, turn to 56.



When you arrive at the zoo gates, you question the attendant, asking whether there have been any reports of animals escaping from their cages over the last couple of days. The attendant is obviously excited to see you. 'Gosh. Hi, Crusader!' he stammers. 'Er, ves. I did hear something about an escape. But I don't know any more about it. You'll have to ask the Director. I'll take you to him if you like.' You tell him to lead the way. But as you turn to follow him, a beep - beep - beep comes from your wrist. You hold the Crimewatch up to your ear. 'MUSEUM OF EGYPTIAN HERITAGE,' it speaks. Do you want to follow its advice and head straight away for the museum (turn to 158), or will you ignore this message and instead follow the attendant (turn to 26)?

#### 409

The office is only two stops away. Surprisingly, you don't have to wait long for a train to arrive. You sit and contemplate a good excuse to give to Mr Whyte, who is bound to be in a foul mood when you arrive, but a cry interrupts your thoughts. 'Help!' you hear, from a voice at the other end of the carriage. Oh, no! What is it this time? As if in answer, the voice cries: 'PICKPOCKET!' You had better see if you can help -but there will be no opportunity to change into the Silver Crusader. Will you go and help the man (turn to 185), or will you ignore him and concern yourself with getting to work on time for once (turn to 301)?



You arrive at Parker Airport and ask the nearest security guard whether anything is happening. 'The Silver Crusader!' he gasps. 'Thank goodness you're here! Follow me. I'll take you to the Control Tower.' You follow him up into the Control Tower where you find the place buzzing with activity. The Air-Traffic Controller greets you nervously. 'Have you heard? No? The police are on their way. Some guy calling himself "the Tormentor" has hijacked a DC10 full of passengers to London. He's mad! No demands; nothing, Says he'll crash the plane. Blames it all on "Susan". We don't know what to do. A complete nutter! Is there anything you can do?' Is there anything you can do? If 'Susan' means anything to you, turn to 141. If not, you can use your powers. If you have Super Strength, turn to 84. If you have Psi-Powers, turn to 216. Otherwise, turn to 176.

You press the button on your Circuit Jammer. The Cyborg's grin fades as the device affects its electronic functions. Its abilities have been reduced to those of an ordinary man! Now you may battle the villain on more equal terms:

TITANIUM CYBORG 5KH1.9 STAMINA 10

If you defeat the villain, turn to 19.

#### 412

You arrive at police headquarters and speak to Lieutenant Wojak, who seems to be quite distressed. 'The news has leaked out, Crusader,' he explains. 'We were trying to keep the Poisoner's threats a secret, but it seems some reporter got his hands on the story. The Poisoner has asked for a million in unmarked notes by this evening, otherwise he says everyone in Titan City will suffer. You know the guy: he's a madman. And he's involved with that F.E.A.R. organization. What can we do?" Apparently two citizens have already died from minute traces of poison found in their milk-bottles. You offer to try to track him down. Where will you begin your search? The Cowfield Dairy (turn to 361), or the city's largest drug store in Schuter Mall (turn to 268)? If there is somewhere else you'd like to go, you will know how to get there.

413

You have no time to concentrate; she attacks straight away. Resolve this combat:

SKILLG

TIGER CAT

STAMINA 8

If you win, turn to 217.

#### 414

You leap into the air and shoot after the van. Half a kilometre ahead, you see it about to make a turn. You drop down in front of it, forcing it to stop. The driver stares. 'Say,' he greets you. 'Ain't you that Crusader cat? Well, I sure am glad to meet you. Yesiree.' You tell him you are going to take a look in the back of his van and step round to the back. He follows you, still jabbering. 'But why, Crusader baby? Ain't nothin' in there but a coupl'a porkies, a coupl'a chicken . . .' You open the door and are greeted with a blast which knocks you three metres backwards, to land in a lifeless heap in the road." 'Oh yeah, Nearly forgot,' chuckles the man, 'an' a laser cannon. That ol' Mantrapper sure do have things worked out well. Yes indeed.' You have fallen right into a cleverly executed trap. The van was merely a decoy. And a deadly one at that: your mistake has cost you your life . . .

## 417-418

#### 415

Quick as a flash, you reach forward and grab the girl in the nick of time before she plunges to certain death. Her parents are horrified at the dreadful accident which might have occurred. When the ride is over, they thank you profusely for saving their daughter's life. You decide that you have had enough of Wisneyland. Turn to 103.

## 416

He studies the closed-circuit security screens which are focused on the main treasures of his collection. Everything seems to be in order. But he does study one screen rather closely. It is a figurehead of the god Amon-Ra, festooned with golden jewellery. He is not sure whether there is supposed to be a pair of golden ear-rings on the idol. Do you want to go and check it (turn to 385), or will you instead check the main exhibit, the sarcophagus of Princess Ankalis (turn to 240)?



417

There is nothing particularly suspicious about the boat. Indeed it would be a most unsuitable place to have a meeting, since there is no room for anyone apart from the crew on board. Turn to 368.



418

From your Accessory Belt you draw out your Directional Sound Neutralizer. Focusing it on the noisy crowd, you send a charge into the centre. Its effect is immediate. By neutralizing all the sound-waves within range of its effect, no one can hear what anyone else is saying! Baifled by their apparent deafness, the crowd turn towards you. You turn off the Sound Neutralizer. Voices whisper: 'The Silver Crusader!' In a booming voice you command them to cease their squabbling and disperse. They do as you say. Now you must change back into your street clothes and choose your next move. Will you continue your original journey to work (turn to 341), or head into Audubon Park (turn to 165)?

You concentrate hard on the immensely powerful mind within Sidney Knox's body. You must resolve the following combat as if it were a normal fight, but in this case, it represents a mind-to-mind battle between Knox's will and your own. While fighting this one out, your SKILL is the same as your current SKILL score, and your 'mental' STAMINA is 6 (you will not lose any 'real' STAMINA points).

## SIDNEY KNOX SKILL7 STAMINA6

Each time you lose a round of combat, the effect on your physical body wears down your SKILL. You must permanently lose 1 SKILL point for each Attack Round which you lose. If you defeat him, turn to 358. If you wish to break mental combat, you will have to attack him physically (turn to 33).





#### 420

The Manager, Roger Stevens, wants to do all he can to help. He was woken in the early morning by a call from the police. The Alchemists, masters of advanced chemistry, had neutralized the alarm with some sort of acidic gas which delayed its being activated as they forced their way in. Another unknown compound had dissolved the security lock on the main door. Why the security guard had not noticed the intruders was still a mystery which would only be solved when the time-lock released him from the vault. You ask him about his depositbox holders and he becomes less co-operative. Some of the boxes are owned by important citizens, and their identities must not be disclosed. Will you try to find out more about the deposit-box owners (turn to 83), or question the Chief Detective (turn to 323) or the security guard (turn to 259)?

Using a Spectral Analyser, you are surprised to discover that the police chief's guess was probably not far from the truth. The creature seems to be made of a sort of rock. The nearest equivalent is the kind of substance found in fallen meteors! But how will you attempt to defeat it? If you have a vial of phenolic acid, turn to 340. If you want to try to take it on with your bare hands, turn to 262. If you feel this creature is a little too strong for you, turn to 319.

#### 422

You concentrate on the creature's mind, but you are unable to get through to it. In fact you are unsure whether it has a mind at all, or whether it is motivated simply by instinct. You try a different tack. Running round the side of the empty grave, you watch the creature carefully as it follows you. As it steps forwards, you *will* the ground to open up under its foot. A crack appears on the ground and when the Reincarnation's foot touches the soil, it drops a metre into the grave! The jolt has injured it, but certainly has not stopped it. You must now turn to 373 to fight it, but deduct 4 STAMINA points from its score, for the fall it has just had. You study the cigarette packet. It is an ordinary packet of Karlsboroughs, but contains no cigarettes. The piece of paper inside makes no sense at all; a few meaningless words strung together. Is it really meaningless, or perhaps some kind of code? If it is a code, it means nothing to you. If you have ETS, you could take it home and run it through your Decoding Computer (turn to 329). But this will take some time, and you ought to be getting to work. Otherwise you can save it, and give it some thought later (turn to 86).



424

You spend half an hour winding round the stacked shelves of the supermarket, choosing what you will be eating over the next couple of days. Eventually you pay for your groceries and leave. Turn to 226.



The crowds are gathering to get into the exhibition, and a huge banner proclaims: 'APPLIANCES OF THE FUTURE - See Tomorrow's Home Technology Today!' As you wander through the exhibitions, there are many excited voices enthusing over the more ambitious gadgets on show. The 'Clothing Service Station', for example, is a machine which takes in dirty washing and cleans, dries and irons it, ready to wear. A 'Cocktail Composer' puts together all the ingredients of a cocktail. 'The Perfect Opponent' is a games-playing computer which can learn the rules of any game and will play at eight different levels of skill. Robots are there in many forms. A 'Tidy Maid' remembers where everything goes in a room and will replace everything in its proper position. On a large stand, a man with round glasses and a loud voice is demonstrating his firm's 'Tireless Butler', a man-sized Android which will do many home chores. You stare at him, His face looks familiar, but you can't quite place him. The Android passes him a cigarette as he is bending down, but catches his hair and moves it slightly. A wig! Of course! With a bald head, his identity is obvious. Although he is not easy to recognize without the cybernetic enhancers he wears on his arms and his distinctive - and very dangerous - eye-goggles, it most certainly is Vladimir Utoshski, head of F.E.A.R.! You quickly nip away to change into the Silver Crusader, and return to capture the villain. But he is quick. He sees you coming, flicks a switch at the back of the Android, and darts off into the crowd. A whirring sound

comes from the Android. It turns towards a man studying its arm and smashes him across the face with a powerful blow! Screams break out and the Android goes berserk, charging into the crowd, arms flailing. Will you pursue Utoshski (turn to 387), or is your first duty to save the visitors from the mad Android (turn to 62)?



#### 426

Like a true hero, you grasp the bottle between your hands and try to smother the explosion. But the bottle is boiling-hot! You scream in pain as it burns your hands badly. You must lose 2 SKILL points and must now decide whether to fling the bottle through an open window (turn to 269 – but you need not lose another SKILL point), or rush off to look for a fire-extinguisher (turn to 89). You quietly slip into the Colonel's office and find the Macro Brain leafing through files. After your last encounter with the Macro Brain, you devised what you hope will be the perfect weapon against him, an Alpha-wave Emitter. You draw it from your Accessory Belt and set it going. If your theory is correct, generating alpha waves on such a highly developed mind will cause acute mental anguish - perhaps even epileptic fits, in such a sensitive subject. The Macro Brain clutches at his ears and spins round to face you. 'Agarghh!' he cries, clutching his ears with his hands. 'Crusader! It is you! If this is one of your devices, switch it off!' You smile at his obvious discomfort. You will switch it off if he tells you all he knows about the F.E.A.R. meeting which is to take place soon. The Alpha-wave Emitter is agonizing for him. 'All right! All right!' he agrees. 'The meeting is due to take place at a Chinese laundry, tomorrow. But that is all I know. Now switch that damn thing off!' You switch off your device and pin the Macro Brain's arms behind his back. You march him out into the courtyard, and the sight of your hostage ends the battle quickly. The F.E.A.R. troops surrender to the army. You may add 6 Hero Points for capturing the Macro Brain. Now you can return to town. Turn to 311.

You resume your shopping-tour downtown. Will you make for 'Verging Records' to go and have a look at what new albums have come out recently (turn to 189), or will you have a look in the window of Epiphany's, the famous jeweller's (turn to 300)?

What can you get him? An apple? A bottle of whisky? A new tie? You decide to go for something a little more imaginative. Do you want to head downstairs to the Book Department (turn to 42) or upstairs to the Games Department (turn to 355)? Some time later, things begin to happen. One of the jets is evidently ready and is being prepared for a flight. Six figures, dressed in heavy coats with turned-up collars, appear and get on board. Although you cannot make out any of their faces, one figure stands out as being much bulkier than the rest. His coat is an unnatural fit, bulging at all the wrong places. As he steps into the aircraft, the clang of metal on metal confirms your suspicions. Feet of steel! It is the Titanium Cyborg! Quickly you find a hiding-place and change into the Silver Crusader. But just as quickly, the jet is leaving the hangar and taxiing up the runway! What is your power:

You may award yourself 2 Hero Points for defeating Mustapha Kareem, alias the Mummy, The curator, needless to say, is incredulous when you explain what happened; Kareem had been with him for eleven years. Turn to 276. As the young starlet picks herself up and thanks you, the Serpent moans and pleads for mercy. He can offer you some information and wants to do a deal. He will tell you what he knows if you will release him. But you have sworn to uphold justice and can agree to no such deal. You explain that you can only suggest that helping you by relating this information may make the judge a little easier on him. Reluctantly he agrees. He tells you two pieces of information. First of all, you learn that the Creature of Carnage is in fact Illya Karpov, a known agent of F.E.A.R. Also he has heard that there will be an assassination attempt on the life of the President when he visits Titan City. The killer will be hiding on the roof of the Regent Hotel. If you decide to watch the President's arrival, add 100 to the reference you are on when you arrive to apprehend the assassin. You may add 2 LUCK points for this information. After you have handed him over to the police, turn to 79. You may add 2 Hero Points for rescuing Lola Manche.

The Ringmaster pleads with you not to hand him over to the police; he has no wish to spend any more time in jail. In desperation he gives you a clue, which may or may not be useful. He tells you that the Ice Queen, in the disguise of her alter ego, Sylvia Frost, has bought the Titan abattoir. If you come across evidence of the Ice Queen's activities, deduct 20 from the reference you are on at the time and turn to this new reference. You may add t LUCK point for this information. The Ringmaster is hopeful that you will release him for telling you this news. Of course you are not willing to bargain with the man. You hand him over to the police and may award yourself 3 Hero Points. Now turn to 148.

You manage to push through the crowd and you see a man's body slumped on the ground lying in a pool of blood. His head hangs at an unnatural angle. Judging from his clothes, he was a wealthy man, and a brown hide briefcase with gold fastenings lies by his side. But by now the police cordon is forcing you, along with the other onlookers, away from the scene. Turn to 181.

'Lafayette! Get in here at once!' No sooner had you stepped through the office door than Jonah Whyte's booming voice summoned you. You creep into his office, mumbling scanty excuses for being late vet again. 'Enough!' he yells. 'What do you think we are running here? A charity? Do you suppose I should be grateful that you even grace us with your presence? Very noble of you indeed to even bother coming in at all! Well, I tell you what. I'm feeling kind today. You can have the rest of the day off. Without pay! And if you're not in first thing tomorrow morning, you can start looking for another job!" You slink out of his office with your tail between your legs. How can you tell him what you've been doing? And now you've been suspended for a day. Where will you go? Will you spend the day at Wisneyland, the amusement park (turn to 15), or will you go downtown to do some shopping (turn to 202)?

You leap aside to avoid being bowled over by the huge frozen weight. Quick as a flash, the Ice Queen is upon you! You must fight her:

ICE QUEEN

SKILL 7 STAMINAS

The Ice Queen's touch is dangerous. Each time she lands a blow on you, its effect will be to freeze part of your body. You must deduct 1 SKILL point for each successful attack she makes on you. You will not regain this SKILL until the next time you gain STAMINA points. If you defeat the Ice Queen, turn to 241. You leap on the leader and grapple with him on the floor. Although you have separated him from his test-tube rack, the Alchemist still has in his hand a tube of nerve-gas. While you fight him, you must take special care that he is not able to break the tube or else the innocent citizens – not to mention you – may be harmed. In view of this precaution, you must deduct 2 points from your Attack Strength during the struggle:

First ALCHEMIST SKILL8 STAMINA6

If the Alchemist should inflict a hit on you, you must *Test your Luck*. If you are Lucky, continue as normal. If you are Unlucky, you must turn immediately to 28. If you defeat the Alchemist you may go for the others (turn to 354).



You make your way home and spend the rest of the night relaxing in front of the TV after the day's excitement. You may add 6 STAMINA points for the rest. The next morning you leave for work early. You travel by bus. As the bus enters Radd Square, you notice a disturbed crowd in the centre of the square. Something is happening! At that very moment, your Crimewatch sounds! You hold it to your ear and hear its message: 'COWFIELD DAIRY.' FAST. Quickly you get off the bus. Will you investigate the disturbance in Radd Square (turn to 201), or will you follow your Crimewatch's instructions and head towards Cowfield Dairy, two blocks away (turn to 369)?

The Rotating Room is a huge barrel on its side which tumbles over and over. The people inside try desperately to walk forward at the same speed as it rotates in order to keep their footing; walking too fast or too slow means they fall over. There are three people inside as you enter and they are happy to leave at your request. Keeping your footing, you examine the inside and find a delicate key which has become stuck to the surface in a piece of chewinggum. You decide to take it for examination. Turn to 37.



The police are amazed. Single-handedly you have defeated the most dangerous association of criminals known to the world! And the extent of their dastardly plans soon becomes clear. Utoshski had developed a transmitting computer centre which was capable of overriding transmissions from the Pentagon to the US 'Star Wars' satellite orbiting the earth. He was able completely to control the super weapons on board the satellite, capable of decimating an entire city at the push of a button. His objective was the domination of the civilized countries of the world.

But you have foiled his plan. The Pentagon security codes can be changed almost immediately. And the Titanium Cyborg will be closely guarded for the rest of his life. You have earned 10 Hero Points for this victory. You can honestly say that you have saved the world from F.E.A.R. itself!

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
