FREE JEWELS

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These 33 shiny baubles, from the cheap to the one-of-a-kind, show what can be done with *All the Treasures of the World: JEWELS* and *All the Treasures of the World: GEMS*, both from Faster Monkey GamesTM. For some items, details of the calculations are given. The full rules allow generation and evaluation of thousands more.

Under 10 gp

- † Pin (Size 2) of tin (24 cp), shaped in an artistic representation (x2) of wings. 48 cp, rounded to 5 sp.
- † Child's leather string (6 cp) of eight brightlypolished tin charms (68 cp): bird, cow, fish, heart, horse, moon, rabbit, and star. 74 cp rounded to 7 sp.
- ₹ Copper ring. Very common item. 1 gp.
- ↑ Dancer's rattle: Imitation coins (Size 4) in bronze (16 sp), each stamped with a flower design (artistic representation, value x2). The coins are strung on a fine bronze chain (+4 sp) for a total worth of 36 sp.
- ₹ Silver bracelet: A thin bangle, often worn in bunches by prosperous matrons. 4 gp each.
- ₹ Silver bangle as above, plus gold tracery: 5 gp.
- Y Girl's ring (Size 1) of copper-nickel-gold mix (equivalent of gold plated copper), with cutouts forming a "greek key" design: 4 gp.
- Nhaman's Spirit Armor: Chest-plate (Size 6) of ivory beads (6 gp), stained in a geometric pattern (+3 gp). 9 gp.



10 gp+

† Bronze bracer, showing a heraldic shield against a finely-hatched background: 10 gp.

- Y Gold earring: A small hoop, such as worn by pirates to show their ability to pay for their own funerals. 10 gp.
- Toe-ring in the form of a twist of silver wire with a single red garnet on the end: 10 gp.
- † Fancy silver armband: A thick silver bracelet enameled with a wave-like meander design in black glass. 18 gp.
- The Cheap silver-plate crown: Iron crown of 12 points (Size 5, value 5 sp), decorated with cutouts (+10 sp), plated in silver (+30 sp), studded with twelve matching 1 gpv amethysts (+14.4 gp), value 18.9 gp rounded to 19 gp.
- Plain gold ring: A common item. In some cultures, used as a standard unit of currency. 20 gp.

25 gp+

- Y Ivory cloak-clasp, carved as a bunch of grapes and enameled with purple glass: 25 gp.
- † Thick steel collar, engraved in horizontal stripes and covered with 36 quartz crystals: 25 gp.
- ↑ Diamond ring, cheap: Bronze ring (8 sp) with gold plating (+6 gp) and a tiny, flawed, yellowish diamond chip (25 gp). 31.8 gp value, rounded to 32 gp.

50 gp+

- Noting Silver spurs, pair, skillfully worked like shooting stars: 50 gp.
- Y Substantial platinum navel-stud: 50 gp.
- Man's ring: Chunky ring (Size 3) of gold (30 gp), with a bumpy surface (+3 gp) forming a fake ore-nugget texture (artistic representation, value x2). Value 66 gp.



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100 gp+

- Mystic amulet of silver, parcel-plated with a masterful depiction of a benignly-smiling sun in gold; silver chain: 100 gp.
- Red gold torc, skillfully carved like bark with an acorn at each tip: 100 gp.
- † Diamond ring, moderate: Plain electrum ring (12 gp) with a yellow diamond. 112 gp.
- ₹ Gold bracelet: Size 3 (30 gp), stamped (+3 gp) with a skillful representation (value x4) of 12 birds and a simpler image of 9 stars (x2, but only the higher multiple applies). The birds fly to the stars, I guess. 132 gp.

250 gp+

- † Gold ring with 14 orange-red spinels around it, cloisonné in thin-walled gold chambers: 250 gp.
- † Hairnet of braided silver wire, with 48 perfect crystals of rose quartz at the knots: 250 gp.

500 gp+

- Silver tiara: Size 4 (8 gp), of filigree (+4 gp), studded with eight 50 gpv gems (four matching fire opals and four matching blue spinels, +480 gpv), total worth of 492 gp rounded to 500 gp.
- Normal Brooch (Size 3) of white gold filigree, skillfully shaped into a lacy flower (132 gp); on the flower, a masterfully realistic gold bee (96 gp) with onyx bands (8 gp), silver-lace wings (24 gp) and eyes of blue-black sapphire (matched pair, 240 gp). 500 gp.
- Note That Diamond ring, expensive: Platinum ring (100 gp) engraved (+10 gp) with a skillful abstract design (value x2) of interlocking circles, holding a white diamond solitaire (+500 gp), for a worth of 720 gp.

1,000 gp+

- Y Perfect ruby ear-stud: 1,000 gp.
- † Platinum chain (50 gp) with engraved platinum locket (165 gp), hinged to reveal a huge opal carved into beautiful cameo of a woman (800 gp). 1,015 gp, or rounded to 1,000 gp.

2,500 gp+

- **Tongue paume" bracelet: Substantial white gold bracelet (Size 3, 27 gp) built in joined sections (+6 gp) with no pattern, with each section holding a 100 gp diamond (2d6 x Size 3 = 21 stones, 2,100 gp plus matching bonus of 420 gp). 2,553 gp rounded to 2,500 gp.
- Nonpareil necklace: Segmented necklace (Size 4) of electrum (24 gp), engraved (+8 gp) and woven with sections of gold (+12 gp) to form a masterful representation (value x8) of a fanned peacock's tail (value without gems: 352 gp). A huge emerald (1,000 gpv) occupies the great spot of the central feather, with sixteen smaller feathers to each side. On each of these, the green spot is a rare star peridot or a large cat's-eye tourmaline (32 gems of 50 gpv each, plus matching, for a gem value of 1,920 gp). All 33 feathers are sprinkled with many small green garnets (80 gems of 5 gpv each: 480 gp with matching). Grand total: 3,750 gp value.

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
