### Known Powers:

**Absorb Electricity:** The Monster has an UN (100) ability to absorb electricity and electrical attacks. The rank of the electrical attack can be used to recover any lost health on a point per point basis. The Monster may channel the excess energy into his Strength if he so chooses. In this case, raise the creature's Strength to be equal to the rank of the electrical attack for 1-10 rounds. After which time, his Strength

will return to it's base ranks.

**Body Armor:** The Monster's thick skin and dense bone structure provide him with PR (4) protection against all physical attacks. In addition, all color results rolled against the creature are reduced by one color effect, making him immune to Red results.

**Immortality:** The Monster was created through artificial means, as such he does not age and will live forever.

**Iron Will:** The Monster is capable of shrugging off pain that would bring most men to their knees with EX (20) ability.

**Recovery:** The Monster regains lost Endurance ranks at a far greater rank than the average human. He regains one additional rank each day.

**Regeneration:** The Monster has impressive regenerative abilities, he may recover 2 points of health each turn that he is not involved in combat or strenuous activity. His recuperative powers are unable to erase the many scars and marks of decomposition on his body.

**Resist Disease:** The Monster possesses a Class 1000 immunity to all diseases.

**Suspended Animation:** If The Monster is subjected to cold of at least RM (30) intensity, he will enter into a state of suspended animation until such time as his body is in a properly warm environ. He must surpass an Endurance FEAT roll versus the intensity of the cold to avoid this event.

**Limitation-Fear Of Fire:** Due to an unfortunate encounter with fire during his early existence, The Monster has developed an irrational fear of fire. He must pass a successful Psyche FEAT roll whenever he is confronted with fire or he will cower in fear for as long as the fire presents itself to him.

**Talents:** Occult Lore, Stamina

### History:

#### 1788

In 1788, Victor Frankenstein left his family estate in Geneva, Switzerland to study natural science at the University Of Ingolstadt. While there, he became obsessed with the ideal of creating life from dead tissue and thus, he began the process of robbing graves to obtain the body parts he would need for his diabolical experiments. Victor stitched together a monstrous body and he subjected it to chemical treatments and radical electrolysis. Frankenstein's experiments were successful and he brought his creation to life. As the first signs of life were displayed by the creature, the full horror of what he had endeavored weighed upon Victor and he fled back to his homeland of Geneva, Switzerland, abandoning his creation at it's inception. The Monster was left to fend for itself.

For days, The Monster wandered the forests and he nearly perished of starvation. He eventually encountered a savage grizzly bear, which he wrestled and killed. After consuming the raw meat of the bear, The Monster skinned the carcass and fashioned a makeshift coat, which he would wear for many years. As the weeks passed, the monster continued wandering the countryside, doing his utmost to avoid human contact. The entire time, he began to nurture an all consuming hatred for his creator, Victor Frankenstein. The creature's travels eventually brought him to a small cottage owned by the De Lacy family. For several days the creature observed the family and discovered that the family's patriarch was an old blind man. Here was a being who would not shriek in terror at the monster's grotesque appearance. The Monster concealed himself in a stable for several days until he had the chance to meet the old man



alone. As luck would have it, a wolf strayed into the cottage and threatened to kill old De Lacy. The Monster came to the old man's rescue and killed the beast, then he slowly nursed De Lacy back to health. Before long, De Lacy's children returned to the cottage, and mistook the monster for a savage murderer. Shouting their lamentations, they chased the creature away from the cottage and back into the woods. Eventually the creature would find his way to Geneva where he would learn that his creators bloodline resided. Still nursing a deep seated hatred for all things Frankenstein, the creature decided to brutally extract his revenge by murdering Victor's younger brother, William. To further confound the tragedy, he framed the Frankenstein's servant, Justine Moritz, for the crime. Justine was sentenced for murder and hanged, but Victor knew that his poor brother had been murdered by his own vile creation.

Victor would later meet with the monster for the second time in a mountain cave far to the north of the Von Frankenstein family estate. The monster told Victor of his experiences and tragedies, then he demanded that Victor create for him a mate. Victor felt he had little choice but to relent to the monster to spare his family the creature's wrath. As such, he set about creating a female version of the monster. The Monster himself, kept a close vigil over Victor and his work, and even assisted by providing Victor with a fresh human heart for the experiment. Victor brought the second creature to life, but was so disgusted by the sight of it, that he immediately destroyed it before she had taken her first breath.

The Monster was outraged and he became incensed with anger and hatred. His need for revenge against Victor Frankenstein intensified, and he satisfied his desire for vengeance by strangling Victor's close friend, Henry Clerval. The Monster then tracked down Victor and his newly wed bride,

Elizabeth. On their blissful wedding night, The Monster appeared and slew Victor's innocent bride. Consumed by grief for his lost love, Victor vowed to track the creature down and destroy him. Victor trailed the creature to the North Pole, sacrificing his own health in his crusade to find and destroy his creation. Victor would contract Pneumonia and would perish before he could destroy the brute.

Despite his consuming hatred for Victor Frankenstein, the creature was extremely "distraught" over the loss of his only father that he would ever know. Now the creature yearned for his own destruction, if such a thing were even possible. The creature began to wander the frozen plains of the arctic to locate a place to build his own funeral pyre. As he journeyed, he slowly entered warmer climates and discovered a small tribal camp. A community of brutish neanderthal men, they attacked the monster en masse. None of the brutish men could overcome the monster or his great strength, and Frankenstein's creation easily battered them back. The tribe's chieftain recognized the creature's great strength and ordered his warriors to stand down. He invited the creature to stay with them and they made him an honorary tribe member.

Some days later, a nomadic tribe of rival barbarians raided the neanderthal camp. The Monster joined with his newly found brethren in battling the invaders back, many of the neanderthals would perish. The barbarian invaders tried their best to destroy Frankenstein's creation but they ultimately failed. During the raid, the neanderthal chieftain was mortally wounded. The Monster carried his broken form away from the battle so that he could perish in the traditions of his people. After erecting a funeral pyre for his chieftain, a massive quake erupted beneath his feet. The Monster fell from the precipice he stood upon and plunged into the icy

waters below. The extreme cold rendered him inert, and he would remain trapped in the ice for the next one hundred years.

## 1898

In January of 1898, explorer Robert Walton IV, mounted an expedition unto the North Pole. Walton was the great grandson of the explorer who first encountered Victor Frankenstein in 1798. He and his crew came upon the frozen remains of the Frankenstein Monster. Walton recognized the creature from the stories that had been passed down to him and he ordered it brought aboard the ship. Several crew members were disillusioned with Walton bringing the giant's body on board and they mutinied. During the conflict, a fire broke out in the ship's lower cabins, and the intense heat revived the Frankenstein Monster. The creature lashed out and took a young cabin's boy named Sean Farrell as hostage. To make matters worse, Walton's ship collided with an iceberg, killing several crewmen. Both Walton and Sean Farrell passed away, but before he perished, Walton informed the creature that Victor Frankenstein's last living descendant was still alive.

Forging a small wooden raft for himself, the Monster began a personal voyage to track down the last remaining Frankenstein. The first leg of his journey brought him to a small hamlet in Scandinavia. While there, the monster discovered the villagers planning to execute a comely young lass named Lenore. Empathizing with Lenore's persecution, the creature rescued her only to discover that the reason the villagers wanted to execute her was because she was a werewolf. The Monster battle with the werewolf under the light of the full moon, and he would eventually end her existence by using her father's silver tipped sword to free her from her curse.



The creature's journey eventually brought him back to the land of his creation, Germany. Returning to Ingolstadt, the creature entered the now dilapidated ruins of Castle Frankenstein wherein, he would discover a horde of misshapen and mindless servants. These pathetic beings were the slaves of a military man named Colonel Blackstone. Blackstone had taken residence in Castle Frankenstein and he had acquired a giant mutated spider which could steal the souls of men. Blackstone captured The Monster and made plans to convert him into another one of his mindless slaves. The Monster managed to break free and Blackstone himself was killed in the ensuing scuffle.

Leaving Ingolstadt, The Monster continued his journey through the Bavarian countryside. En route, he encountered an old gypsy named Marguerita who told the monster she possessed information about the last surviving Frankenstein. The Monster remained with Marguerita for a short time, until he discovered that she was indeed, a vampire. Marguerita tricked The Monster into helping her resurrect the Lord Of Vampires, Count Dracula. Enraged by Marguerita's treachery, The Monster slew her outright and engaged in battle with Dracula, Lord Of Vampires. Dracula attempted to prey on the monster and devour his blood. However, Dracula was still weak from his long rest in the grave and he was not prepared for a prolonged battle with the Frankenstein

Monster. Dracula was still a force to be reckoned with however, and he gravely wounded the Frankenstein Monster's throat, rendering him mute and unable to speak. Dracula fled from the battle and he returned to Transylvania to recover his might. Moments after the

strangled him to death if not for Ivan's interference. Ivan's strength was great enough that he could hold the Frankenstein Monster at bay. Frankenstein calmed the monster and revealed to him that it may be possible to transplant his brain into a normal human

body. The Monster still suspicious of Vincent's motives, relented and agreed to travel with him to England. There, in the basement of an old London townhouse, did Vincent Frankenstein prepare the monster for surgery. The creature realized that Vincent's plan was to transplant Ivan's brain into his body, an act which would certainly mean the end of the monster's own life. In a moment of selflessness, the malformed Ivan refused to engage in the destruction of another beings life and he betrayed his master, Vincent Frankenstein. Angry, Vincent shot Ivan and fled from the cellar. Soon after Vincent would perish, but not by the Monster's hand, instead he would be slain by his servant Betty, who was angry with Vincent for failing to heal his sickened wife, Lenore, who Betty held a great affection for.

The Monster left the London Estate, little realizing that Vincent was not the last of the Frankenstein bloodline as he had been led to believe. Moments before her death, would Lenore Frankenstein gave birth to a son, Basil. With no true direction remaining in his life, The Monster returned to Switzerland. There he found himself in an encounter with a pack of wild dogs who drove the creature over the edge of



battle, Vincent Frankenstein, the grandson of Victor's brother Ernst, entered the cavern with his giant hunchbacked assistant, Ivan. Recognizing Vincent as the last surviving Frankenstein, The Monster attacked him, and likely would have



a cliff where he fell into frigid waters below. Once again, The Monster fell into the throes of suspended animation where he would remain for several decades.

### **“Frank”**

During the 1960's, a being strongly resembling Frankenstein appeared as a member of the First Line. His appearance, powers and demeanor all suggest he had some sort of connection to Frankenstein's Monster. Frank's ultimate fate has yet to be revealed.

### **1974**

Being discovered by a steam freighter several decades later, the monster would thaw out, but for some reason he did not immediately revive. He was taken to a freak show and placed on display. There he was discovered by a man named Derek McDowell, who became obsessed with owning the Frankenstein Monster. Derek was so enthralled with the ideal of owning the Frankenstein Monster that his girlfriend, who thought the creature was a cheap carnival prop, attempted to burn him. The woman burned herself badly, and the flames caused the Frankenstein Monster to awaken. Frankenstein's Monster went on a rampage about the carnival and the military was called in. The creature attempted to flee by climbing a Ferris Wheel, where he was shot with a bazooka by the military. He fell to earth and was buried in the rubble of the Ferris Wheel.

Falling unconscious, the creature was transported to the local morgue. There McDowell gained possession of the creature's body and shipped him to Owen Wallach. McDowell discovered he could control the creature with specific currents of electricity. They planned to use the monster to acquire a fresh body to transfer Wallach's brain into because he was dying. However, due to the

Monster's great strength, their plan would fail, and so McDowell transferred Wallach's brain into the creature's body. Waking up and finding himself trapped in the creature's body, Wallach killed McDowell and vowed to transfer the creature's mind back into his body and to locate himself a more suitable vessel. Wallach was discovered by his nurse, whom he had to murder to eliminate witnesses.

Afterwards, he carried McDowell's corpse to the river and tossed it in. Wallach then traveled to a circus, where he discovered young trapeze artist named James, whose body he planned to abduct for his own use. The Monster's sudden appearance stunned James' girlfriend Gretchen who fell to her death. Wallach then knocked James unconscious and carried him to his hidden laboratory. Wallach prepared James' body for the transferral. He paused for a moment and shattered a mouse habitat just to watch the rodents suffer. Wallach then began the transplant, however, unbeknownst to him, one tiny mouse was crawling through James' body. Once the transplant was completed, Wallach found himself in the body of a mouse and the Monster Of Frankenstein was being controlled by an animal.

Psycho James Sinoda (The Master), was secretly monitoring Wallach's lab, as he needed the Monster's brain reinstated to his body, The Master decided to manipulate events: by using Voodoo magic, Sinoda resurrected McDowell, who climbed from the river as a zombie. Believing he had been resurrected to gain his revenge on Wallach, McDowell navigated his way to Wallach's laboratory. Once there, McDowell planned to extract Wallach's brain and isolate it from any stimuli. McDowell discovered Wallach's mind transferal equipment and he transferred his mind into the nearby body of James, abandoning his own rotten form. Using

Jame's body, McDowell tracked down the Monster and captured him. Then he returned the creature's brain into his body, mistakenly believing it to be Wallach's brain. The Frankenstein Monster awoke and slew McDowell. With James' mind trapped within the rotten form of McDowell and the creature mute due to the fire, James begins to explain his back story and what has happened during The Monster's absence. As James' story comes to a close, The Master controls McDowell's body and murders James and then captures the creature. The Monster had begun to feel a kinship with James before The Master killed him.

The Master offered The Frankenstein Monster the chance to join him, but the creature refused and attacked, so Sinoda had his minions restrain the creature and chained him away in his dungeon. Sinoda decided to continue with his plans without the creature's aid, instead he sent his freaks to accomplish his goals. The freaks kidnapped Julia and chained her in the dungeon next to Frankenstein's Monster.

Psycho James Sinoda began to torture Julia, and in so doing, his mask fell away and the freaks managed to glimpse his hideous face. Aghast at his hideousness, the freaks decided to oppose The Master, enraged, Sinoda turned his weapons upon his freaks. Sinoda killed his freak butler Bruno, the other freaks were outraged and attacked him in kind. The Frankenstein Monster burst his chains in such a violent display of strength that it caused the dungeon wall to collapse, burying Sinoda and his freaks. The Monster lifted Julia's unconscious form and fled the dungeon. Outside however, he was confronted by a police force who believed him to be the freak that had kidnapped Julia to begin with. Fearing the police would accidentally kill the girl, The Monster fled with her into the surrounding forests. Later, Julia would



awaken and she fled from the creature's grasp. Later on, The Monster would steal aboard a train where he would encounter a young girl who had no fear of him at all. The pair were drawn into an assassination plot against the President of the United States. As they attempted to foil the attempt, they would come to the realization that the President was not even aboard the train. The Monster took his leave from the train which subsequently exploded and his friend was lost in the inferno. Later, The Monster would appear at a costume party where he would become interested in a woman dressed as a princess. Unfortunately later that night, the woman's husband murdered her and he framed the creature for the crime. Angered, The Monster slew the man as vengeance and escaped into the night, saddened at the lost of two women who did not fear him.

### Legion Of The Unliving

At some point, The Monster was temporarily pulled out of time to serve as a member of Kang the Conqueror's Legion of the Unliving to fight the Avengers. However, because the monster's body was not dead but the corpses he was composed of were, he was able to refute Kang's mind control allowing him to wander off on his own accord. The creature encountered Dr. Donald Blake and attacked him, forcing the good doctor to transform into the Mighty Thor, Norse God of Thunder. The two battled, Thor realized that the creature was also a prisoner out of time and decided to end the battle by allowing the creature to wander off. The Monster would later discover the badly damaged body of The Vision, which he would carry to the Human Torch. The Monster then

proceeded to protect the fallen avenger from attacks by both Wonder Man and Kang, until Kang was forced to return the legion to their correct times. Which in the Monster's case, was before he was frozen for the second time.

### Brotherhood Of Baal

The Monster headed to Los Angeles, he



had heard rumors of the Brotherhood of Baal's experiments in soul transference. He wanted the brotherhood to transfer his soul into a new body, and the brotherhood readily agreed, but first they prepared for the ritual sacrifice which just happened to involve Lissa Russell as the victim. However, Lissa's brother Jack Russell interrupted the ceremony as The Werewolf By Night.

Frankenstein's Monster did battle with the werewolf, and rendered him unconscious. The cultists decided to sacrifice the werewolf instead of Lissa. As the leader of the Brotherhood of Baal prepared to sacrifice the werewolf, the monster came to realize that the ritual was actually designed to allow Satan to inhabit his body. The Monster grew angry and engaged the cultists in battle, the werewolf burst free of his bonds and together, he and the monster defeated the cultists. Later, Lissa would follow the foot prints of the Frankenstein Monster and the werewolf along the beach.

### Adam

The Monster later befriended Ulysses Bloodstone and resided at Bloodstone Manor as a caretaker calling himself Adam. After Ulysses' death, the Monster of Frankenstein delivered the bloodstone choker to his daughter Elsa Bloodstone. The creature joined Elsa on many of her adventures as they fought against the creatures of the night, such as Dracula and The Living Mummy.

### Fearsome Four

During the Serpent's War, the Monster of Frankenstein formed a team with She-Hulk, Howard the Duck, and Nighthawk to stop the Man-Thing, who found himself driven to an uncontrollable rage which was caused by large amounts of fear induced by the Serpent's hammer wielding champions. After facing various alternate universe heroes and the Psycho Man, the four finally managed to confront their own fears and calm the Man-Thing, bringing an end to his rampage and saving the world, before going their own ways.



### Murder Circus

Frankenstein's Monster appeared leading the Murder Circus in his search for further living descendants of the Frankenstein bloodline.

### All New Howling Commandos

Frankenstein's Monster was later recruited by Phil Coulson to join his incarnation of the Howling Commandos. The team was tasked with fighting Dormammu's Mindless Plague.





# THE FRANKENSTEIN BLOODLINE

## History:

The tormented and seemingly cursed family bloodline extends all the way back to the 1st century A.D. The Frankenstein bloodline originated from the Franks, a barbaric Germanic tribe that inhabited the region that is now known as Bavaria. After the fall of the Roman Empire, the Franks living in the Francia region relocated and established a strong community south of the Rhine. An immense fortress was built in the mountains that became known as the Rock of the Franks. Known also as Frankenstein, the fortress was commanded by a powerful warrior known as Arbogast, the earliest known progenitor of the Frankenstein family line. Arbogast Frankenstein earned a reputation as a savage fighter by challenging and defeating knights on the castle grounds. This fortress was but the first of many structures that would bear the name of Castle Frankenstein over the centuries.

In 1440, a knight of the Teutonic Order named Frank Von Frankenstein traveled across eastern Europe as a violent missionary converting heathens to Catholicism. His crusade brought him into conflict with the Wallachian voivode, Vlad Tepes. Vlad's forces were greater than Frankenstein's, and he had Frank's body impaled on the grounds of his castle. Ironically, some four hundred years later, Vlad Tepes (who would later become more infamously known as Count Dracula) would meet an untimely end at the hands of the Von Frankenstein family's most notorious legacy, The Frankenstein Monster.

The Frankenstein family had also been tied to the legend of St. George and the Dragon. In 1531, Hans Von Frankenstein and his older brother Georg encountered a creature known as Shceuslischer Lindwurm. This dragon like entity rose from a well in the mountains of the Katzenborn, and

attacked the neighboring villages. Hans Von Frankenstein believed that the monster could be placated through human sacrifice. After drawing lots, Hans offered up a peasant girl known as Anna Marie as an unwilling sacrifice to the dragon. Georg, who had been off fighting a war, returned home and slew the dragon with his sword but he was incapable of saving the life of Anna Marie. As the years passed by, Hans found history repeating itself, as another dragon like monster arose from the Katzenborn. Aided by puritan warrior Solomon Kane, Hans Von Frankenstein sought to stop the monster, but it was Kane who delivered the fatal blow which saved the village. Like before, another innocent victim, this time a woman named Cathryn, was needlessly sacrificed before the lindwurm could be destroyed. Madness and regret soon overwhelmed Hans, and rumors began to circulate of a curse upon the Frankenstein bloodline. By 1662, the Von Frankensteins left the region and the castle was sold.

In 1683, Johann Karl Frankenstein became a bishop of the ecclesiastical principality of Worms, Germany. He would pass away in 1691. His exact relationship to the Von Frankenstein family remains unknown.

In 1673, Lutheran minister, Johann Dippel and his wife Anna Munchmeyer, fled from France during the reign of King Louis XIVV. They gave birth to a son named Johann Konrad on Bergstrabe near Darmstadt. Dippel studied theology, philosophy and alchemy at the University of Democritus, most of which is still preserved to this very day. Dippel's true calling however, was in the pseudo-science of alchemy, and he became obsessed with learning the secrets of immortality. In the year 1732, Dippel developed a meager version of the legendary Philosopher's Stone which he dubbed Arcanum Chymicum. He sold it to the landgrave of Hess in

exchange for the title to Castle Frankenstein. Dippel became known as Baron Von Frankenstein. In 1734, family members found Dippel dead in one of his many castle dungeons. The cause of death was unknown, but it appeared as if Dippel had taken his own life after consuming a vial of poison. Feeling a resurgence of the "Frankenstein Family Curse" Dippel's five brothers and sisters took Konrad's infant son, Alphonse, and fled Darmstadt for Switzerland. They established a new branch of the Frankenstein family line in the city of Geneva.

By 1770, Alphonse Frankenstein was a wealthy missionary and bourgeois who had taken a wife named Caroline Beaufort. While on holiday in Naples, Italy, Caroline gave birth to the first of three sons, Victor Von Frankenstein. Alphonse's other children were named Ernst and William. In 1775, the Frankensteins discovered an orphaned girl named Elizabeth Lavenza living in squalor in the Italian village of Como in Milan. They took her in and raised her alongside Victor as his adopted sister.

Victor Von Frankenstein left for the University of Ingolstadt in 1788 where he studied natural science under the tutelage of the venerated Professor Waldman. Like his grandfather, Konrad Dippel, young Victor sought to unlock the secrets of life itself. In 1792, Victor managed to construct a human body using the limbs and organs of corpses which he had attained through acts of burial theft. By means of an unknown chemical process, he animated the body and succeeded in creating a creature that would henceforth become known as the Frankenstein Monster. The Frankenstein Monster loathed it's unholy existence and swore vengeance against the entire Frankenstein bloodline for his misery. The Monster trailed Victor back to Geneva where he callously murdered Victor's youngest brother William. A short time later the





monster murdered Victor's beloved Elizabeth. Before long, Alphonse Frankenstein would perish due to a broken heart, and Victor himself would follow soon thereafter when he perished from pneumonia while trying to pursue his creation to the ends of the Earth in a vain attempt to destroy the creature. Ernst Frankenstein, the last of the Von Frankenstein bloodline, survived and he went on to father a new line of Von Frankensteins.

Regardless, the Frankenstein Monster appeared in Westchester county to murder him for his relation to the Von Frankenstein bloodline. The Monster revealed to Maximillian that he had killed the entire Frankenstein family: William, Elizabeth, Victor, Wolfgang, Grigor the Butcher of Slovaki, Bianca Frankenstein and "Little Gustav".

According to the Frankenstein Monster, which appears to be true from looking at his family's reputation and their behavior, the Frankenstein family

carries in them the seeds of evil and many of them focus on dead reanimation and unnecessary insane surgeries.

Tired of being regarded as a monster and having to wander the world alone, the creature hid himself aboard a train car in a train yard in New York City that was bound for Los Angeles, he hoped that the Brotherhood Of Baal would help him. However, before his arrival in Malibu, the creature was discovered aboard the train and to escape persecution, he burst through the side of the train car, which was overlooking a cliff side along the Pacific Ocean.

Members of the Brotherhood Of Baal discovered the creature roaming the beaches and the creature followed them to Danton Vayla's mansion. 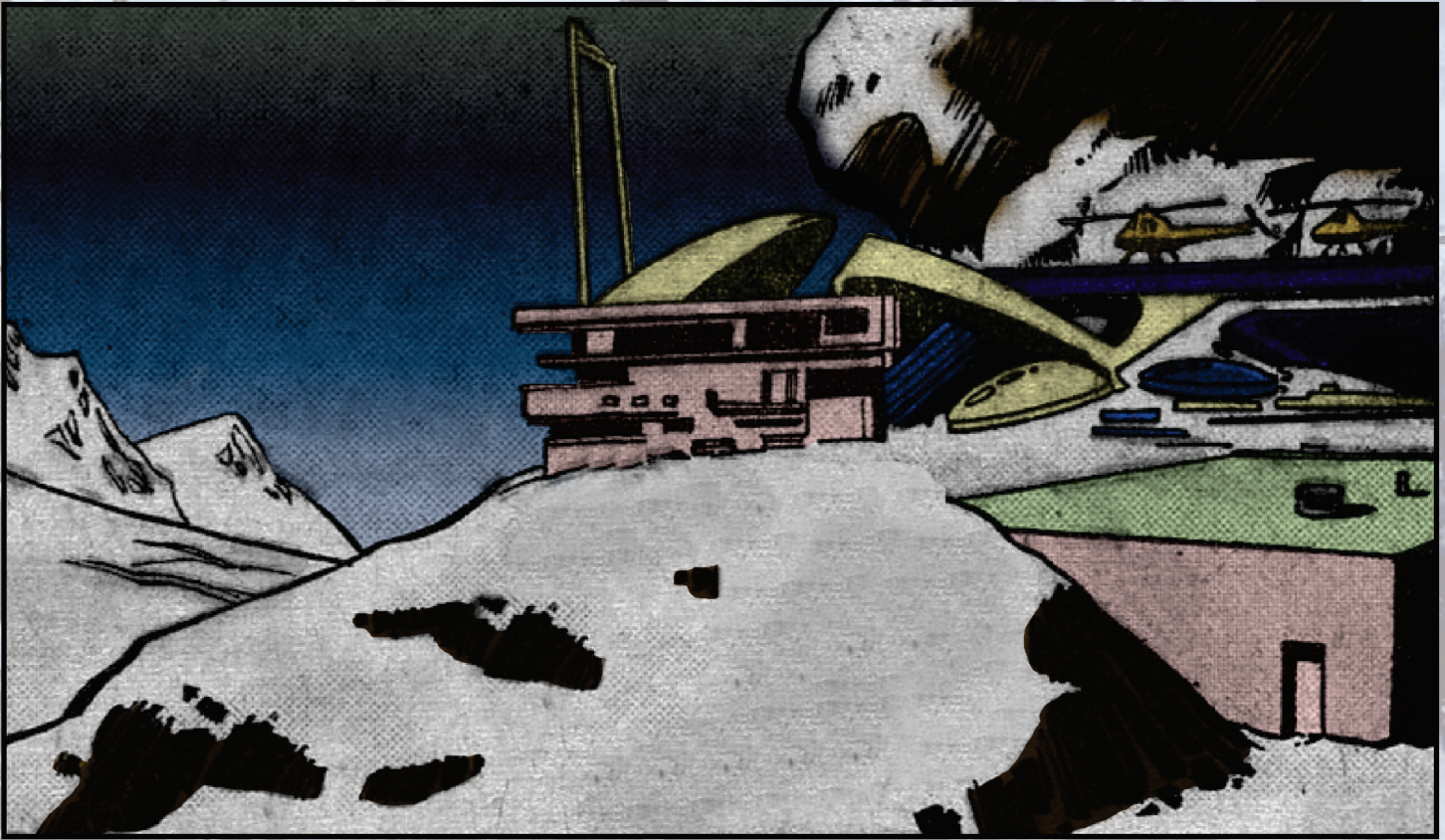

### Background:

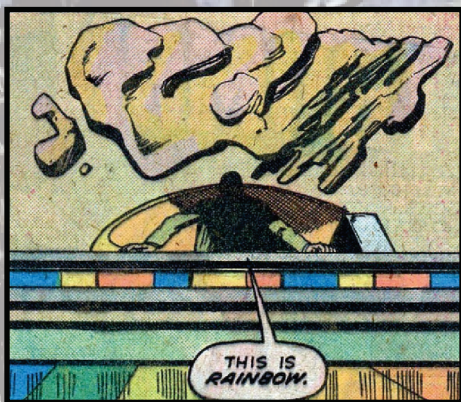

As they prepared to open the Frankenstein Monster's skull, Prawn busted in through the skylight in a commando style raid, at the same time, the Jigsaw Monster appeared, having tracked the Frankenstein Monster down by his scent. The Jigsaw Monster and the creature engaged in a horrific battle, the

Frankenstein Monster lifted his opponent overhead and hurled him into the gas lines, causing the entire warehouse to burst into flames. The Frankenstein Monster, Prawn, Ralph Caccone and Cardinal were the only beings to escape the fire alive. Prawn transported Ralph and the Frankenstein Monster to Castle Frankenstein to meet with Veronica Von Frankenstein, who performed surgery on the creature, restoring his voice which had been long ago lost in battle against Dracula, Lord of the Vampires. Cardinal met up with Agent Indigo, another I.C.O.N. agent. They traveled to Veronica's chalet and ordered an army of living dead super soldiers to assault the place in order to recapture the Frankenstein Monster. While Veronica hastily performed the surgery, Prawn and Ralph held off the living dead army. Cardinal ordered in the Berserker Android which quickly overpowered the two defenders. Veronica managed to complete the



surgery and the Frankenstein Monster managed to awaken in time to disable the Berserker Android. Cardinal contacted I.C.O.N.'s leader, Rainbow, who issued new orders. Cardinal contacted Werner Schmidt, an I.C.O.N. agent who was undercover inside Veronica Von Frankenstein's chalet and gave him instructions on how to reactivate the Berserker Android. The android set out after the Frankenstein Monster who had wandered out into the snow covered mountains. Ralph and Prawn realized that Schmidt had betrayed them, and as Schmidt fled to the I.C.O.N. helicopter, Ralph blew it out of the sky with a rocket launcher he had commandeered from a undead super soldier. How many other I.C.O.N. agents exist throughout the world is unknown, but their leader Rainbow remains at large.

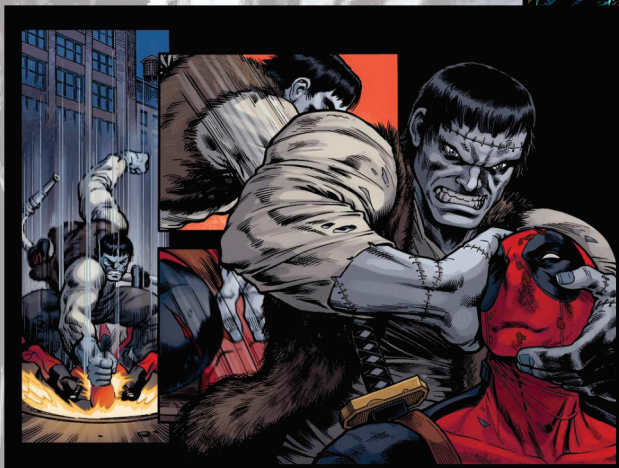




## Murder Circus
