

1001 Predatory Pirates

Th' players filter in fer th' game. They be all wearin' some form o' pirate costume, rangin' from a puffy shirt 'n a bandana wit' their usual jeans t' somethin' fancy from th' local costume rental shop. One player's shoulder bears a fake parrot, which periodically squawks "Pieces of eight! Pieces of eight! Pieces of 7! Awk! Parroty error!" from a hidden iPod 'til th' other players threaten t' keelhaul its owner. Th' GM be th' last, 'n looks around at th' group in thar varied piratical regalia.

GM: Aaaaargh! It be Talk Like a Pirate Day!

Party Leader: Aye, Cap'n. An' ye can see that we be dressed fer it!

GM: Ye realize this won't help ye? I've a lot planned fer tonight.

Party Leader: Ye'd be goin' against yer crew!

GM: Only if I don't share th' plunder!

'Tis a collection o' 1001 descriptions o' pirates. Th' details be more cinematic 'n legendary than real, nah least 'cause real pirates were actually nah anyone ye would wants t' meet. These could be captains, hands, or even retired pirates t' add a wee color t' a game.

While 'tis a somewhat whimsical list fer Talk Like a Pirate Day, it be quite useful in a game. Mayhap ye wants t' make th' pirates somewhat less fancy, especially in th' names (historical pirates mostly jus' used thar real names), 'n perhaps make some o' them non-humans. A crew o' orcish pirates would be somethin' t' fear! In SF games, they fit right in if th' spacegoin' pirates be deliberately modelin' thar appearance on pirates from in ole movies. Th' less modern-realistic th' settin', th' better these pirate descriptions will do.

T' use this list, ye can either start at th' top o' th' list 'n use them in order, roll three different colors o' d10 (treatin' 10 as 0), or jus' pick somethin' that strikes yer freebootin' fancy.

So spice up yer game a bit, 'n 'ave fun!

1001 Predatory Pirates

1: Matthew the Salty (Matthew Every) of the ship Black Witch wears orange trousers, a loose purple shirt, and a tricorn hat. He carries a parrot on his shoulder and likes gaudy jewelry.

2: Blue Thomas (Thomas Harris) of the ship Devil's Revenge wears short white trousers, no shirt, and a purple bandana. He carries a parrot on his shoulder and has a neatly trimmed brown beard. He is something of a coward.

3: Blue Simon (Simon Nichols) of the ship Salty Kraken wears green and purple striped trousers, a ruffled purple shirt, and a white bandana. He wears an eyepatch and carries a brace of pistols.

4: Black Edward (Edward Turner) of the ship Devil's Wraith wears brown trousers, a loose blue shirt under a brown jacket, and a purple bandana. He has long black hair and has a peg leg.

5: Cursed Burgess (Stede Burgess) of the ship Princess Margaret's Fancy wears white trousers, no shirt, and a orange bandana. He carries a brace of pistols and has a peg leg.

6: Black David (David Farley) of the ship Blue Witch wears short black trousers, a ruffled brown shirt, and no hat. He likes gaudy jewelry and has a peg leg.

7: One-Eye Roger (Roger Winter) of the ship Proud Revenge wears white trousers, a loose red shirt, and no hat. He wears high-topped boots and has a flowing brown beard.

8: Red Jacques (Jacques Vane) of the ship Night's Doom wears purple trousers, a loose blue shirt under a yellow and white striped jacket, and a tricorn hat. He carries a brace of pistols and has a flowing black beard. He is unusually brave.

9: Adam Condon of the ship Devil's Kraken wears flared red trousers, no shirt, and a tricorn hat. He likes gaudy jewelry and wears an eyepatch. He is unusually trustworthy.

10: Henry the Salty (Henry May) of the ship Proud Revenge wears purple trousers, a close-fitting blue shirt under a blue jacket, and no hat. He likes gaudy jewelry and carries a brace of pistols. He is exceptionally sloppy.

11: Black Robert (Robert Tew) of the ship Black Kraken wears orange trousers, a ruffled brown shirt under a black jacket, and a white bandana. He wears high-topped boots and carries a parrot on his shoulder. He is exceptionally trustworthy.

12: Cap'n Jacques (Jacques Every) of the ship Princess Elizabeth's Doom wears red trousers, a loose green shirt, and a green bandana. He carries a parrot on his shoulder and wears high-topped boots.

13: Barnaby the Mad (Barnaby Goffe) of the ship Red Pearl wears black-and-white striped trousers, a close-fitting yellow shirt under an orange jacket, and no hat. He has a peg leg and has a red sash around his waist. He is inordinately deceitful.

14: Black Martin (Martin Coates) of the ship Bloody Fortune wears blue and black striped trousers, a ruffled green shirt under a brown jacket, and no hat. He wears an eyepatch and has a flowing blond beard.

15: Cursed Michael (Michael Wright) of the ship Bloody Revenge wears short white trousers, a ruffled yellow shirt, and no hat. He wears high-topped boots and carries a parrot on his shoulder. He is inordinately cruel.

16: Scurvy Alexander (Alexander Skyrme) of the ship Salty Wench wears blue trousers, a ruffled white shirt, and a blue bandana. He wears an eyepatch and has a long, untidy black beard.

17: Mad-Eye Michael (Michael Raynor) of the ship Queen Grace's Hunter wears short brown trousers, a ruffled red and green striped shirt under a black jacket, and a yellow bandana. He has a hook for a hand and has a peg leg. He is somewhat brave.

18: Bloody David (David Harris) of the ship Butcher wears flared black trousers, a ruffled yellow shirt under a white jacket, and a orange bandana. He has a peg leg and wears an eyepatch.

19: "Duke" Brown (Ralph Brown) of the ship Ghostly Wench wears red and purple striped trousers, a ruffled green shirt, and a black bandana. He has a hook for a hand and has a peg leg.

20: Mathias the Bloody (Mathias Blackburne) of the ship Devil's Kraken wears blue trousers, a loose orange and white striped shirt under a blue jacket, and a orange and yellow patterned bandana. He likes gaudy jewelry and has a hook for a hand. He is a fop.

21: Salty Coates (Gregory Coates) of the ship Princess Anne's Jewel wears white trousers, a close-fitting yellow shirt, and a black bandana. He has a peg leg and likes gaudy jewelry.

22: Wicked Lawrence (Lawrence Rackham) of the ship Lady Margaret's Fortune wears brown trousers, a ruffled purple shirt, and a orange bandana. He carries a brace of pistols and carries a parrot on his shoulder. He is a slob.

23: Adam the Vulture (Adam Critchett) of the ship Salty Witch wears orange trousers, a ruffled purple and green striped shirt under a purple jacket, and a tricorn hat. He has a purple sash around his waist and has a neatly trimmed black beard.

24: Cap'n Nathaniel (Nathaniel Shipton) of the ship Ghostly Fancy wears brown trousers, a loose black shirt under a red jacket, and a orange bandana. He carries a brace of pistols and has a peg leg. He is exceptionally cowardly.

25: Charles the Salty (Charles Roche) of the ship Wench wears brown trousers, a ruffled yellow and blue striped shirt under an orange jacket, and a green bandana. He carries a parrot on his shoulder and has a yellow sash around his waist. He is a martinet.

26: "Duchess" Every (Anne Every) of the ship Bloody Revenge wears brown trousers, a ruffled black shirt under a red jacket, and a brown bandana. She wears high-topped boots and has long black hair.

27: White Stede (Stede Brown) of the ship Salty Pearl wears black trousers, a ruffled white shirt, and a tricorn hat. He has a peg leg and wears an eyepatch.

28: Wicked Stilwell (Adam Stilwell) of the ship Black Hunter wears red and purple striped trousers, a close-fitting blue shirt under a white jacket, and a blue bandana. He has a hook for a hand and has a orange sash around his waist. He is notably deceitful.

29: Adam Contend of the ship Death's Hunter wears orange trousers, a loose blue shirt under a white jacket, and a tricorn hat. He has a peg leg and wears high-topped boots.

30: Edward Brown of the ship Proud Kraken wears white trousers, a loose purple shirt under a brown jacket, and a purple bandana. He wears an eyepatch and wears high-topped boots.

31: Red Henry (Henry Thatch) of the ship Captain Samuel's Jewel wears flared white trousers, a loose black shirt, and a tricorn hat. He carries a parrot on his shoulder and likes gold chains.

32: Ironfist Stephen (Stephen Griffin) of the ship Butcher wears red trousers, a ruffled orange shirt, and a purple bandana. He wears an eyepatch and has a hook for a hand.

33: Stephen the Wicked (Stephen Kelly) of the ship Scarlet Doom wears white trousers, a loose red shirt, and a tricorn hat. He wears an eyepatch and likes gaudy jewelry. He is exceptionally brave.

34: Edmund Spriggs of the ship Witch wears short white trousers, a close-fitting blue shirt, and a blue bandana. He has a hook for a hand and carries a brace of pistols.

35: Bloody Levasseur (Bartholomew Levasseur) of the ship Ghostly Doom wears brown trousers, a ruffled red shirt under a red jacket, and a tricorn hat. He has a black sash around his waist and has a long, untidy black beard. He is unusually unlucky.

36: Bloody West (Francis West) of the ship Captain Christopher's Hunter wears purple trousers, no shirt, and a white bandana. He carries a brace of pistols and likes gaudy jewelry. He is somewhat chivalrous.

37: Gregory Bonnet of the ship Death's Fancy wears flared white trousers, a ruffled green shirt, and a blue bandana. He has a peg leg and has a hook for a hand. He is somewhat cruel.

38: Wicked Ralph (Ralph Wheeler) of the ship Butcher wears brown trousers, a close-fitting orange shirt, and a orange and purple patterned bandana. He has a hook for a hand and wears an eyepatch. He is notably brave.

39: Nicholas the Bloody (Nicholas Wheeler) of the ship Black Fortune wears flared purple trousers, a ruffled red shirt under a black jacket, and a tricorn hat. He carries a brace of pistols and has a hook for a hand. He is exceptionally honest.

40: Wicked Nicholas (Nicholas Thompson) of the ship Scarlet Wench wears green trousers, a ruffled black shirt, and no hat. He has a hook for a hand and wears high-topped boots.

41: Salty Wood (Sybil Wood) of the ship Princess Emma's Fortune wears white trousers, a loose black shirt under an orange and blue striped jacket, and a orange bandana. She has a peg leg and likes gaudy jewelry.

42: John West of the ship Death's Fancy wears red trousers, a loose red shirt, and a tricorn hat. He has a brown sash around his waist and carries a parrot on his shoulder.

43: Fulke the Butcher (Fulke Evans) of the ship Wicked Butcher wears flared red trousers, no shirt, and a purple bandana. He has a yellow sash around his waist and has a long, untidy blond beard. He is inordinately lucky.

44: Trickster Lewis (Lewis Kelly) of the ship Proud Wench wears flared green trousers, a loose red and black striped shirt under a black-and-white striped jacket, and a tricorn hat. He has long brown hair and carries a parrot on his shoulder. He is notably deceitful.

45: "King" Simon (Simon Collier) of the ship Black Pearl wears short yellow trousers, no shirt, and a tricorn hat. He has a purple sash around his waist and has a hook for a hand.

46: Nicholas the Bloody (Nicholas Howard) of the ship Bloody Butcher wears flared red trousers, a loose blue shirt under a green jacket, and a orange bandana. He has long brown hair and has a hook for a hand.

47: Wicked Lionel (Lionel May) of the ship Night's Revenge wears white trousers, a loose black shirt, and a tricorn hat. He likes gaudy jewelry and wears high-topped boots.

48: Salty Nicholas (Nicholas Morris) of the ship Black Butcher wears brown trousers, a ruffled red shirt under a brown jacket, and a tricorn hat. He has a peg leg and has a brown sash around his waist.

49: Blue Thatch (Bartholomew Thatch) of the ship Devil's Hunter wears yellow trousers, a ruffled orange shirt under a green jacket, and a green bandana. He has a black sash around his waist and carries a parrot on his shoulder.

50: Lionel the Wicked (Lionel Bobbington) of the ship Red Luck wears flared orange trousers, a ruffled green shirt, and no hat. He likes gaudy jewelry and wears an eyepatch.

51: Hugh Coates of the ship Princess Avis's Ghost wears green trousers, a loose yellow shirt, and no hat. He carries a brace of pistols and carries a parrot on his shoulder.

52: Gentleman Charles (Charles Anstis) of the ship Night's Fancy wears flared red trousers, no shirt, and no hat. He has a hook for a hand and wears high-topped boots. He is unusually brave.

53: Lazy O'Malley (William O'Malley) of the ship Proud Fortune wears black trousers, no shirt, and no hat. He has a peg leg and carries a brace of pistols.

54: Hugh Hoar of the ship Bloody Hunter wears blue trousers, a ruffled yellow shirt, and a tricorn hat. He has a peg leg and wears high-topped boots.

55: "Duke" Nathaniel (Nathaniel Glover) of the ship Devil's Fancy wears flared blue trousers, a loose black-andwhite striped shirt under a yellow jacket, and a tricorn hat. He carries a parrot on his shoulder and has a red sash around his waist. He is a slob.

56: Lionel Lane of the ship Red Doom wears green trousers, a ruffled black shirt, and a white bandana. He has long red hair and wears an eyepatch. He is reputed to be a slob.

57: Hezekiah the Salty (Hezekiah Wright) of the ship Queen Sybil's Ghost wears black trousers, a loose orange and purple striped shirt, and a tricorn hat. He has long brown hair and has a peg leg. He is unusually lucky.

58: Mad Griffin (Adam Griffin) of the ship Queen Joan's Ghost wears orange trousers, a loose green shirt under a green jacket, and no hat. He has a flowing blond beard and has a hook for a hand.

80: Butcher John (John Rackham) of the ship Night's Revenge wears green trousers, a loose brown shirt under a yellow jacket, and a red bandana. He likes gold chains and has a long, untidy blond beard.

81: Samuel Knight of the ship Death's Fortune wears black-and-white striped trousers, a ruffled red shirt, and a tricorn hat. He has long brown hair and wears an eyepatch.

82: Robert Inless of the ship Cursed Hunter wears red trousers, a loose yellow shirt under a red jacket, and a purple bandana. He likes gaudy jewelry and has a neatly trimmed black beard.

93: Roger the Limper (Roger Nichols) of the ship Night's Butcher wears green trousers, a ruffled black shirt, and a purple bandana. He has a peg leg and carries a brace of pistols. He is notably lucky.

94: Wild Hugh (Hugh Every) of the ship Salty Butcher wears brown trousers, a ruffled red shirt, and no hat. He has a peg leg and wears an eyepatch.

95: Red Thomas (Thomas Fowler) of the ship Blue Revenge wears short orange trousers, no shirt, and a tricorn hat. He has a hook for a hand and wears high-topped boots.

99: Cornelius Fife of the ship Wicked Wraith wears white trousers, a loose black shirt, and a tricorn hat. He has a blue sash around his waist and wears high-topped boots.

108: Peter the Fool (Peter Hornigold) of the ship Proud Luck wears red trousers, a ruffled red shirt, and no hat. He has a hook for a hand and wears high-topped boots. He is exceptionally sloppy.
