Operation Brevity Italian Forces

May 15, 1941

Rommel left a light force of scattered Italian units to defend the border, with a few mobile German units to back them up. Though these Italians were mostly defeated by the Commonwealth forces, they did put up a stiff resistance in almost every case, delaying the British attack enough to allow reinforcements to be brought up and the operation halted after little more than a day.



Defended Halfaya Pass, mostly at the base of the high ground. Put up a stout defense for most of the day but were finally overrun, losing 130 prisoners.

Also I/61st Regiment was stationed at Bardia with the German II/5 Panzer (see German sheet for this unit).
