

Division is named in honor of the March on Rome, October 28, 1922. This division arrived in Libya in summer of 1940 and was part of the invading force into Egypt in September. The missing artillery and engineers has been loaned out to the Libyan divisions. Division retreated into Libya during Operation Compass in December and was destroyed between Sollum and Halfaya and at Bardia in January of 1941.
