

The Bologna Division was serving in the Axis lines around Tobruk when the Allied offensive began. When the time came for the attempted British breakout from Tobruk, Bologna stood squarely in the path of the combined infantry and tank assault. The division stubbornly held, despite being partly overrun, and bought enough time for Pavia to counterattack and temporarily stabilize the line. Despite heavy casualties in the battle, the division survived to continue the fight in North Africa.
