

The 15th Panzer began the battle as part of armored reserve in the north. When the Allied assault began, the 15th was called forward to counterattack, blunting the Allied advance. In this desperate tank battle, the division lost most of its tanks. When the line was broken by Operation Supercharge, the largely toothless 15th Panzer was forced to retreat. The division lived to fight again and opposed the 8th Army again and again until finally forced back into Tunisia and finally destroyed.
