Though this division was first organized in June of 1941, it did not leave England until June 26 of 1944. The division was then heavily involved in the fighting across France and into Belgium, where the Guards Armored led the advance of XXX Corps in the ground attack portion of Operation Market–Garden. For the Bulge, the Guards were deployed on the Meuse River to guard against a German break-through and were another British division which did not see action in the Bulge but easily could have if the German offensive had been more successful.
