French Colonial Infantry

Consists of 3 infantry regiments of 3 battalions each, 1 artillery regiment, 1 engineer battalion, 1 anti-tank company, and 1 recon battalion.



Notes: France had many overseas colonies and divisions raised from many of these were stationed in France in May, 1940. Types include DIC (colonial infantry), DIA (Africa and Morocco), and DINA (North Africa). I don't know the exact organization of these units, but I presume they would be very close to the standard infantry organization. Troop quality is probably highly variable and could be represented by either type of rifle unit.
