Russian Tank Division



These ten tank divisions were formed in July of 1941 and were built around remnants of previous units. The previous tank division organization had proved to have too many tanks to handle efficiently plus there weren't many tanks left after the first month so these new divisions have fewer tanks than before. Seven of these divisions were destroyed by early October as the German Wehrmacht continued to grind the Russian army into pieces.

101st Tank Division (202 & 203 Tank Rgt, 101 Mot Inf Rgt) - formed from remnants of 52nd Tank Division

102nd Tank Division (204 & 205 Tank Rgt, 102 Mot Inf Rgt) - formed from remnants of 56th Tank Division

104th Tank Division (208 & 209 Tank Rgt, 104 Mot Inf Rgt) - formed from remnants of 9th Tank Division

105th Tank Division (210 & 211 Tank Rgt, 105 Mot Inf Rgt) - formed from remnants of 53rd Tank Division

107th Tank Division (143 Tank Rgt, 107 Mot Inf Rgt) - formed from remnants of 69th Motorized Rifle Division

108th Tank Division (216 & 217 Tank Rgt, 108 Mot Inf Rgt)

109th Tank Division (218 & 219 Tank Rgt, 109 Mot Inf Rgt) - formed from remnants of 9th Tank Division

110th Tank Division (220 & 221 Tank Rgt, 110 Mot Inf Rgt) - formed from remnants of 51st Tank Division

111th Tank Division (222 & 223 Tank Rgt, 111 Mot Inf Rgt) - formed from remnants of 82nd Mech Rifle Division

112th Tank Division (124 & 125 Tank Rgt, 112 Mot Inf Rgt)
