

The 14th Motorized Division was assigned to Army Group Central where it was heavily engaged. At the end of 1942, the division was to be upgraded to a panzergrenadier division, however, the decision was changed completely and the 14th instead lost all its motor transport and became just a regular foot infantry division again. The 14th Infantry Division continued to fight on the Russian Front until early 1945, when it was destroyed by the Russian Army near the border of Poland.
