NEW COUNTERS FOR 1942



The Germans manufactured about 1500 of a 100mm Gun (not howitzer) during the war. These heavy long-barreled pieces were mounted on the same carriage as the 150mm howitzer and appeared in limited quantities in artillery regiments in the early to middle years of the war. They gave the artillery a longer ranged gun for when they needed it. These heavy guns proved difficult to transport and were mostly relegated to coastal duty by the end of the war. These are presented in two versions, one for PanzerBlitz and one for Panzer Leader.



In 1942 and 1943, the Germans frequently found themselves short-handed on tanks. One quick solution was to use captured Russian tanks to fill in (at least temporarily). These two versions of the Russian T-34 are presented in gray for use by the Germans.



This is another version of the Russian SMG company, mostly for use in early war settings. I present this for players to use or ignore as they wish.
