### Assembling your Deathstalker Scorpion

First, follow the instructions found in the free Pathinder Paper Miniatures instruction PDF, which can be found on Paizo.com.

While gluing the base, make sure not to glue the white tabs on the top and back of the base together; these tabs are used to hold the carapace. Once the base's glue has set, fold the tabs away from each other.

Score the carapace along the red line, and the line through the middle of the body. Then, cut the thorax along the bottom line, and score the top line so you have a functional tab to glue the two parts together. Hold until set, as per your glue's instructions

Glue the body onto the white tabs on the base. The body may fold a bit; this is normal. Hold until set as above. Once the glue has set, bend and fold the legs into whatever positions you desire.

Congratulations! You now have a giant trapdoor spider to munch on your players!
