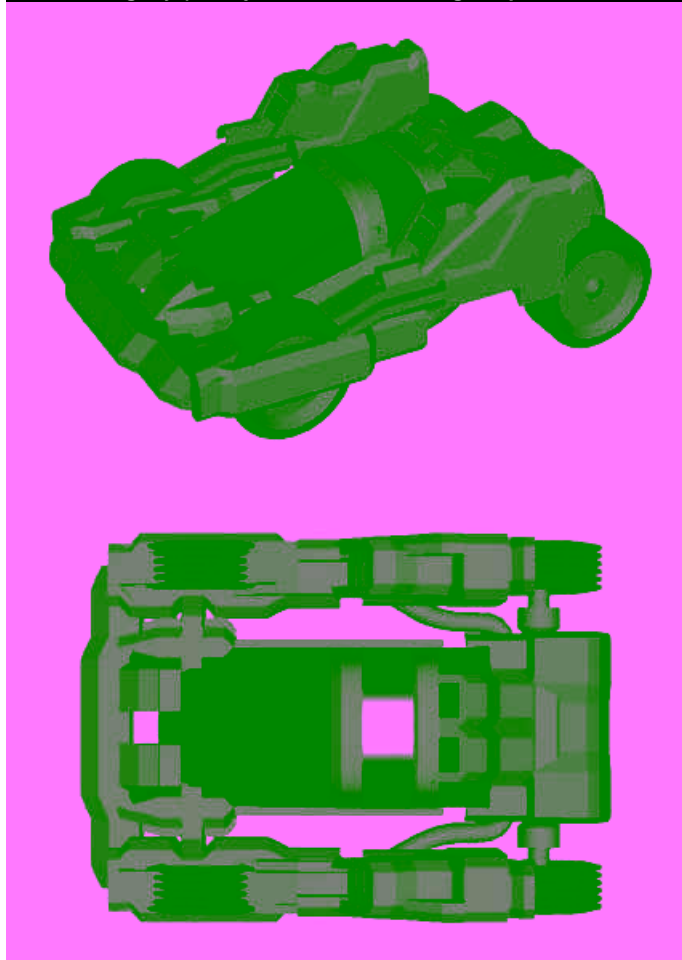


Lone Eagle Prototype Racer
