

# ROMULAN RANK INSIGNIA



Magna-Admirals are the equal of Federation five-star grand admirals and command an entire theater of war.



Pente-Admirals are the equal of Federation four-star fleet admirals and command fleets of 20-50 ships.



Major-Admirals are the equal of Federation three-star vice admirals and command a wing of 12-25 ships.



Ante-Admirals are the equal of Federation two-star rear admirals and command a division of 6-10 ships.



Pente-Commanders are senior commodores who will never be promoted to admiral; they are often staff specialists.



Major-Commanders are squadron leaders and command groups of three or four warships in combat.



Ante-Commanders (also known as Sub-Commanders) captain cruisers or other large ships in combat.



Proto-Commanders are the captains of destroyers and lesser starships, or students at Imperial Command School.



Pente-Tribunes are equal to Star Fleet captains, but are usually staff officers not in the chain of command.



Major-Tribunes are the equal of Star Fleet commanders and head major departments on a starship.



Ante-Tribunes are the equal of Star Fleet lieutenant commanders, and supervise minor departments on a ship.



Proto-Tribunes are students at the senior leadership and staff schools, so that all students are equal.




Pente-Centurions have little hope of promotion to tribune, but are often deputy department heads.



Major-Centurions are the equal of Star Fleet senior lieutenants and continue to be in charge of duty sections.



Ante-Centurions are the equal of Star Fleet junior lieutenants and have authority over a duty section.



Proto-Centurions are officer candidates serving up to two years with minimal status in an active military unit.



Ultra-Decurions are E9 sergeants-major, the senior enlisted man on a starship or in a cohort of ground troops.



Magna-Decurions are E8 master sergeants, the senior enlisted man in a duty section or century.



Pente-Decurions are E7 senior NCOs who supervise junior sergeants in a duty section.



Major-Decurions are E6 veteran working sergeants in charge of a few enlisted personnel at a duty station.



Ante-Decurions are E5 junior working sergeants on their first assignment in charge of a duty station.




Pente-Soldats are veterans who will never be promoted to leadership positions, but are respected for their skills.



Major-Soldats are veteran soldiers or crewmen who have gained a broad range of skills through their experience.



Ante-Soldats are junior enlisted personnel who have completed basic training but lack much experience.



Proto-Soldats are recruits undergoing basic training, but in wartime some are sent to frontline units for final training.
