INTRODUCTION

The items in this list are primarily aimed at a modern setting, but many of them can be adapted for a historical or fantasy setting, by substituting anything electrical or electronic with mechanical or magical, and any unsuitable materials, such as plastic, with more suitable ones, such as wood, bone or stone. For example, an electric light can be replaced with candles or magical light and a plastic skull could be replaced with a wooden one.

Whilst the various items may simply be used for dressing up a location with Halloween-themed clutter, they can be used for other purposes. The items may seem to be ordinary Halloween decorations - but perhaps they are not. The fake eyeballs may be real, and so could the skulls, the bones and the blood - or anything else for that matter. The pumpkins or other decorations could be possessed by evil spirits. Combined, these could turn a normal Halloween location into something a lot more horrific than it originally appeared.

USING THE LIST

Either select results manually, or roll d100 to get a random choice.

1. **Axe** (Long or short handled plastic axe)

2. **Balloons** (Black and orange balloons, possibly with a helium canister for inflating them)

3. **Bat** (Large paper, inflatable or stuffed black bat)

4. **Bat Garland** (Several black paper bats on a black garland)

5. **Bat Stickers** (Self-adhesive bat stickers)

6. Black Rose (Fake black plastic rose)

7. **Blood** (Container of fake blood, different types with different uses, such as cosmetic, decoration or culinary) 8. **Bloody Draping** (Long rags covered with fake blood that can be draped across things)

9. **Bloody Fingers** (Fake severed fingers with bloody ends)

10. **Bloody Handprints** (Self-adhesive stickers in the shape of bloody handprints)

11. **Bones** (Fake bones, probably made from plastic, may be bloody)

12. **Bottle Labels** (Labels for bottles with such things as "Poison," "Bat's Blood," "Devil's Brew" and "Zombie Juice" on them)

13. **Bowls** (Orange or black bowls in the shape of pumpkins and skulls)

14. **Cakes** (Such as ghost or haunted house in appearance)

15. **Candies** (Or sweets, in Halloween shapes such as eyeballs, spiders, bats, teeth and snakes, or simply normal ones)

16. **Candelabra** (Black, gothic table candelabra with multiple arms and skull decorations, possibly battery-powered, motion detecting and animated)

17. **Candles** (Themed candles such as pumpkins, jack o'lanterns, skulls, haunted houses, zombies and simple black and orange candles, perhaps with dribbles of wax down the sides)

18. **Cape** (Opera cape, as worn by cinematic vampires, in black with a red lining, or a long, black witch's cape)

19. Cat (Life size stuffed witch's cat)

20. **Cat Garland** (Felt black cuts on a garland)

21. **Cauldron** (Black plastic witch's cauldrons in different sizes, some with animated fake liquids inside them)

22. Chain (Plastic chain with large links)

23. **Cookies** (Or biscuits, in Halloween shapes such as bats, pumpkins, spiders, mice and zombie fingers)

24. **Crawling Hand** (Battery-powered severed zombie, or other monster, hand that slowly crawls around on its fingertips) 25. **Creepy Candy Bowl** (A black plastic bowl for candy with a battery-powered motion sensing moving green zombie hand attached to it) themed shapes such as skulls and pumpkins, or in black and yellow, or decorated with such as skulls, jack o'lanterns and bats)

26. **Creepy Cloth** (Tattered and torn black cotton cloth)

27. **Creepy Doll** (Battery-powered small, creepy-looking doll with red eyes that makes sounds and moves)

28. **Crisps** (Or potato chips, in themed shapes such as zombie fingers, bugs and webs, or simply normal ones)

29. **Cupcakes** (Small cakes decorated with pumpkins, spiders, fingers and other creepy items, or using orange, black or blood coloured icing)

30. **Cutlery** (Orange and black plastic cutlery, or in odd shapes such as bones)

31. **Doorbell** (battery-powered, when the button is pressed an eye opens above it)

32. **Door Curtain** (Made from strips of black, shiny foil, perhaps with themed decorations)

33. **Eyeballs** (Fake plastic or rubber eyeballs)

34. **Face Makeup** (Skin makeup in suitable colours including black, orange, green, blood, grey and anything else suitable for horror characters)

35. Fangs (Plastic fake vampire fangs)

36. **Fog Machine** (Mains-powered machine that turns a water based liquid into fog and pumps it out)

37. **Gallows** (Fake gallows, life size or close to it, probably plastic)

38. **Ghost** (Wall mounted decoration, possibly luminous)

39. Glasses (Plastic drinking glasses in

40. **Glow in the Dark** (Small glow in the dark items such as spiders, mice and bats)

41. **Gothic Portraits** (Large wall decal with what appears to be creepy framed portraits on it, of such as odd looking people, perhaps with strange eyes or deformities, and skulls)

42. **Guillotine** (Life sized fake guillotine, probably plastic)

43. **Hanging Bat** (Plastic bats on string that can be suspended from the ceiling or other place)

44. **Hanging Man** (Life size human figure with a noose around its neck for hanging

from the ceiling)

45. **Headband** (Plastic headband with such as knives, axes, arrows, bat ears and devil horns on them)

46. **Jack o'Lantern Lights** (A chain of small lights in the shape of orange jack o'lanterns with an electric light inside each)

47. **Jelly Mould** (And finished jellies, in shapes such as ghosts and brains)

48. **Knife** (Plastic knives, machetes and cleavers of different sizes)

49. **Lawn Spider** (Several foot wide inflatable spider for use outside, perhaps with built-in lights)

50. **LED Figures** (Small, battery-powered spiders, bats and mice, or other appropriate creatures, with LEDs)

51. **Lipstick** (Unusual lipstick shades such as black, orange, grey and green)

52. **Luminous Skeleton** (Wall-mounted flat skeleton that glows green in the dark)

53. **Masks** (From simple solitaire masks to zombie, werewolf, monster, devil, skull, witch and film character masks)

54. **Nail Polish** (Black, green and orange nail polish, or other suitable colours)

55. **Napkins** (Paper or fabric napkins, possibly in black or orange, perhaps with Halloween decorations on)

56. **Paper Chains** (Orange and black paper chains, possibly with decorations on them such as pumpkins and skulls)

57. **Paper Cups** (Disposable cups with Halloween themed images on them, such as spiders, bats and skulls)

58. **Paper Lanterns** (Lantern covers in the shape of a ribcage)

59. **Pile of Skulls** (A decorative pile of, probably plastic, skulls, perhaps with battery-powered lights and sound)

60. Plates (Paper or

plastic plates in black or orange or decorated with jack o'lanterns, skulls, bats and similar)

61. **Pumpkin** (Either real, carved into a Jack o'Lantern, or plastic, with one built in, with either a candle or electric light inside it, such as a real or electric tealight)

62. **Pumpkin Balloons** (Orange balloons with a jack o'lantern face on them in black)

63. **Pumpkin Bucket** (An orange plastic bucket with a handle in the shape of a pumpkin, for collecting candies/sweets)

64. **Pumpkin Garland** (Orange garland with felt pumpkin jack o'lanterns on it)

65. **Pumpkin Light Cover** (Orange jack o'lantern light cover that fastens over a ceiling light)

66. Rat (Fake plastic or furry rat)

67. **Raven** (Or crow, perched on a rock or a skull, battery-powered, flaps its wings and caws)

68. Screaming Doormat (Battery-pow-

ered device to place under a doormat that screams when trodden on)

69. Scythe (Fake plastic scythe)

70. **Sidewalk Signs** (Made from plastic to resemble wooden signs on stakes bearing messages such as "Keep Out!", "Beware!", "Go Back!" and "Danger!", perhaps in paint that looks like blood)

71. **Sign** (Hanging signs, probably made from plastic that looks like wood, with messages such as "Cemetery," "Dead Zone" and "Haunted House" apparently carved into them, possibly decorated with blood)

72. **Skeleton** (Life size articulated skeleton)

> 73. **Skeleton Bowl** (Serving bowl with the top half of a skeletal Death, animated, motion activated and battery powered)

74. Skeleton Dog

(Life size skeletal dog)

75. **Skull** (Fake skull, probably plastic, possibly with an articulated, battery-powered moving jaw, as well as a voice)

76. **Skull Wall Decoration** (Large, flat wall-mounted skull decoration, possibly with battery powered glowing eyes)

77. **Skull Tealights** (Battery powered tealights with a skull surrounding the light)

78. **Solar Lantern** (Solar-powered lantern being held by such as a skeleton or zombie arm)

79. **Sound Machine** (Battery-powered, produces a variety of Halloween sounds, such as groans, creaks, howls, cackles

80. **Spiders** (Fake plastic and rubber spiders of different sizes, usually black)

81. **Spooky Tree** (Inflatable spooky tree with a face for use outside, several feet high)

82. **Stretchable Spiders Web** (Fake spiders web that can be stretched to cover

areas)

83. **Telephone** (Old fashioned black battery-powered telephone with a spooky voice on the end when the receiver is picked up)

84. **Tinsel** (Black, or black and orange, tinsel, with cardboard jack o'lantern decorations)

85. **Toilet Seat Decal** (Decal for sticking onto a toilet seat that has a picture of a zombie head and hands that are pulling it out of the toilet)

85. Tombstones (Fake

tombstones, plastic or polystyrene, with various messages on such as R.I.P.)

87. **Torture Garland** (Bloodstained fake, plastic or cardboard, knives, pincers, saws and other torture implements strung from a garland)

88. **Trident** (Long or short handled plastic devil's trident)

89. **Wigs** (Different types of wigs, such as witch, zombie and vampire)

90. **Wind Up Toys** (Small wind up mechanical toys such as ghosts, skeletons, eyeballs and pumpkins)

91. **Wings** (Costume bat wings, made from fabric)

92. **Window Decoration** (Decal for sticking onto windows, shows such as a zombie, mummy, werewolf or other creature of the night looking out through it)

93. Witch's Broomstick (Traditional wooden handled stick broom, possibly made from plastic)

> 94. **Witch's Fingers** (Plastic fingers with pointed nails, possibly suitable for wearing over normal fingers and may glow in the dark)

95. **Witch's Hat** (Pointy black hat, made of paper or felt)

96. **Wounds** (Fake wounds for attaching to skin)

97. **Zombie Butler** (Life size zombie dressed as a butler, either a cardboard cutout or a figure that animates and interacts, moving and groaning)

98. **Zombie Door Poster** (Door-sized adhesive poster with a picture of a zombie, or other monster such as a werewolf, breaking through the planks of a wooden door on it)

99. **Zombie Ground Breaker** (Zombie head, hands and tombstone for outdoor decoration)

100. **Zombie Limbs** (Fake severed zombie limbs with blood and protruding bone)
