Killer toys are much more than dolls or teddy bears armed with a razor sharp kitchen knife. More than likely they are objects possessed by hate filled entities bent on revenge. Killing and acts of vengeance in themselves are not enough. The possessed entity must feed and grow in power, and that nourishment comes from the anguish, fear, pain and terror it causes others. The longer a killer toy can remain innocuous to its owner while causing mayhem and terror to those around them, the stronger it becomes.

The killer toy derives pleasure not only from inflicting physical pain, but the mental anguish it causes. It loves nothing more than to isolate its victim from their family and friends. By the time the victim becomes aware of the toy's true nature they often have no one to turn to for help. With the modern age, the killer toy has more ways than ever to cause pain in anguish.

Not unlike the big eyed puppy in the dog pound, the toy worms its way into your affections. Without you realising, you discover too late you have a narcissistic psychotic killer toy that has been watching your every move and knows you better than you know yourself.

It has seen your passwords, remembered your past indiscretions and knows all your dirty little secrets. Not everything in the list is specific to killer toys and could be applied to any crazed lunatic or serial killer. The following list explores how a killer might isolate and manipulate an individual in the modern age before revealing its true nature.

1. When unobserved and you have set your phone down, the killer toy sends dirty texts to an inappropriate person such as an ex-partner, your current partners siblings, in-laws or even work colleagues.

9. When unobserved and you have set your phone down, the killer toy changes your alarm time, or reminder so you are late for work or miss an important date or meeting.

10. When unobserved and you have set your phone down, the killer toy puts a sinister ring-tone on your phone.

11. When unobserved and you have set your phone down the killer toy kills one of your friends and uploads the picture of their corpse into their contact photo.

12. When unobserved, and after the corpse of your dead friend has been found, the killer toy phones you on the dead friend's phone.

13. When unobserved, and after the corpse of your dead friend has been found, the killer toy texts your friends from their phone.

14. When unobserved, and after the corpse of your dead friend has been found, the killer toy sends you and your friends text messages of their dying screams.

15. When unobserved and you have set your phone down, the killer toy changes the Ring-tone of your phone to the pleading, dying screams of your friend.

16. When unobserved and you have set your phone down, the killer toy changes your screen saver to a picture of your dead pet (you didn't realise it was dead yet, did you?).

17. When unobserved and you have set your phone down, the killer toy switches your phone off or hides it.

18. When unobserved and you have set your phone down, the killer toy smashed the screen on your phone.

19. The killer toy carries out series of grisly murders. After each murder your pedometer on your phone congratulates you as it registers an unlikely number of steps. When you check your GPS route, you phone appears to have been to each of the murder sites.

20. You receive a text from your partner's phone with something inappropriate or untrue in the message. 'I'm pregnant' or 'That's it, we are finished'. Your partner denies sending the text.

21. You discover the dying screams of a murder victim on your phone. The voice sounds familiar, but you just can't place it.

29. The killer toy starts an online blog detailing what it has been up to, allowing you to discover it just as realisation dawns what you're dealing with and that you are its next victim.

30. When unobserved, and just before you need to be somewhere important, the killer toy lets one of your tires down.

31. The killer toy is in the car, sitting in passenger seat or being nursed by an unsuspecting child. Unexpectedly the toy falls into the foot well of the car, pushing down hard on the accelerator.

36. While out for a drive you are alerted to a noise coming from the boot/trunk of your car. Someone you know has been bound and gagged and placed there by the killer toy.

37. While out for a drive you become aware of an odour emanating from the boot/trunk of your car. The body of someone you know has been place there by the killer toy.

51. The killer toy wants to ruin your life before he kills you. You become aware of your child making unusual noises. To your horror the child appears to be playing with a razor sharp kitchen knife and is smeared with blood.

52. The killer toy is a vandal. If you wear glasses, the killer leaves them where they will be smashed. Perhaps they will simply be left lying on the floor, or be placed in a door jam or balancing precariously on the edge of something.

53. The killer toy is a vandal. If you wear glasses, you find the words 'Die' and 'Scum' scraped into the lenses.

54. The killer toy is a vandal. He tears out pages from a book you have been reading or some important report you have prepared for work. If there is a child or pet, the missing pages can be found with crayon scrawl or chewed.

55. Someone in the neighbourhood has gone missing and you discover a ransom letter has been posted to your address. It's an old fashioned ransom demand, each letter cut from a newspaper or magazine and glued to a page. Later you discover your newspapers or magazines have been cut up, many of the letters missing.

57. You see the curtains move out of the side of your eye. When you look behind them the killer toy is standing there.

58. While talking on the land-line the killer toy pulls out the cable mid call.

59. The killer toy kills a small animal and puts it in the air vent to rot. Soon the house fills with a vile stench and big fat black flies are omnipresent.

60. The killer toy carefully nicks the blade on a brand new safety razor. This causes shallow but bloody cut on anyone that uses it.

61. In the early hours, your phone begins to ring, then stop after a few seconds.
