

CAULDRON CANT

This is a slightly different article. Rather than rules material for your game, we're giving you a sci-fi font for use in player handouts and similar props.

The font is called Cauldron Cant, and it looks like this:

You may be familiar with fonts like “Aurabesh” from the *Star Wars* universe, elvish script from Tolkien’s works, or dwarves runes from *Dungeons & Dragons*. This script fulfils a similar function, and allows you to add an extra element of immersion into your setting.

Cauldron Cant comes from the *Cauldron* campaign setting for science-fiction *What's OLD is NEW* games. You might find it on computer screens and readouts, stencilled onto the side of ships, or used as signage on space stations.
